PROCESSING

Processors in Washington and Oregon (excluding Malheur County) used 58.7 million cwt of raw potatoes to April 1, 2003, 3.74 million cwt more than the 55.0 million cwt processed during the same period last year but 4.15 million cwt less than the 62.9 million cwt processed during the same time frame two years ago. Processing to April 1, 2003 in Washington and Oregon (excluding Malheur County) accounted for 50.2 percent of the 2002 production. Processors in Idaho and Malheur County, Oregon used 56.2 million cwt of 2002 crop raw potatoes to April 1, 18 percent more than a year ago. Processing in the nine processing states totaled 145 million cwt to April 1, up 10 percent from last year. Of the total 145 million cwt processed, 31.9 million cwt were used for dehydrated products, excluding starch and flour.

APRIL 1 STOCKS DOWN 12 PERCENT

Potato stocks in Oregon totaled 7.5 million cwt (375,000 tons), on April 1, 2003, down 12 percent from April 1, 2002. Stocks account for 30 percent of 2002 production, down 11 percent from last year. Oregon stocks were not all grown in Oregon. Stocks include potatoes received from other States now being stored in Oregon. Seventy two percent of Oregon's stocks are in the Hermiston/Boardman area, while Klamath stocks are 9 percent of the State's total. A year ago, 84 percent of Oregon's stocks were in the Hermiston/Boardman area, while 2 percent were in the Klamath area. Hermiston/Boardman area stocks were down 23 percent but Klamath area stocks were up 327 percent from April 1, 2002, primarily due to the lack of water and thus potato production in the Klamath Basin for the 2001 crop.

Potato stocks are defined as the quantity (whether sold or not) remaining in storage for all purposes and use, including shrinkage and waste, and other losses that occur after April 1.

APRIL POTATO STOCKS UP 4 PERCENT

The 15 major potato storage States held 125 million cwt of potatoes on April 1, 2003, up 4 percent from last year but 19 percent below 2001. Storage accounts for 30 percent of the 2002 fall storage States' production, down 1 percentage point from last year. Disappearance, at 286 million cwt, from the start of harvest in 2002 to April 1, is up 7 percent from the same period last year but 6 percent below two years ago.

Western States held 93.9 million cwt of potatoes in storage on April 1, up 7 percent from last year but 21 percent below two years ago. Idaho's potato stocks are up 9 percent from last year and Colorado's are up 30 percent. Washington's potato stocks are 2 percent above last year but Oregon's storage is down 12 percent.

Central States account for 24.2 million cwt of potato stocks this April 1, down 8 percent from last year and 14 percent below two years ago. North Dakota's stocks dropped 33 percent, Wisconsin's stocks are down 7 percent from a year earlier, but Minnesota's stocks are the same as last year.

Eastern States stored 6.95 million cwt of potatoes on April 1, up 18 percent from last year but 5 percent below the 2000 crop. Maine's stocks are up 19 percent from last year, Pennsylvania's gained 17 percent, but New York's are unchanged from a year ago.
