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
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2007 Oklahoma Crop Values Up 72 Percent

Oklahoma:

The total value of principal crops produced in Oklahoma during 2007 was \$1.71 billion, up 72 percent from 2006. The value of winter wheat made up 36 percent of the total crop value.



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United States:

The total value of principal crops produced in the United States during 2007 was \$162.8 billion, up 33 percent from 2006. Comparisons to 2006 for total value of selected crops include **corn** \$52.1 billion, up 62 percent; **sorghum** \$1.95 billion, up 120 percent; **all wheat** \$13.7 billion, up 77 percent; **all hay** \$17.0 billion, up 23 percent; **soybeans** \$26.8 billion, up 31 percent; and **all cotton** \$5.2 billion, up 4 percent.
