










# GOT MILK?

Pennsylvania dairy farms produce about 1.3 billion gallons of milk every year. It takes 2 gallons of milk to make 1 gallon of ice cream. Pennsylvania manufactured 56 million gallons of ice cream in 2002. It takes about 10 quarts of whole milk to make 1 pound of butter.
