




First Estimate Versus Final Estimate 2006 - 2015



U.S. Quarterly Pigs per Litter 2006-2015








U.S. Pigs per Litter by Size of Operation June-August 2015








Canadian Imports by Quarter Feeder Pigs and Slaughter Hogs


