Sample Size	5,167
Collection Methods	Mail, Telephone, Internet, Face-to-Face Interview
Primary Data Items	Total Inventory: by class, weight group; Sows Farrowing; Pig Crop; and Pigs per Litter

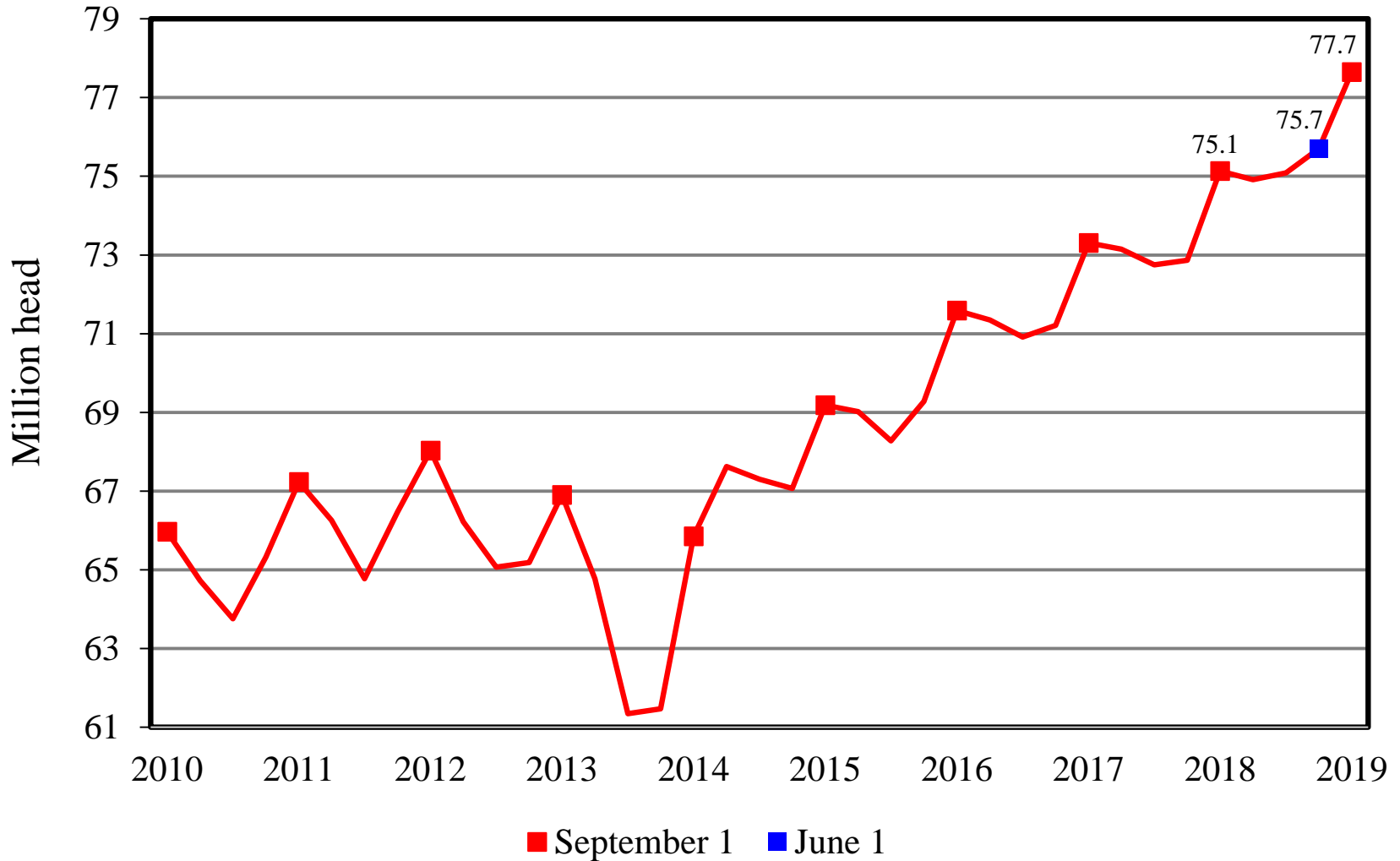

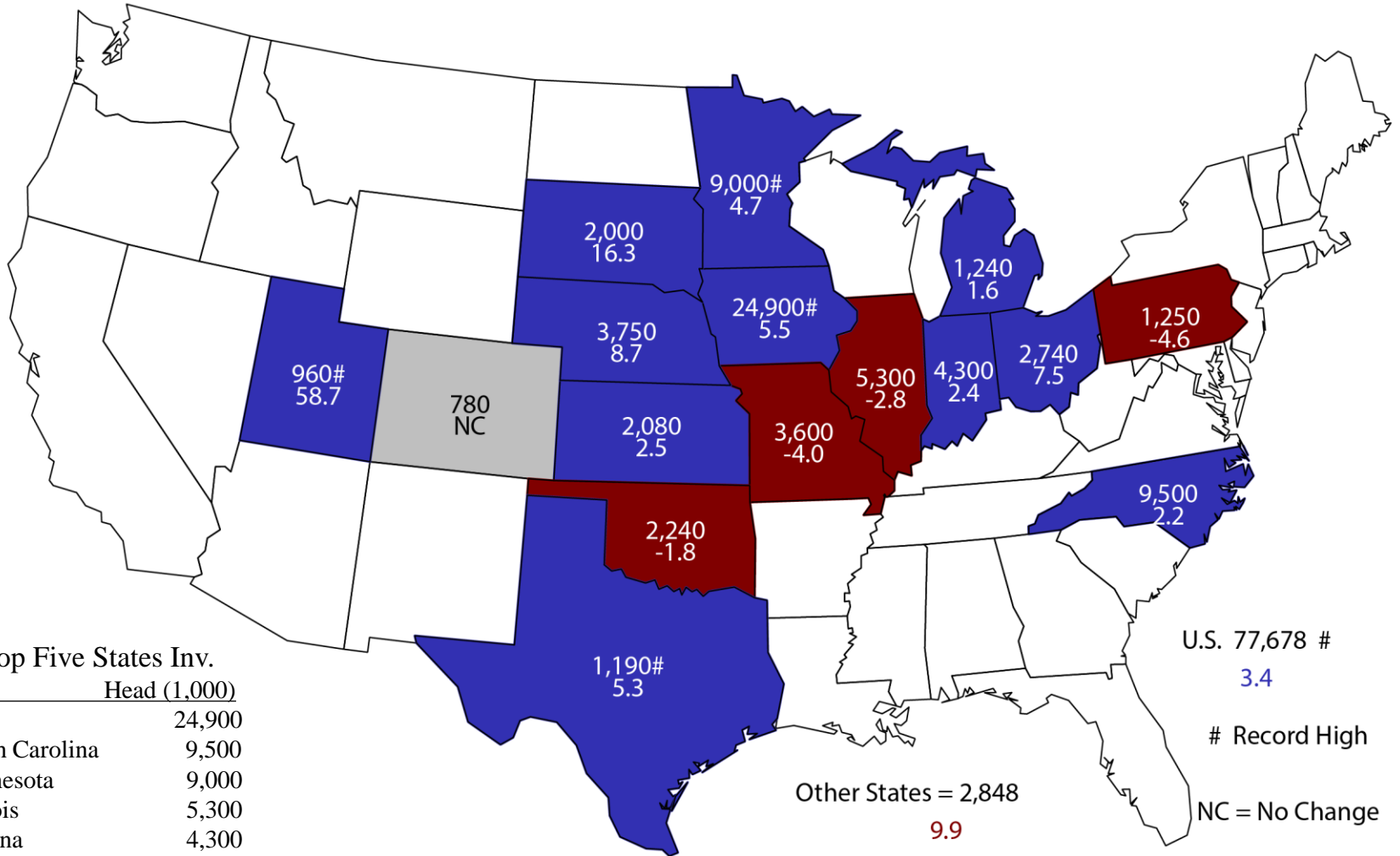

