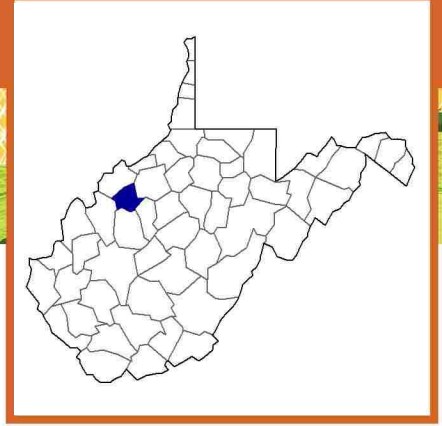

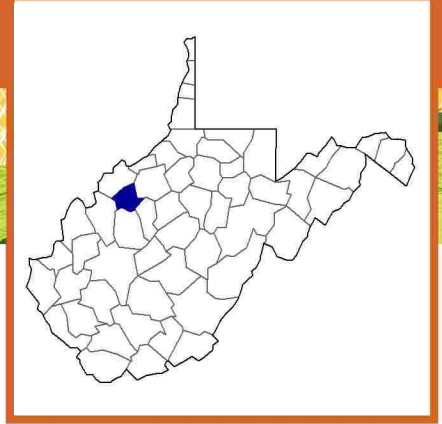


## Wirt County, West Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

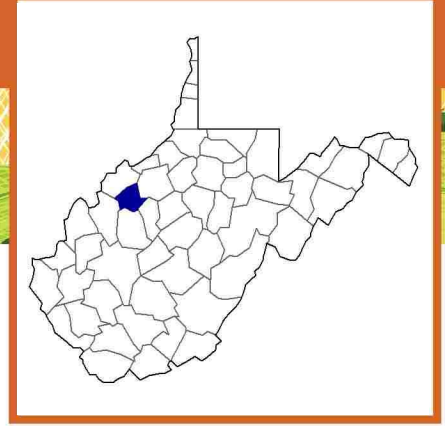

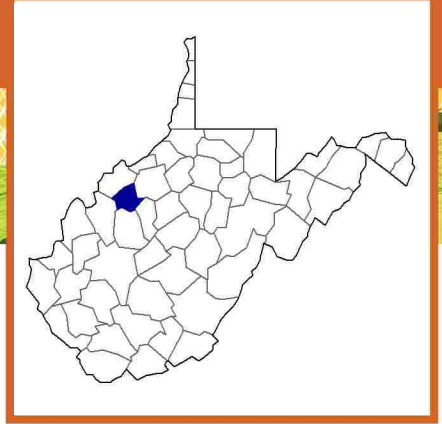

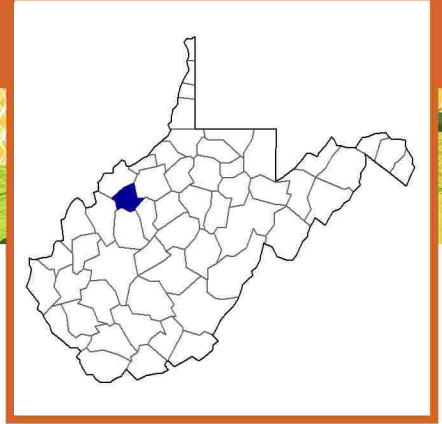

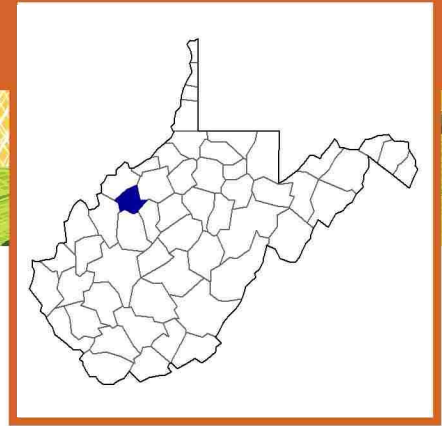
