



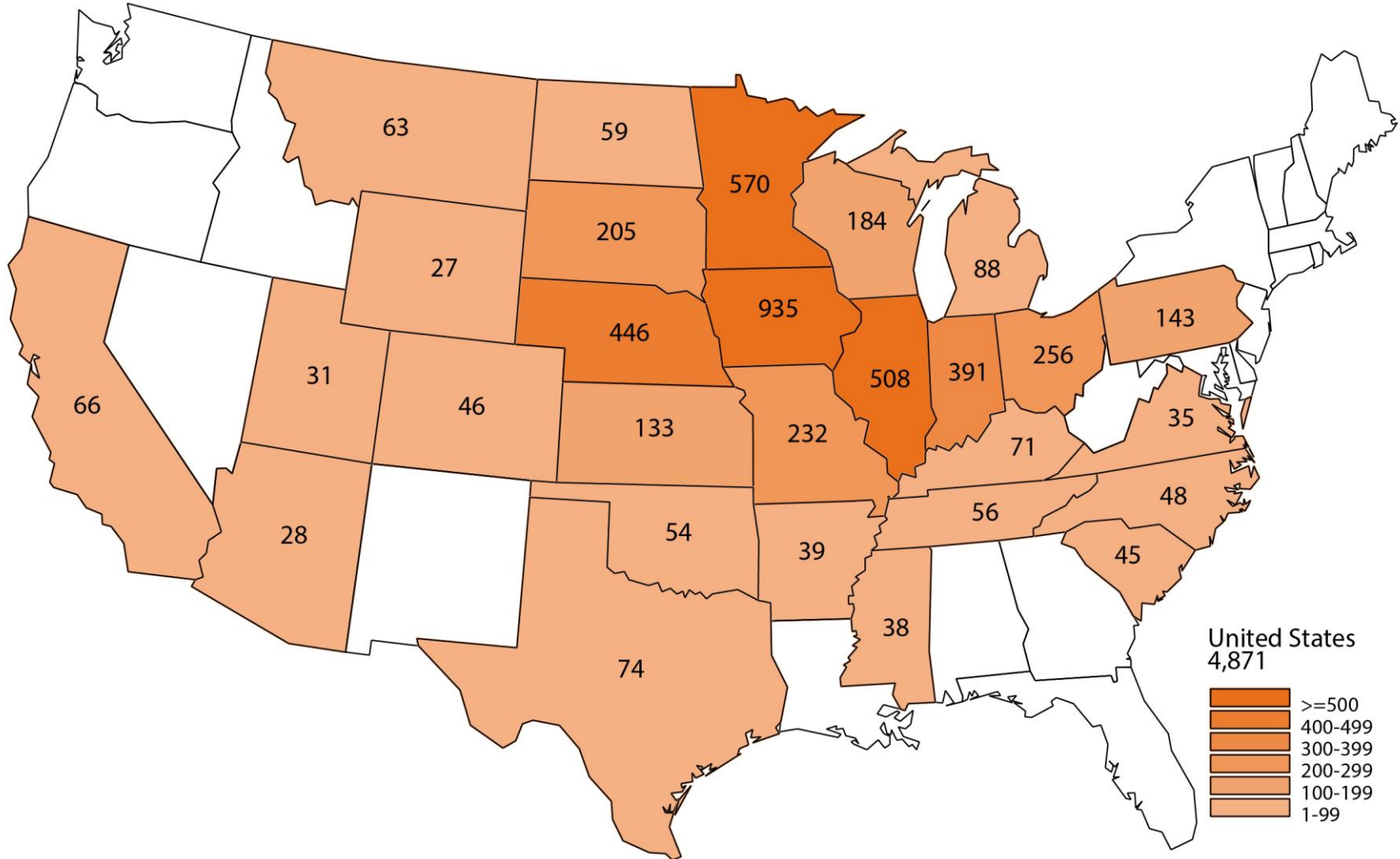

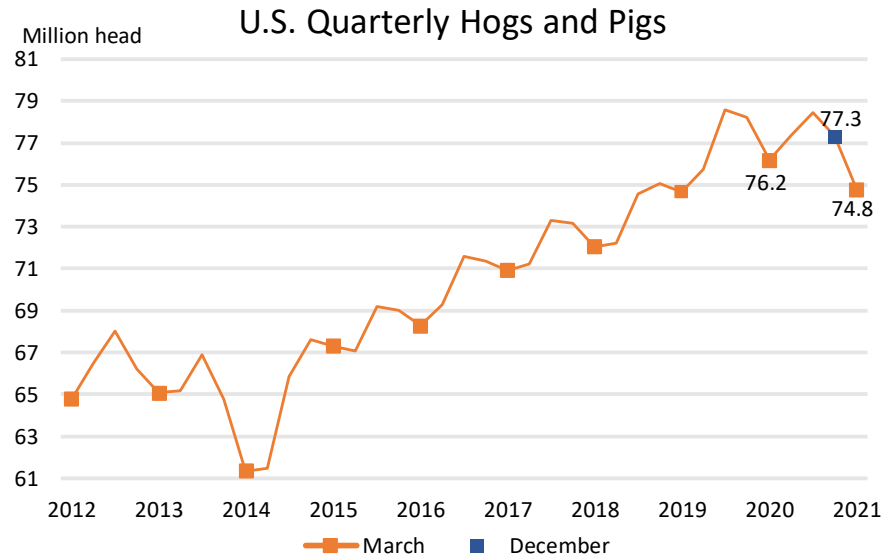