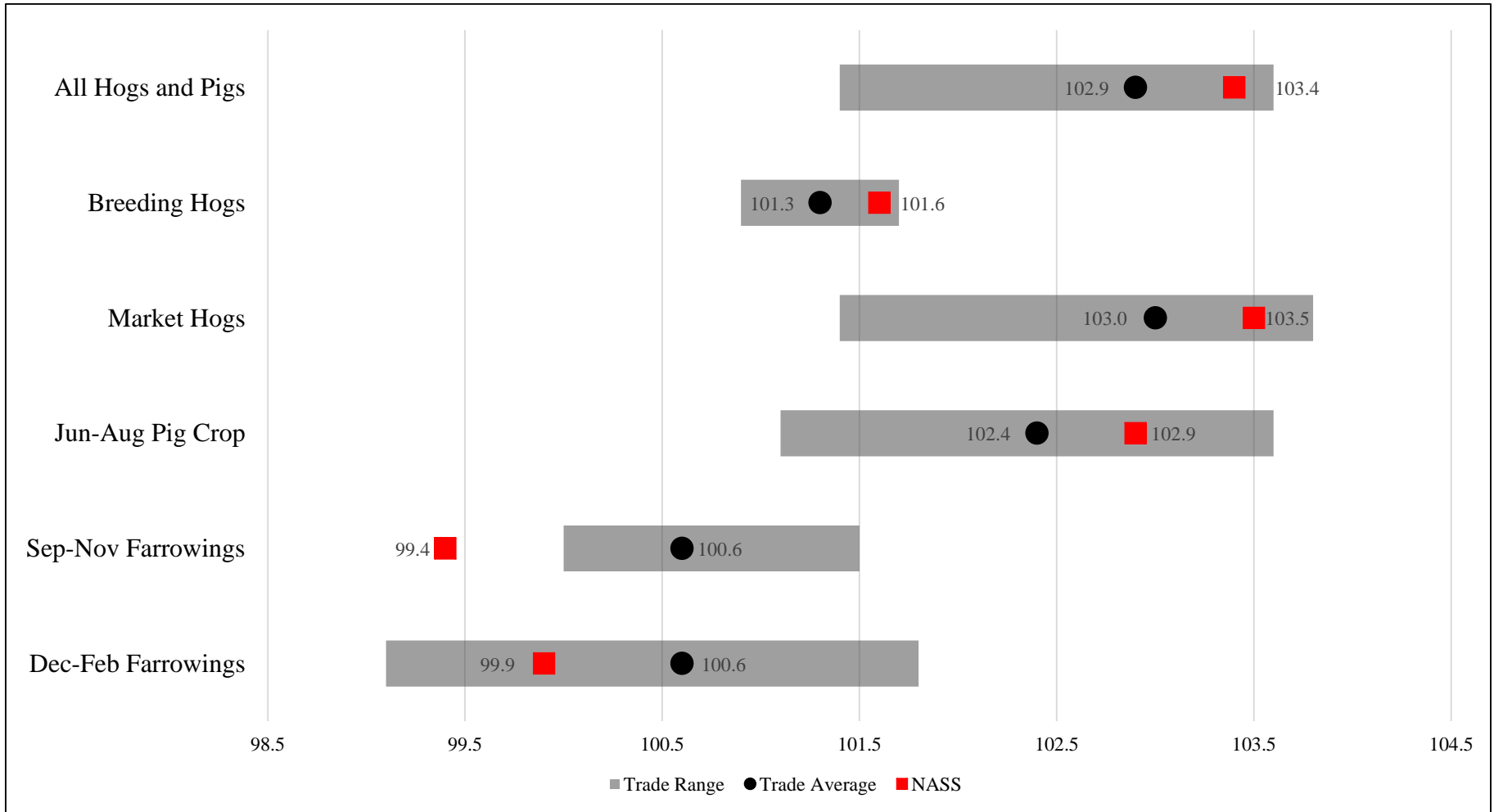

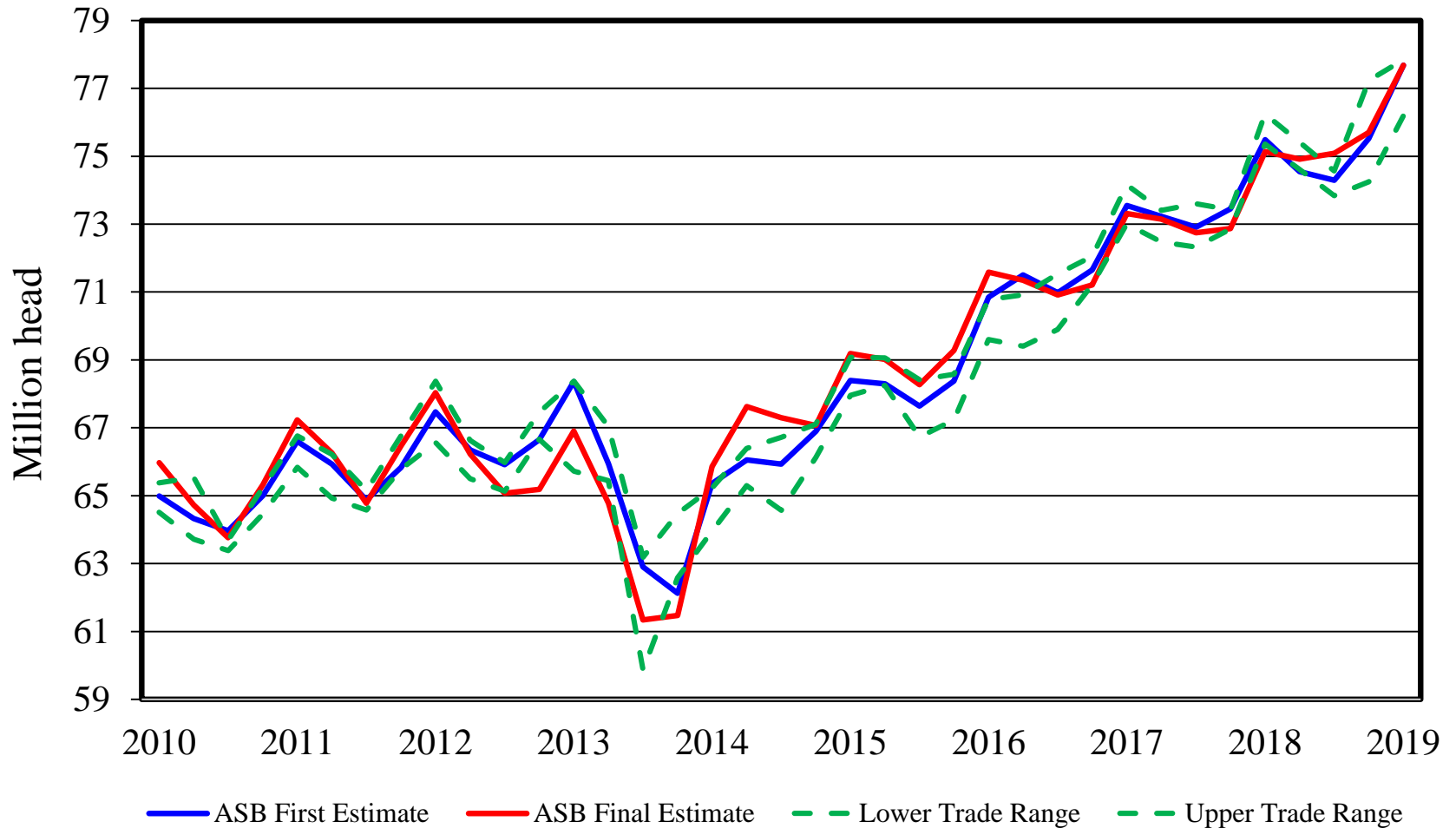
# Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year

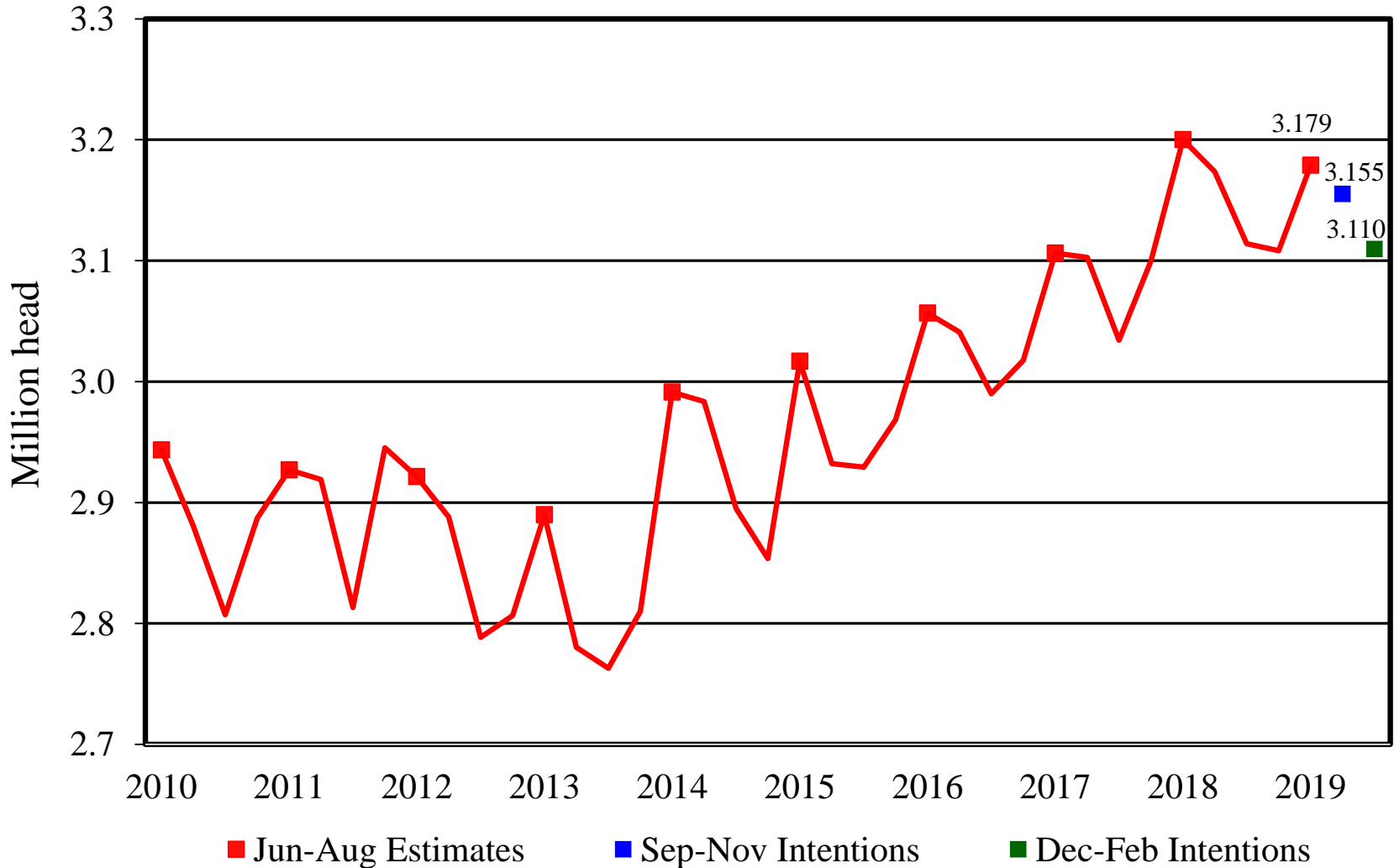
