Oklahoma Hog Inventory Down 1 Percent From Last Year

Oklahoma:

Oklahoma's inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2008, was estimated at 2.33 million head, unchanged from December 1, 2007 but down 1 percent from March 1, 2007. The breeding inventory of 360,000 head was unchanged from last year. The market hog inventory was down 1 percent from the previous year and totaled 1,970,000 head. Weight group breakdowns consisted of 970,000 pigs in the under-60 pound group; 300,000 in the 60-119 pound group; 220,000 in the 120-179 pound group; and 480,000 pigs in the 180 pound and over group.

The December 2007 - February 2008 pig crop totaled 1,674,000 head, down 4 percent from both last year and last quarter. The 180,000 sows farrowed from December 2007 - February 2008, were down 5 percent from the number farrowed during the previous quarter.

United States:

U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2008, was 65.9 million head. This was up 7 percent from March 1, 2007, but down 2 percent from December 1, 2007. Breeding inventory, at 6.14 million head, was up less than 1 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous quarter. Market hog inventory, at 59.8 million head, was up 7 percent from last year, but down 2 percent from last quarter.

The December 2007 - February 2008 U.S. pig crop, at 28.1 million head, was up 6 percent from 2007 and up 9 percent from 2006. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 3.05 million head, up 5 percent from 2007 and up 7 percent from 2006. The sows farrowed during this quarter represented 50 percent of the breeding herd. The average pigs saved per litter was 9.21 for the period December 2007 - February 2008, compared to 9.09 last year. Pigs saved per litter by size of operation ranged from 7.50 for operations with 1-99 hogs to 9.30 for operations with more than 5,000 hogs and pigs.
