## AGRICULTURE

### Field Crops

Days suitable for field work 6.7. Topsoil moisture supplies were rated 62% short and 38% adequate. Corn harvested for grain 51%. Corn harvested for silage 95%. Corn condition was rated 70% good and 30% excellent. Soybeans dropping leaves 98%. Soybeans harvested 39%. Soybean condition was rated 95% good and 5% excellent. Producers were able to make good progress harvesting corn and soybeans. Deer damage was reported in some corn and soybean fields. Seeding of winter wheat and rye continued in some localities.

### Fruits and Vegetables

Producers took advantage of fair weather to continue harvest of fall vegetables. Sweet potato harvest is nearly complete in most localities with the crop rated in mostly good condition. Fall cabbage, lettuce, and spinach were also rated in mostly good condition with harvest 70% complete in most areas. Apple producers continued to make good progress with harvest 85% complete.