## First Estimate Versus Final Estimate

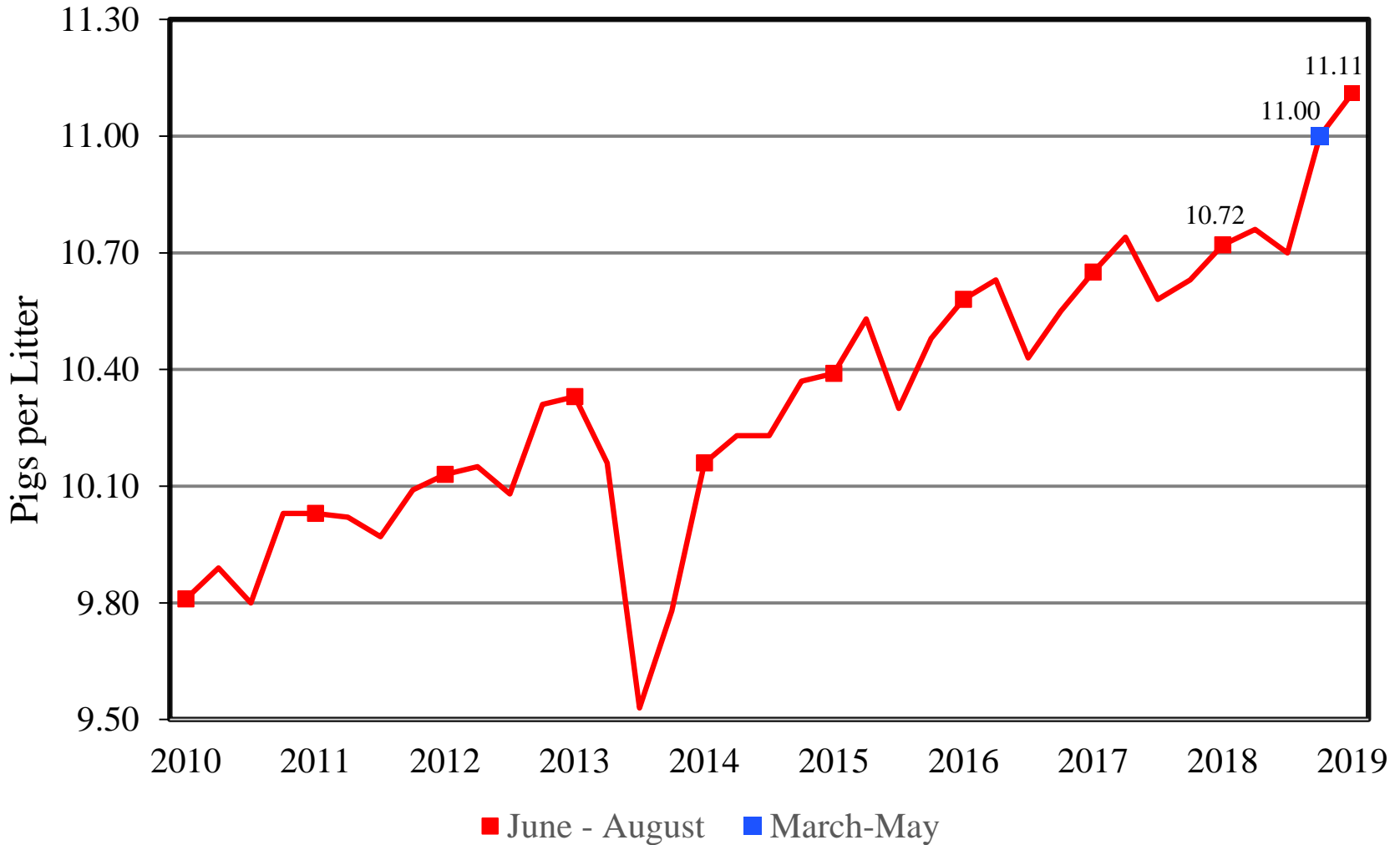

