History of the Census of Agriculture in Puerto Rico

- 1910 1st Puerto Rico Census of Agriculture
- 2018 Puerto Rico Census of Agriculture:
 - This is Puerto Rico's 18th Census of Agriculture and the 5th conducted by NASS
 - In 1997, the Census was transferred from the Census Bureau to NASS
- Data are available for:
 - Island and regional levels
 - Municipio level data is not available for 2018






Farm Definition

Puerto Rico:


"Any place from which \$500 or more of agricultural products were produced and sold, or **normally would have been sold**, during the census year."

Number of Farms and Land in Farms: 1998-2018





Number of Farms by Size Class: 2012 and 2018



Number of Farms and Land in Farms by Size Class (cuerdas): 2018







Total Value of Production by Region as Percent of Island Total






