Oklahoma Cattle on Feed Inventory Down 1 Percent from Last Year

Oklahoma:

The Oklahoma inventory of cattle on feed in feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head was 345 thousand head on December 1, 2007, up 3 percent from the previous month, but down 1 percent from December 1, 2006. Placements during November were 62,000, up 24 percent from one year ago. Marketings of fed cattle during November were 50,000, down 12 percent from the same month last year. Other disappearance during November totaled 2,000 head.

United States:

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States, for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head, totaled 12.1 million head on December 1, 2007, 1 percent above December 1, 2006. Placements during November totaled 2.12 million, 12 percent above 2006 and 3 percent above 2005. Net placements were 2.06 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during November totaled 1.74 million. Other disappearance totaled 57,000 head during November.

Oklahoma Hog Inventory Unchanged From Last Year

Oklahoma:

Oklahoma's inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2007, was estimated at 2.33 million head, down 4 percent from September 1, 2007, but unchanged from December 1, 2006. Breeding inventory of 360,000 head remained unchanged from the previous quarter, but up 3 percent from last year. Market hog inventory was down 1 percent from the previous year and totaled 1.97 million head. The weight group breakdown consisted of 920,000 pigs in the under 60-pound group; 300,000 in the 60-119 pound group; 220,000 in the 120-179 pound group; and 530,000 pigs in the 180 pound plus group.

The September - November 2007 pig crop totaled 1.70 million head, up 2 percent from last year, but 4 percent below last quarter. The 180,000 sows farrowed from September - November 2007 were down 5 percent from the number farrowed during the previous quarter.

United States:

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2007, was 65.1 million head. This was up 4 percent from December 1, 2006, but down 1 percent from September 1, 2007. Breeding inventory, at 6.16 million head, was up 1 percent from last year and up slightly from the previous quarter. Market hog inventory, at 59.0 million head, was up 5 percent from last year, but down 1 percent from last quarter.

The September - November 2007 U.S. pig crop, at 28.0 million head, was up 4 percent from 2006 and up 7 percent from 2005. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 3.03 million head, up 3 percent from 2006 and up 4 percent from 2005. The sows farrowed during this quarter represented 49 percent of the breeding herd. The average pigs saved per litter was 9.24 for the September - November 2007 period, compared to 9.11 last year. Pigs saved per litter by size of operation ranged from 7.40 for operations with 1-99 hogs and pigs to 9.30 for operations with more than 5,000 hogs and pigs.
