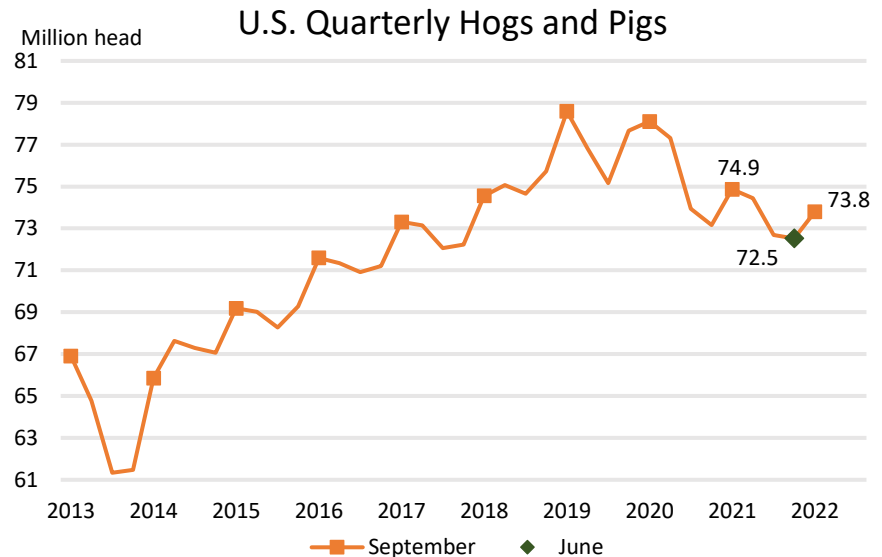

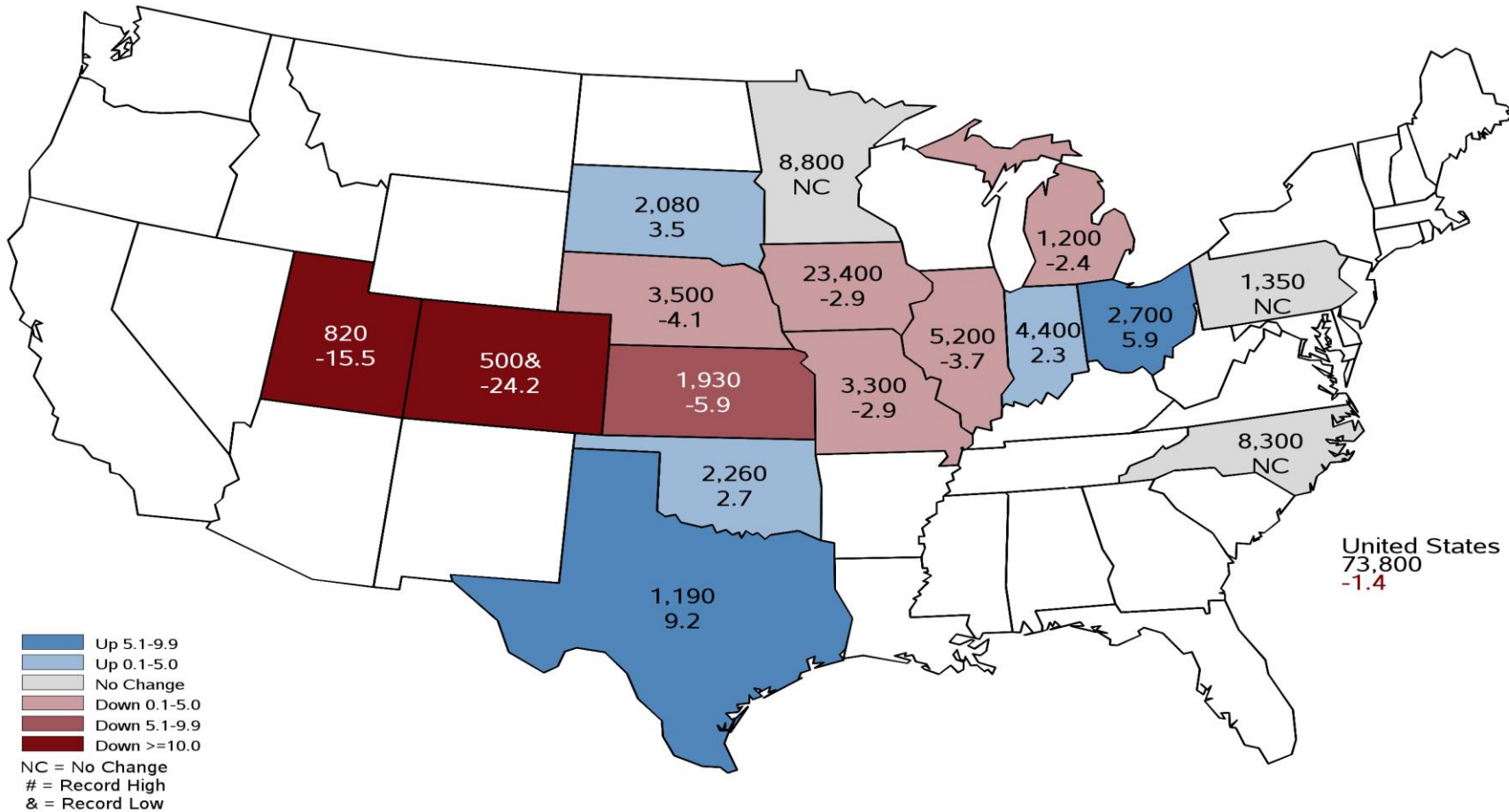

