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

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Wheat Forecast Milk Cows and Production Corn County Estimates Turkey Hatchery

U.S. Winter Wheat Production Down 1 Percent Virginia Unchanged

Winter wheat production is forecast at 1.53 billion bushels, down 1 percent from the May 1 forecast and 10 percent below 2003. Based on June 1 conditions, the U.S. yield is forecast at 43.6 bushels per acre, down 0.6 bushel from the previous forecast. Grain area totals 35.1 million acres, unchanged from May 1.

Virginia's 2004 wheat crop is expected to total nearly 9.77 million bushels, unchanged from the previous forecast. If realized, producers will harvest 33 percent above last year's 7.36 million bushels but 6 percent below the 10.37 million bushels produced in 2002. Producers in the Commonwealth are expected to harvest 155,000 acres of wheat that will yield an average of 63 bushels per acre, 17 bushels per acre above 2003 but equal to 2002. This is unchanged from the previous month's forecast. In general, small grains are in fair to excellent condition.
