INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECORDING DETAILED INFORMATION

Information should be recorded by **COUNTY, FRUIT, VARIETY** (Strain for only Red Delicious and Gala apples), and year planted or topworked. The reference date is January 1, 2001.

DO NOT INCLUDE NON-HARVESTED POLLENIZERS IN TREE COUNT.

DO NOT INCLUDE GRAPES OR TART CHERRIES IN THIS SECTION.

- (1) The county where the fruit is located should be recorded on the first line for each fruit. Use a separate line for each variety, apple strain (for Red Delicious and Gala apples), and year planted or topworked.
- (2-3) Record the type of fruit and variety of the fruit. Enclosed is a listing of the major varieties.
- (4) Specify strain for only Red Delicious and Gala apple varieties.
- (5) Enter the year of planting or year topworked for each line.
- (6) Record the acres of trees (excluding roads, waste areas, abandoned orchards) to the nearest tenth acre.
- (7-8) Record the number of trees for each line by bearing age and nonbearing age. The operator makes the determination in classifying trees as bearing age.

Include additional or clarifying information for unusual situations (irregular tree spacing patterns or interplant designs, multiple row plantings, etc.) in the comments section or on a separate enclosure.
