



**DELMARVA AGRICULTURE DATA  
WEEKLY BROILER CHICKS REPORT**

**PLACEMENTS DOWN 11%**

For the week ending May 08, 2004, growers placed 11.2 million broiler chicks in Delmarva growing houses, according to the Maryland Agricultural Statistics Service. These placements were 11.0% below the comparable week a year earlier. Broiler-type chicks hatched (11.2 million) decreased 11.0% from the comparable week in 2003. Eggs set in incubators during the week totaled 13.9 million, a decrease of 4.5% from the same week a year earlier. Federally inspected slaughter on Delmarva was 10.9 million for the week ending May 01, 2004 compared to 11.3 million slaughtered during the same week in 2003.
