

FARM NUMBERS CONTINUE GRADUAL UPWARD TREND

OKLAHOMA: The number of farms in Oklahoma in 2000 totaled 85,000, up 1,000 from 1999, according to the Oklahoma Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms in the economic class between \$1,000-\$9,999 dollars of sales were down 100. The number of farms with sales in the \$10,000 to \$99,999 class were up 1000 from 1999 and farms with \$100,000 or more in sales were up 100 from last year. There were 34 million acres of land in farms in 2000, unchanged from a year ago.

UNITED STATES: The number of farms and ranches in the United States in 2000 is estimated at 2.17 million, down 1 percent from 1999. Total land in farms is 943.0 million acres, down 4.5 million acres from a year earlier. The number of farms and ranches in the economic sales class between \$1,000 and \$9,999 declined 20,690 farms during 2000 to 1,173,650. Those with sales in the \$10,000-\$99,999 class increased 500 farms from 1999 to 649,350 in 2000. The \$100,000 and over sales class increased 200 farms from 1999 to 349,080 farms in 2000.
