

## Free E-Mail Subscription to NASS Periodicals

**Subscribe E-mail** - Mann Library provides a **FREE** e-mail service for NASS reports. When a current report is released, it is sent via e-mail to the list of subscribers for that report. From NASS Homepage at <http://www.usda.gov/nass/>, select **Publications**. From the **Publications** page, the **Subscribe E-mail** button takes the user to the page describing e-mail delivery of reports. Click on **Go to the Subscription Page** and follow the instructions. It's as simple as clicking on the report name.

Subscriptions may also be obtained by sending an e-mail message to [usda-reports@usda.mannlib.cornell.edu](mailto:usda-reports@usda.mannlib.cornell.edu). In the body of the message put "Subscribe XXX, where XXX is the "Report Code" for each publication desired. To order NASS reports send an e-mail message to:

[usda-reports@usda.mannlib.cornell.edu](mailto:usda-reports@usda.mannlib.cornell.edu) subscribing to the desired reports. As an example, user entries in the message for **Crop Production** and **Hogs and Pigs** would be:
