## Oklahoma Milk Production Down From Last Year

### Oklahoma:

Milk production for the July – September quarter of 2007 totaled 282 million pounds, down 6.0 percent from the same quarter last year. Milk production per cow for the quarter averaged 4,174 pounds, down 0.5 percent from a year ago.

### United States:

Milk production in the United States for the July – September quarter totaled 46.1 billion pounds, up 3.1 percent from the same period last year. The average number of milk cows in the U.S. during the July - September quarter was 9.16 million head, 44,000 head more than the same period last year.

## United States – Canadian Cattle Inventory Down Slightly

All cattle and calves in the U. S. and Canada combined totaled 120.7 million head on July 1, 2007, down slightly from a year ago. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 48.6 million head, were down slightly from a year ago.

## Oklahoma Cattle on Feed Inventory Down 8 Percent from Last Year

### Oklahoma:

The Oklahoma inventory of cattle on feed in feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head, was 325 thousand head on October 1, 2007, up 5 percent from the previous month, but down 8 percent from October 1, 2006. Placements during September were 72,000, up 1 percent from one year ago. Marketings of fed cattle during September were 56,000, down 5 percent from the same month last year. Other disappearance during September totaled 1,000 head.

### United States:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States, for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head, totaled 11.0 million head on October 1, 2007, 4 percent below October 1, 2006. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 2.43 million, 9 percent above 2006 and 3 percent above 2005. Net placements were 2.37 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during September totaled 1.71 million. Other disappearance totaled 54,000 head during September.