(1,000) Head and Percent Change from Previous Year

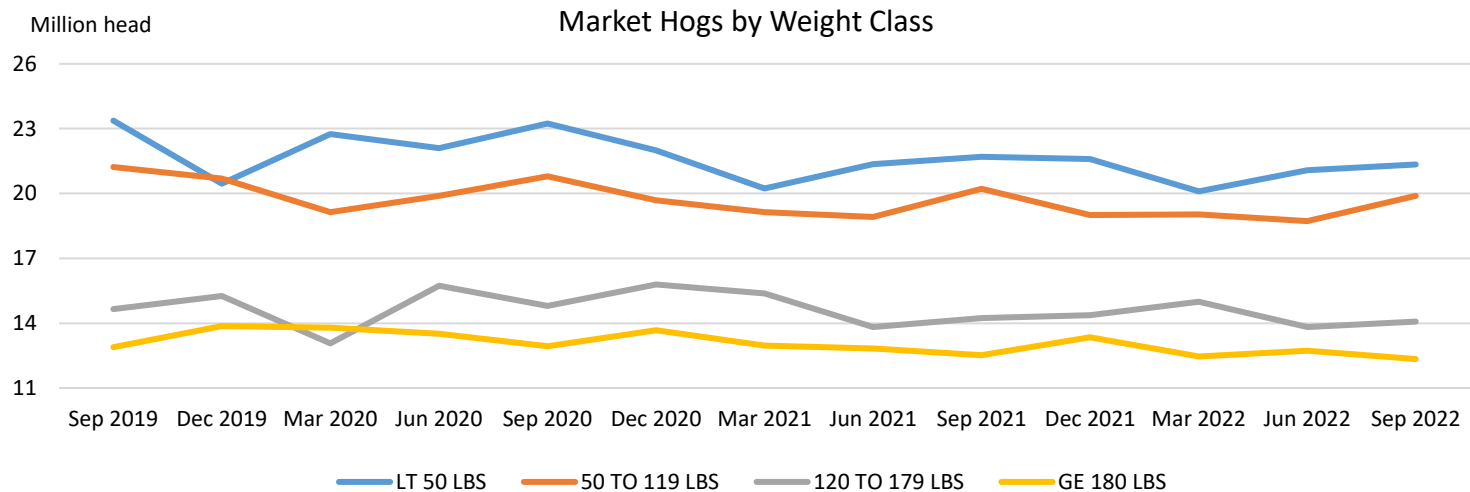

