


Figure 3. Farms by Market Value of Agricultural Products Sold




Figure 2. Farms by Size





Figure 4. Market Value of Agricultural Products Sold

Figure 5. Average Market Value per Farm







Figure 6. Selected Farm Production Expenses








Figure 8. Farms by Legal Status - Percent of Total
