A3127 REMAINS MOST POPULAR VARIETY

A3127 continued as the leading variety planted in Nebraska during 1983. A3127 accounted for 23% of the acreage planted, up from 14.6% in 1982. Williams (including 79 & 82) remained in second position with 11.3%, down 1.1% from last year. Pella moved up to third place with 6.5% of the total. Amsoy and Amsoy 71 totaled 5% in 1983 and moved one place lower to fourth.

Woodworth again ranked fifth with 3% and Century (2.8%) moved higher to sixth place.

S1492, with 1.7% of the acreage, replaced Beeson and Beeson 80 in seventh position.

Nebraska's soybean acreage dropped 9% in 1983, from 2,320,000 acres in 1982 to 2,100,000 acres in 1983.