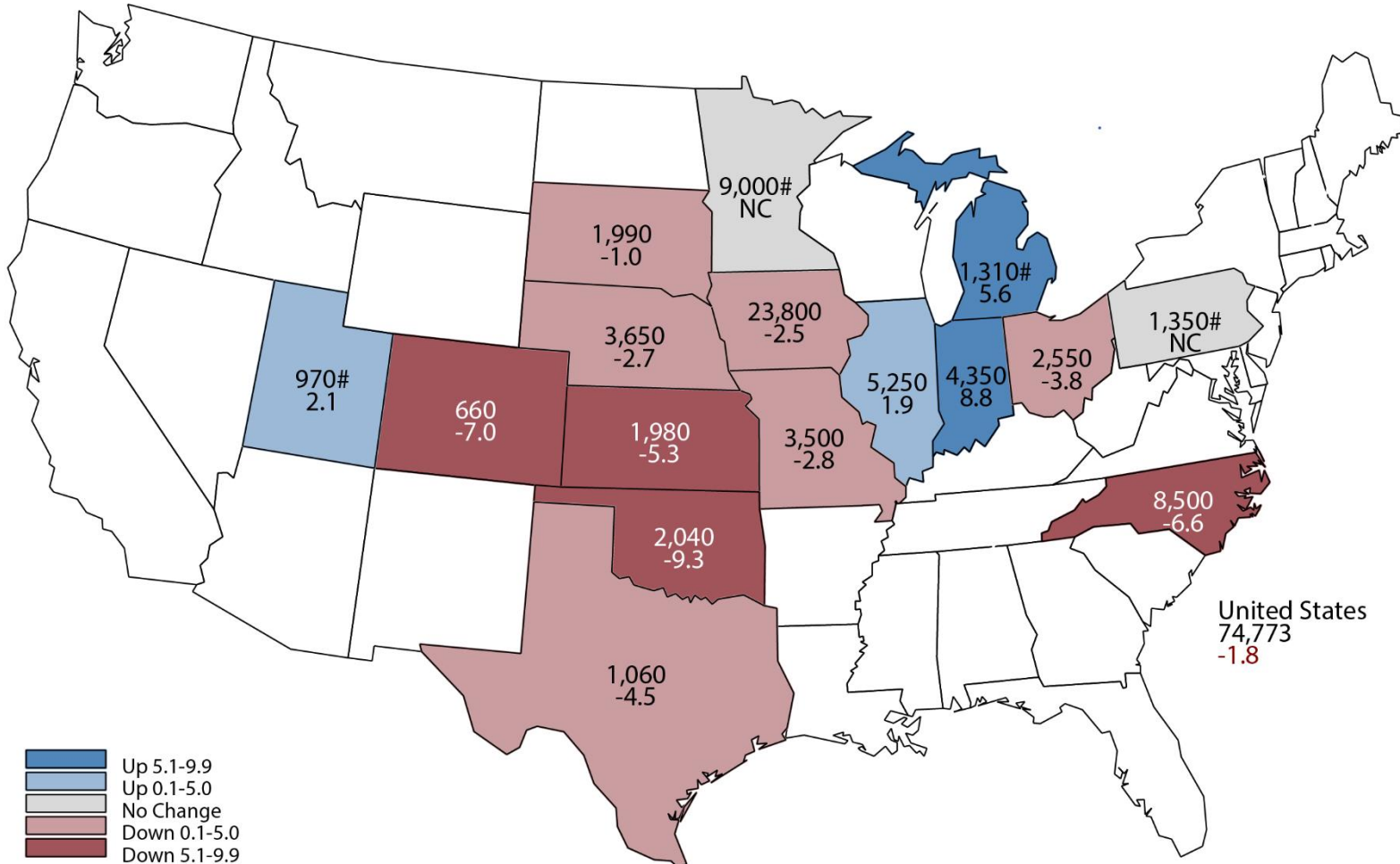

(1,000) Head and Percent Change from Previous Year



