

NUMBER OF FARMS UP 1,000 FROM 2000

OKLAHOMA: The number of farms in Oklahoma in 2001 totaled 86,000, up 1,000 from 2000, according to the Oklahoma Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms in the economic class between \$1,000-\$9,999 dollars of sales were up 1,500. The number of farms with sales in the \$10,000 to \$99,999 class were down 500 from 2000 and farms with \$100,000 or more in sales were unchanged from last year. There were 34 million acres of land in farms in 2001, unchanged from a year ago.

UNITED STATES: The number of farms and ranches in the United States in 2001 is estimated at 2.16 million, down 0.7 percent from 2000. Total land in farms, at 941.2 million acres, declined 1.9 million acres from a year earlier. The number of farms and ranches in the economic sales class between \$1,000 and \$9,999 declined 0.6 percent to 1,166,590 in 2001. Those with sales in the \$10,000-\$99,999 class decreased 1.2 percent from 2000 to 642,010 in 2001. The \$100,000 and over sales class remained unchanged at 349,180 farms in 2001.