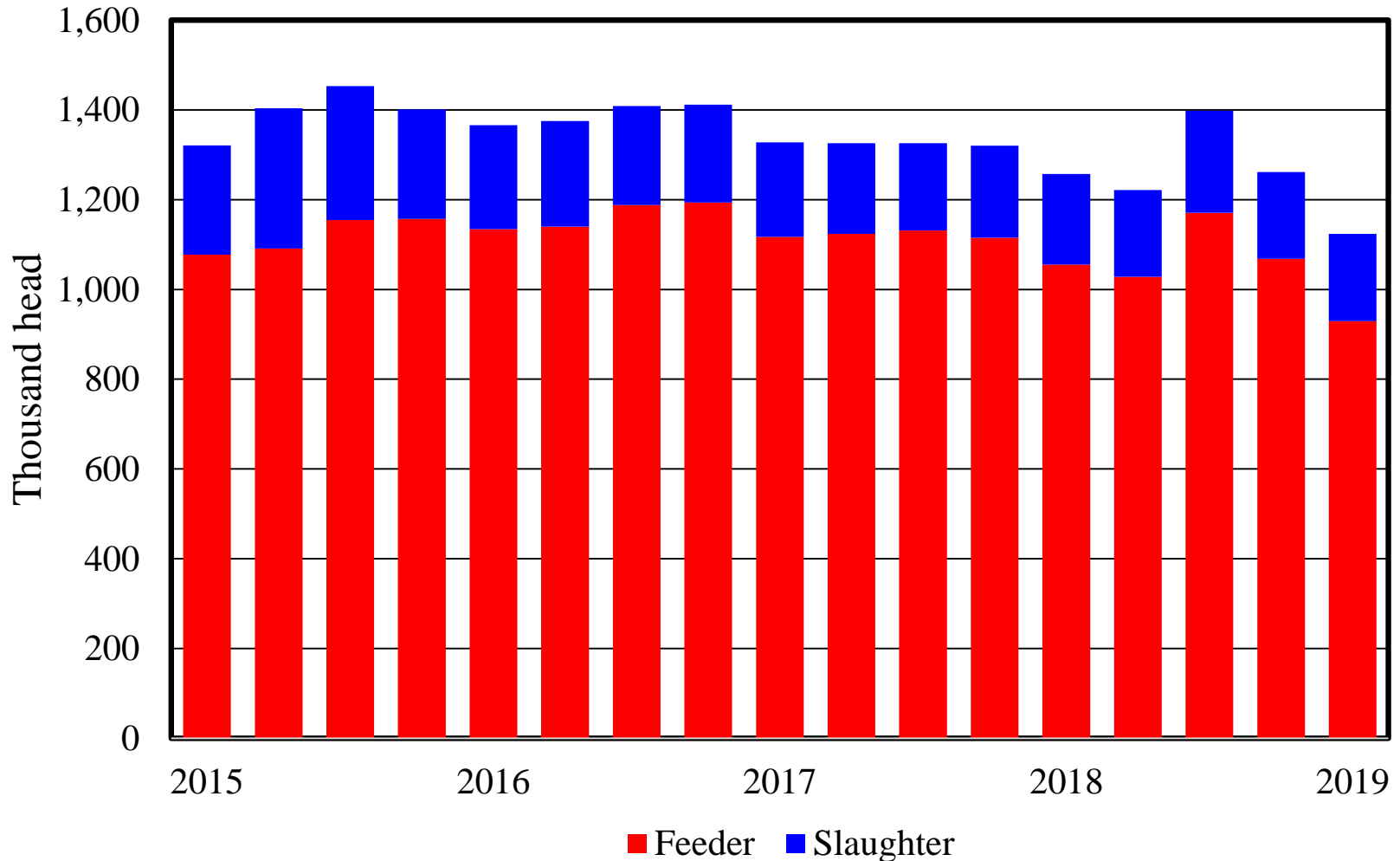
# U.S. Quarterly Pigs per Litter

