



CORN Bushels Produced in 2003






SOYBEANS Bushels Produced in 2003






ALL WHEAT Bushels Produced in 2003






ALL HAY Tons Produced in 2003






ALL CATTLE & CALVES Number of Head, January 1, 2004






ALL HOGS Number of Head, December 1, 2003






MILK COWS Number of Head, January 1, 2004


