

Agricultural Exports, 2001

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Pennsylvania: U.S. agricultural exports from the Keystone State during the fiscal year (FY) October 2000-September 2001 were valued at \$732.4 million. This represents an increase of 19 percent from the \$614.0 million worth of commodities exported in FY 2000.

Pennsylvania exports ranked sixth in dairy products; eighth in unmanufactured tobacco, hides and skins, and fats, oils and grease; and twelfth in prepared fruits, live animals and meat, and poultry and products.

United States: The value of agricultural exports for the U.S. during FY 2001 totaled \$52.7 billion, up 4 percent from the \$50.7 billion in FY 2000.

California was the leading export state in FY 2001. The total value of their exports was \$8.7 billion. Other leading states and their value were: Iowa, \$3.3 billion; Texas, \$3.3 billion; Illinois, \$3.1 billion; and Nebraska, \$2.9 billion.

Methodology: The Economic Research Service estimates State export shares based primarily on production share of the commodity. The estimated export value for each State should not be interpreted as actual measurements of a State's exports. An agricultural commodity is likely to pass through several States before being exported, little data exists on shipments between States, and the State origin is lost as commodities move from farmgate to port.
