


U.S. All Cattle & Calves January 1, 1992 - 2012







U.S. Beef Cows January 1, 1992 - 2012








NASS Estimates Compared to Trade Expectations Percent of Previous Year

Calf Crop	98.9%	99.1%	98.4 – 99.5%






All Cattle Inventory First Estimate Versus Final Estimate January 1, 1992 - 2012
















All Cow & Heifer Slaughter as a Percent of Total Slaughter









U.S. % of Total Placements by Size Group










