

# HIDALGO NEW MEXICO

Land in farms

Increased 31 percent from 843,401 acres in 1992 to 1,104,820 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 32 percent from 5,737 acres in 1992 to 7,567 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 3 percent from 88 farms in 1992 to 85 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Decreased 2 percent to \$18,311,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 69 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 31 percent of the market value.
