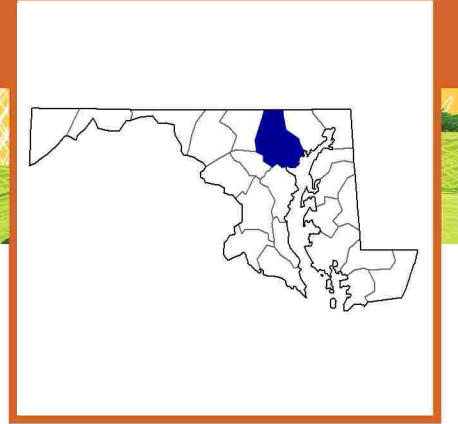


## Baltimore County, Maryland Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

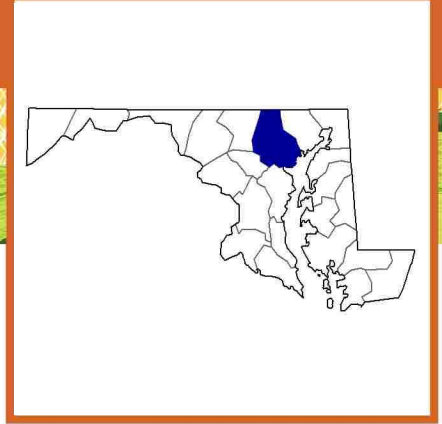

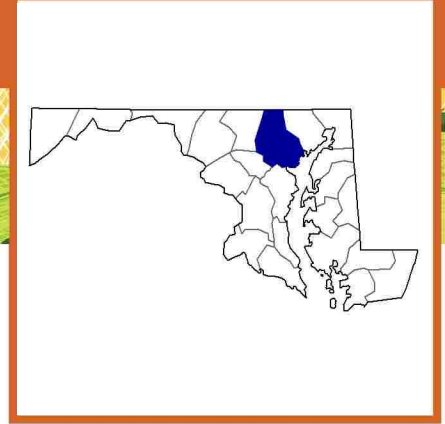

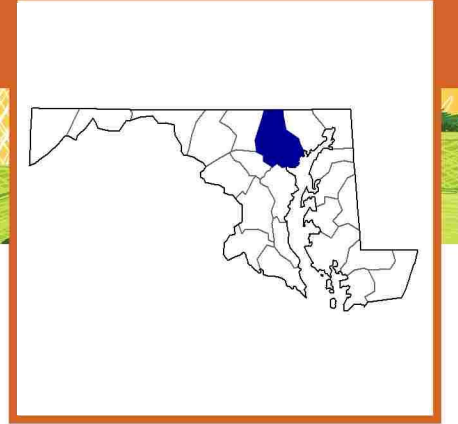

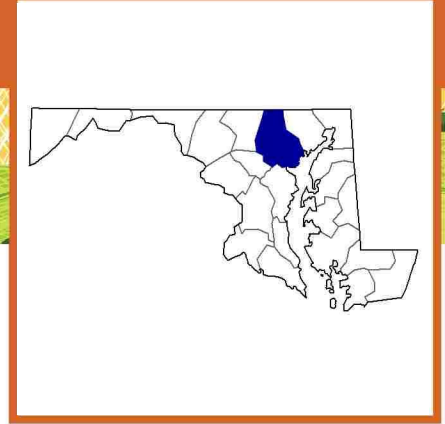

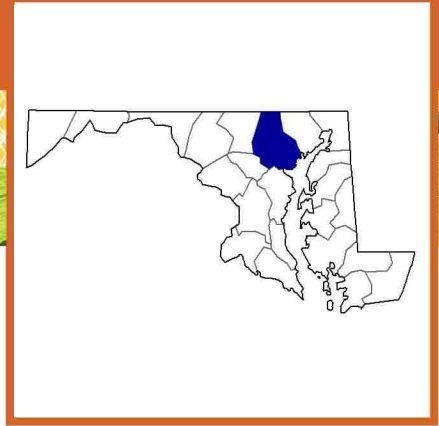