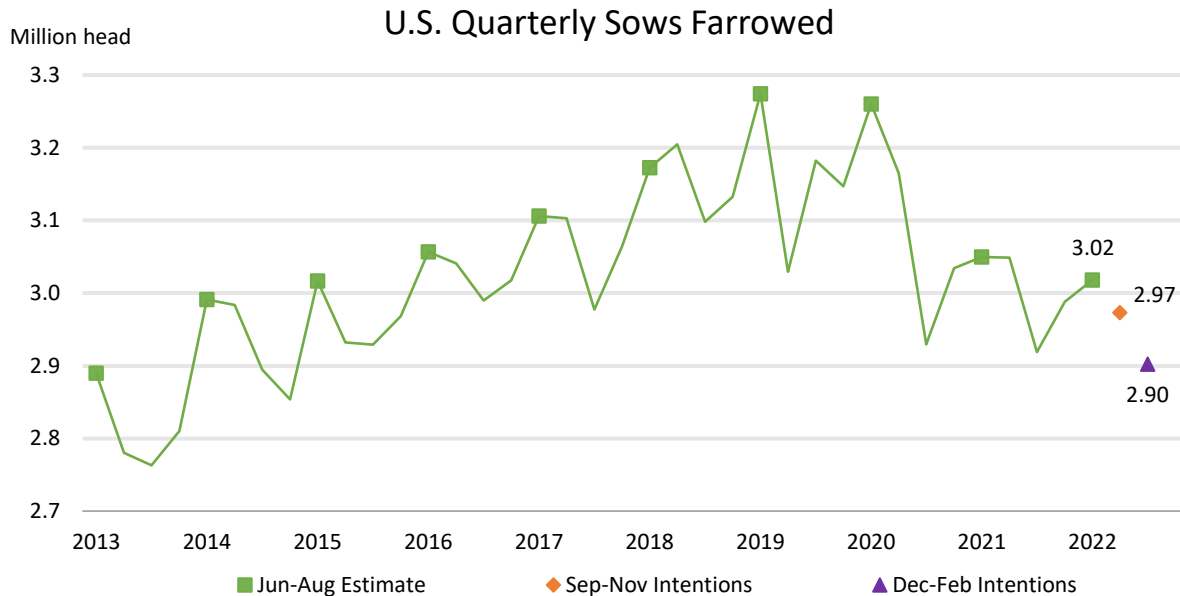

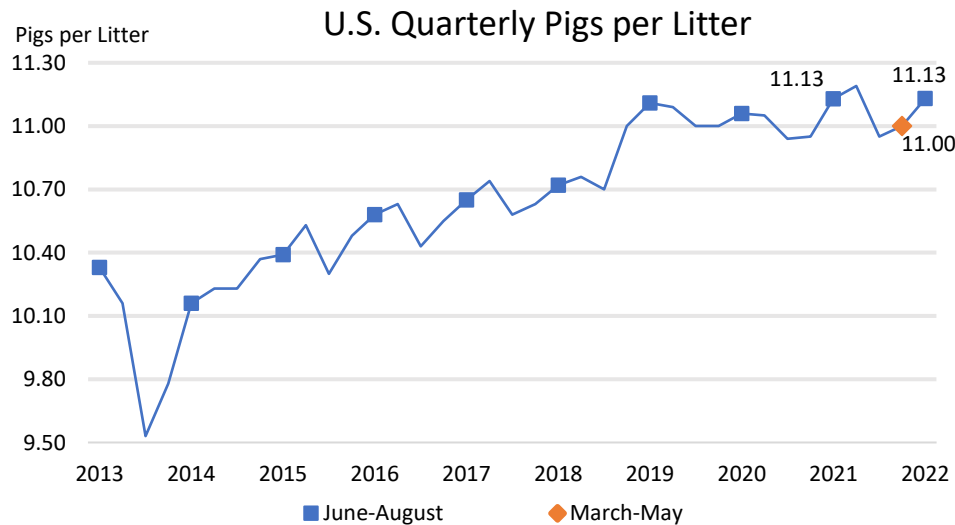

