

Increased 6 percent from 200 acres in 1992 to 212 acres in 1997.

Decreased 20 percent from 99 farms in 1992 to 79 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 7 percent to \$5,875,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 10 percent of the market value.