## 2010-2019

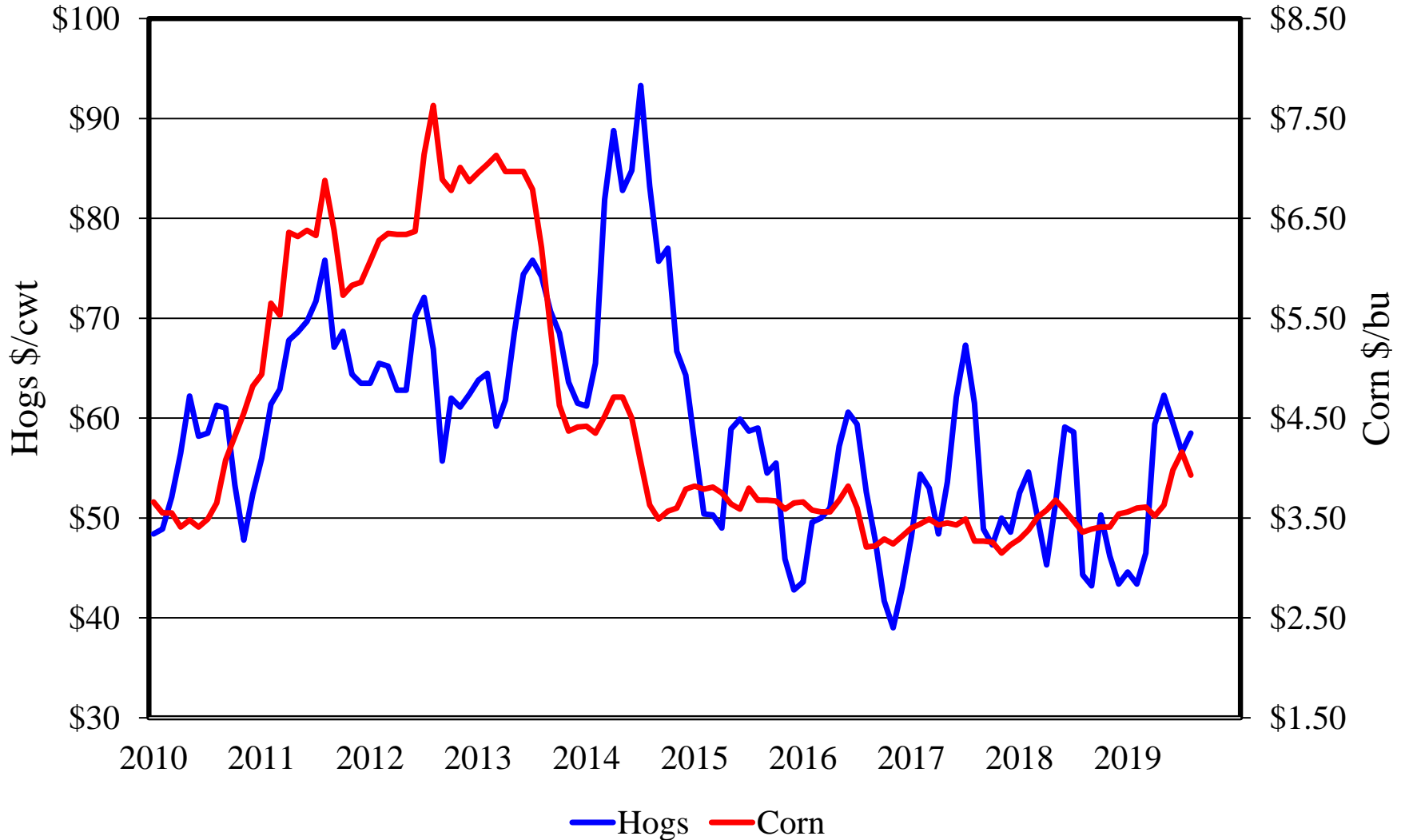


# Canadian Imports by Quarter