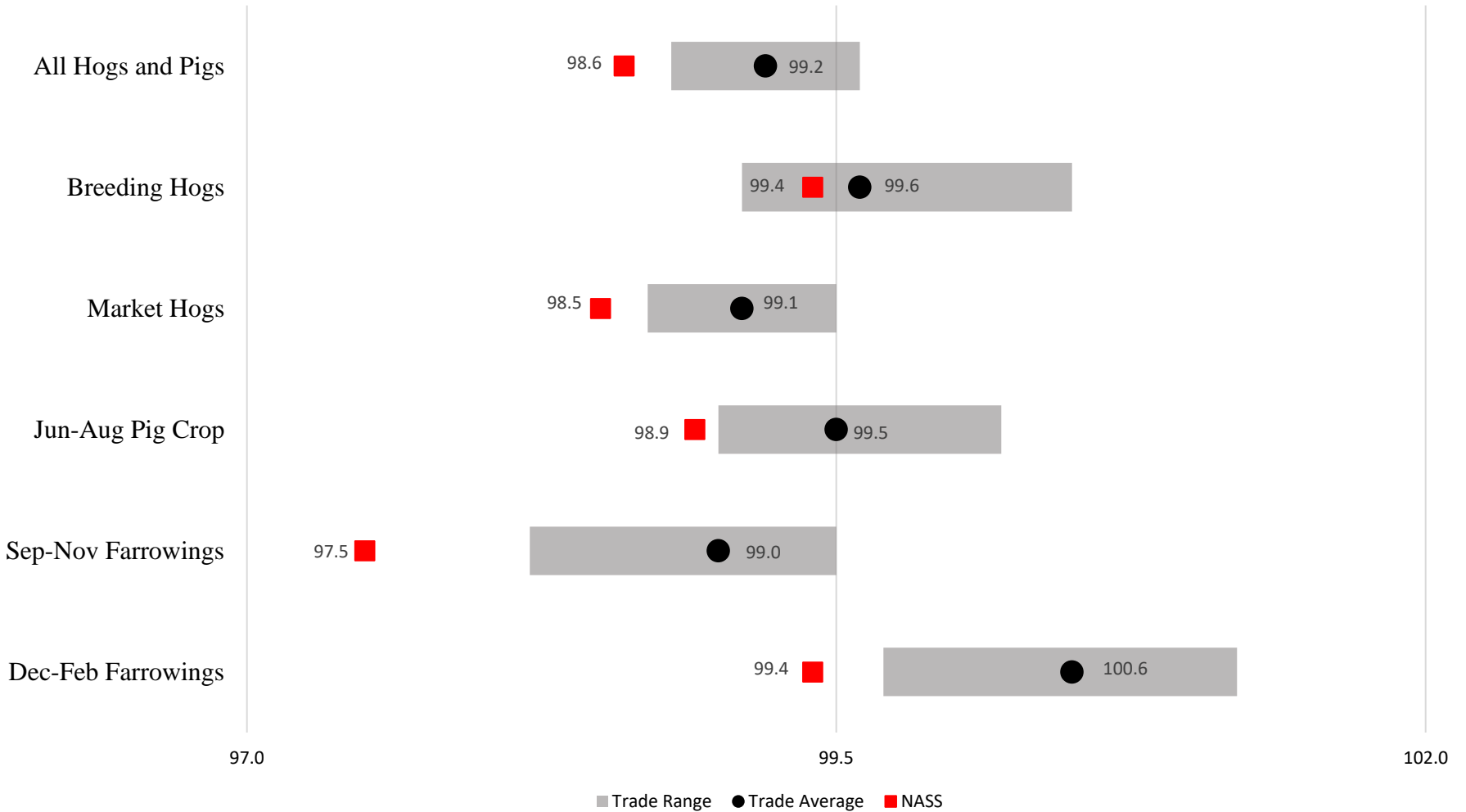

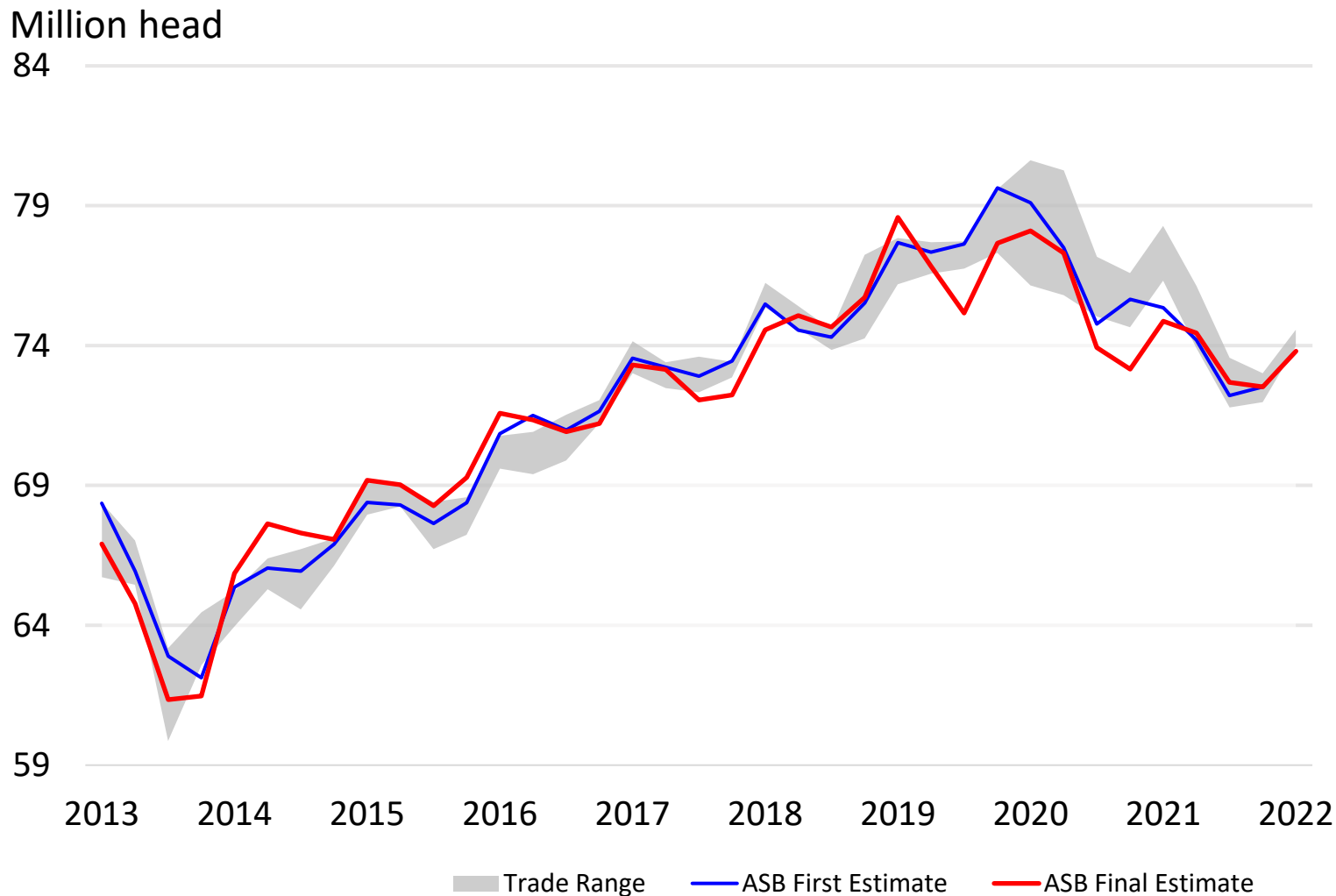
Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year

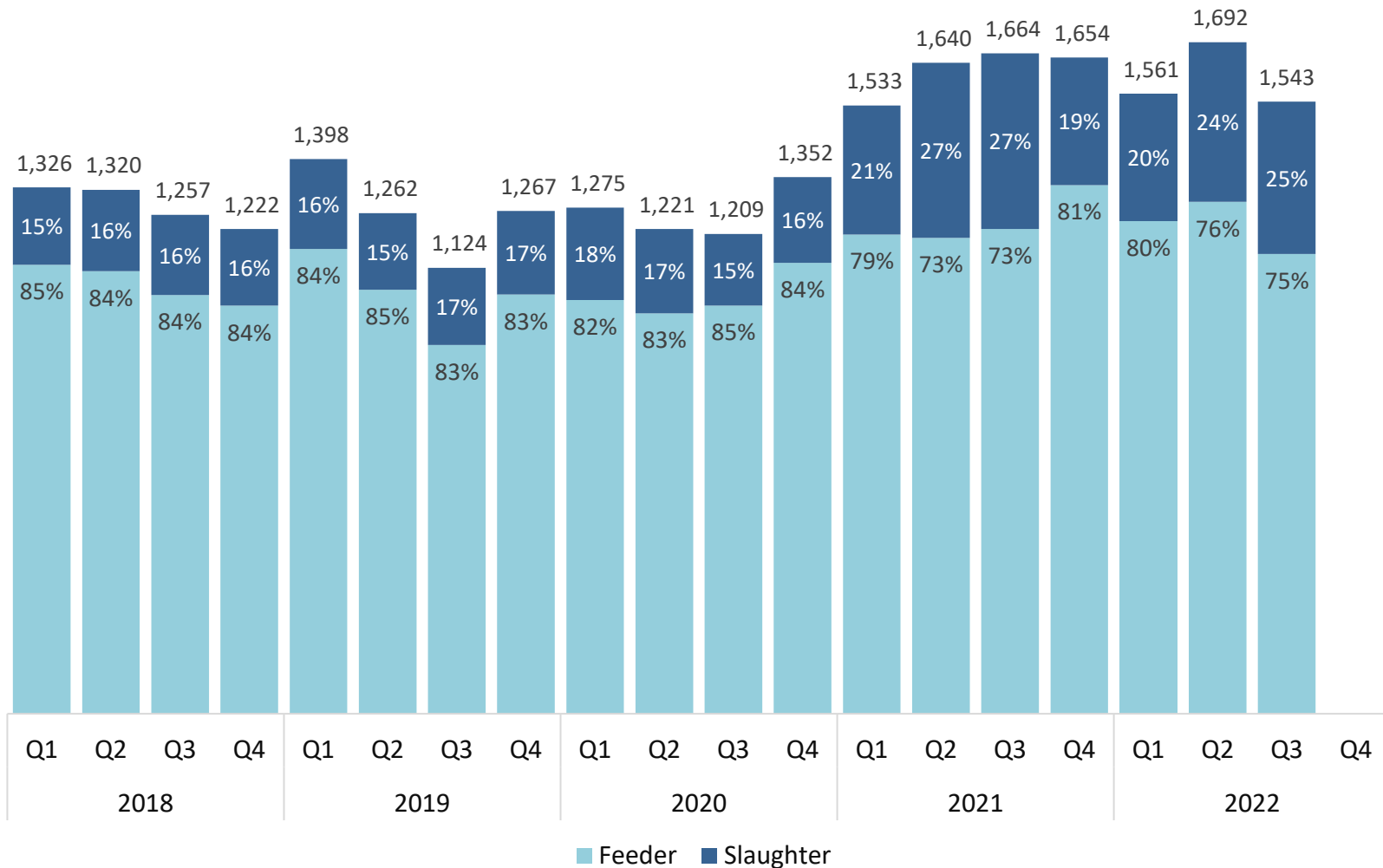

