

CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 1999 was slightly higher than a year earlier. The average price for cattle increased \$2.80 per cwt. to \$54.10. Calf prices for 1999 averaged \$77.10 per cwt. compared with \$70.90 during 1998. Cash receipts totaled \$201 million, up 6 percent from the \$190 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) increased 6 percent from a year earlier.
