## Oklahoma Cattle on Feed Inventory Down 3 Percent from Last Year

### Oklahoma:

The inventory of cattle on feed was 340 thousand head in Oklahoma on April 1, 2008, for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head, down 3 percent from both the previous month and April 1, 2007. Placements during March were 50,000, 26 percent below one year ago. Marketings of fed cattle during March were 58,000, down 13 percent from the same month last year. Other disappearance during March totaled 2,000 head.

### United States:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States, for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head, totaled 11.7 million head on April 1, 2008, slightly above April 1, 2007. Placements during March totaled 1.74 million, 11 percent below 2007 and 5 percent below 2006. Net placements were 1.67 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during March totaled 1.84 million. Other disappearance totaled 63,000 head during January.

## Oklahoma Gross Income From Meat Animals Down

Total gross income from meat animals in Oklahoma was \$3.1 billion, down 8 percent from last year. Gross income from cattle and calves totaled \$2.5 billion for 2007, down 10 percent from 2006. Gross income from sheep and lambs \$3.3 million, was down 8 percent. Gross income for hogs, at \$585 million, was up 3 percent from 2006.

## Oklahoma Milk Production Down From Last Year

### Oklahoma:

The January - March quarterly milk production in Oklahoma was 277 million pounds, down 6.4 percent from the same quarter last year. The average number of milk cows on Oklahoma farms during the quarter, at 66,000 head, was down 6 percent from a year ago.

### United States:

Quarterly milk production for the U.S. was 47.6 billion pounds, up 3.2 percent from the January-March period last year. The average number of milk cows in the U.S. during the January-March quarter was 9.25 million head, 112,000 head more than the same period last year.

## Cash Receipts From Farm Marketings up 5 Percent

Cash receipts from farm marketings in 2007 were up 5 percent from 2006. Cash receipts for livestock and their products were slightly higher from a year earlier. Cash receipts for crops showed a 24 percent increase from 2006 receipts. Livestock and related income accounted for 77 percent of cash receipts from 2007 farm marketings.