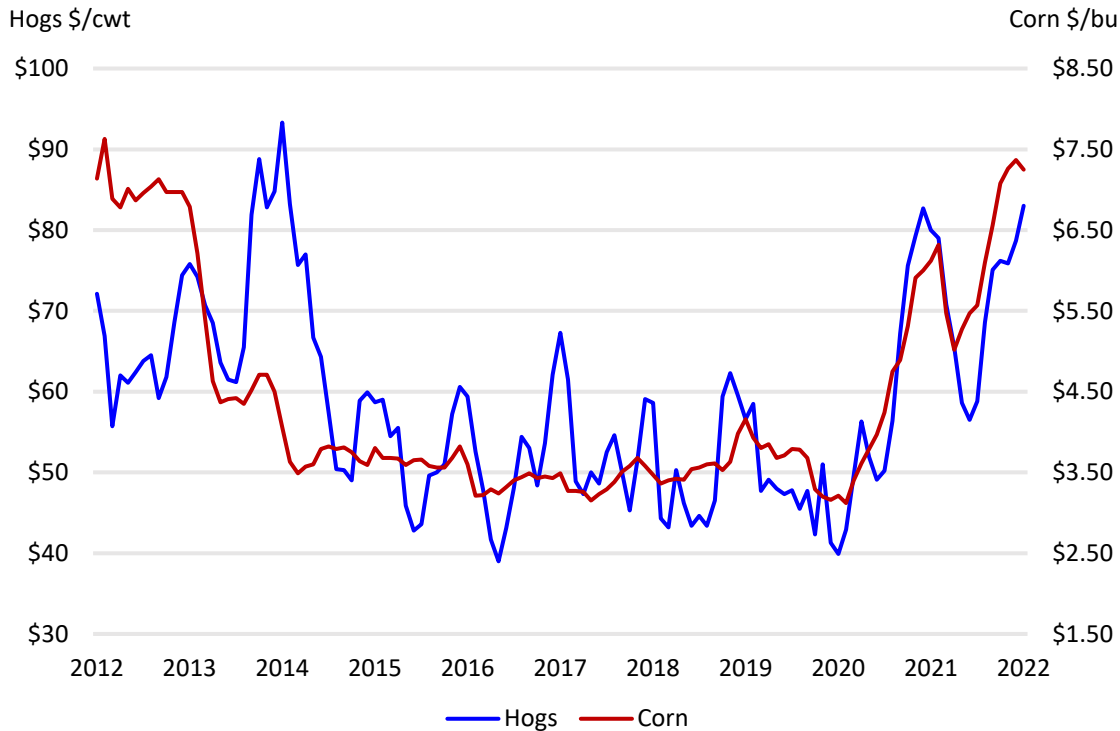
Canadian Imports by Quarter
