

Increased 21 percent from 318 acres in 1992 to 386 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 28 percent from 75 farms in 1992 to 54 farms in 1997.


Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 71 percent to \$14,180,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 86 percent of the market value. Livestock sales accounted for 14 percent of the market value.
