Oklahoma Hog Inventory Down 3 Percent From Last Year

Oklahoma:

Oklahoma's inventory of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2007, was estimated at 2.31 million head, down 1 percent from March 1, 2007, and down 3 percent from June 1, 2006. The breeding inventory of 360,000 head remained unchanged from last year. Market hog inventory was down 3 percent from the previous year and totaled 1.95 million head. The weight group breakdown consisted of 930,000 pigs in the under 60-pound group; 315,000 in the 60-119 pound group; 230,000 in the 120-179 pound group; and 475,000 pigs in the 180 pound plus group.

The March – May 2007 pig crop totaled 1.81 million head, up 10 percent from last year, and up 4 percent from last quarter. The 195,000 sows farrowed were up 3 percent from the number farrowed during the previous quarter.

United States:

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2007, was 62.8 million head. This was up 2 percent from both June 1 2006, and March 1, 2007. Breeding inventory, at 6.12 million head, was up 1 percent from last year and 2 percent from the previous quarter. Market hog inventory, at 56.6 million head, was up 2 percent from both last year and last quarter.

The March - May 2007 U.S. pig crop, at 27.1 million head, was up 2 percent from 2006 and up 4 percent from 2005. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 2.97 million head, up 1 percent from 2006 and up 3 percent 2005. The sows farrowed during this quarter represented 49 percent of the breeding herd. The average pigs saved per litter was 9.15 for the period March - May 2007, compared to 9.08 last year. Pigs saved per litter by size of operation ranged from 7.60 for operations with 1-99 hogs and pigs to 9.20 for operations with more than 5,000 hogs and pigs.
