Internet Access

The Kentucky Agricultural Statistics Service (KASS) data are available free of charge on the Internet at: <http://www.nass.usda.gov/ky/>. The site provides access to Kentucky Agri-News Reports, Crop Weather Reports, Press Releases, County Estimates and Census of Agriculture data. Links to the Kentucky Department of Agriculture, the University of Kentucky Agricultural Weather Center and other web sites related to Kentucky Agriculture are also included.

All National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) reports are also available free of charge on the Internet. For access, connect to the Internet and go to the NASS Homepage at <http://www.usda.gov/nass/>. Select "Today's Reports" or Publications and then Reports by Calendar or Publications and then Search, by Title or Subject.

Through a cooperative project with Cornell University, the Albert R. Mann Library distributes NASS, Economic Research Service and World Agricultural Outlook Board periodicals and data files via the USDA Economics and Statistics System on a web server. Over 400 reports annually and over 100 data files are available free of charge.

A calendar of scheduled releases is available from the USDA Economics and Statistics System. From the NASS Homepage, click on Publications and then click on Reports Calendar.

National reports are the most timely source of statistics. However, State reports may have more local information.

Internet Published Estimates Database

Historical State and U.S. information is available in an online data base via the Internet free of charge. County information is available for selected items. The database allows custom extracts based on commodity, year, state and other selection criteria and produces an output file compatible for updating databases and spreadsheets. The database can be accessed from the NASS Homepage at <http://www.usda.gov/nass/> Click on Quick STATS for the data base choices.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service provides meaningful, accurate and objective statistical information and services for the United States, its agriculture, and its rural communities. NASS provides its services through a main Headquarters unit located in

Washington, DC and in 46 State Statistical Offices (SSO's) serving all 50 States and Puerto Rico. The SSO's are operated under cooperative funding arrangements with State Departments of Agriculture and/or land-grant universities.

Nationwide: About 400 National reports are issued by NASS every year with estimates covering about 120 crops and 45 livestock items. Each report is released on a fixed schedule according to an annual calendar of release dates. Strict security measures are maintained to ensure that no one gains premature access to the information. The Census of Agriculture is published every 5 years covering all commodities by state, county, and zip code.

Kentucky: The Kentucky statistical office issues about 55 reports annually. The twice monthly Agri-news is a State compilation taken from National reports. A weekly crop weather report is issued during the growing season (April-November). Other reports include: cash receipts, floriculture, county estimates, and an annual summary including historical comparisons. All other NASS state statistical offices also offer State reports similar to those from Kentucky.