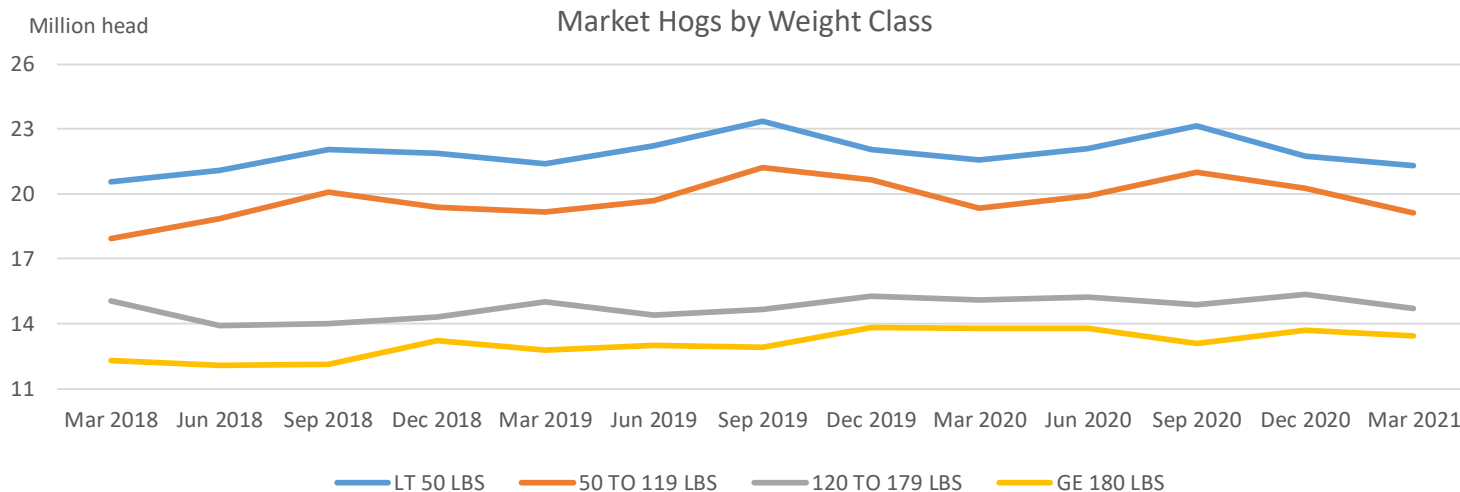

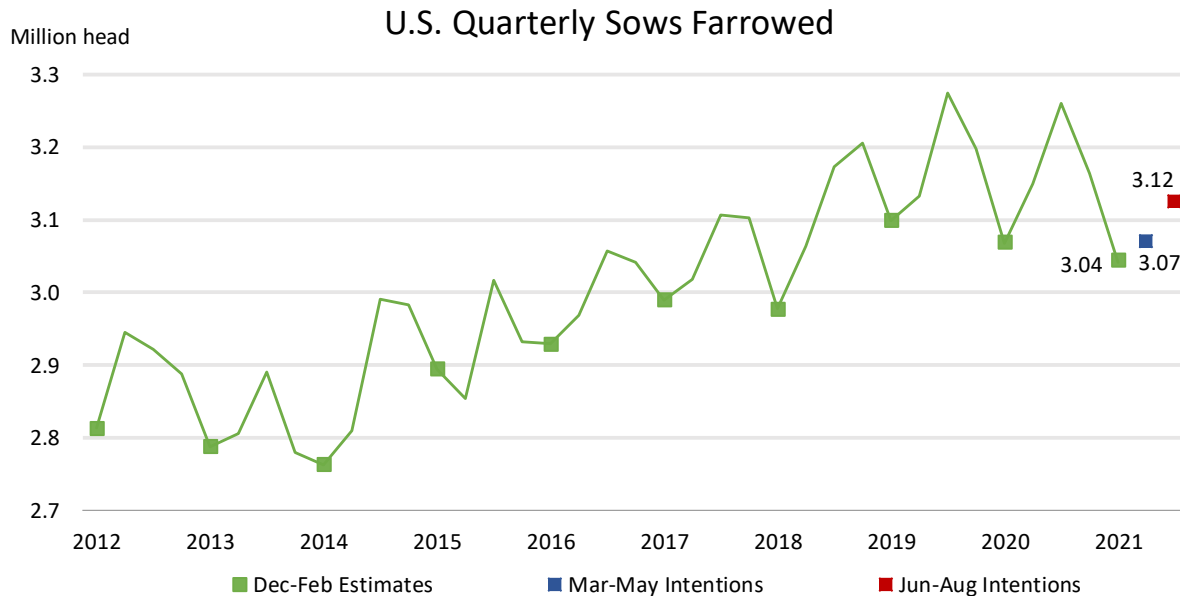

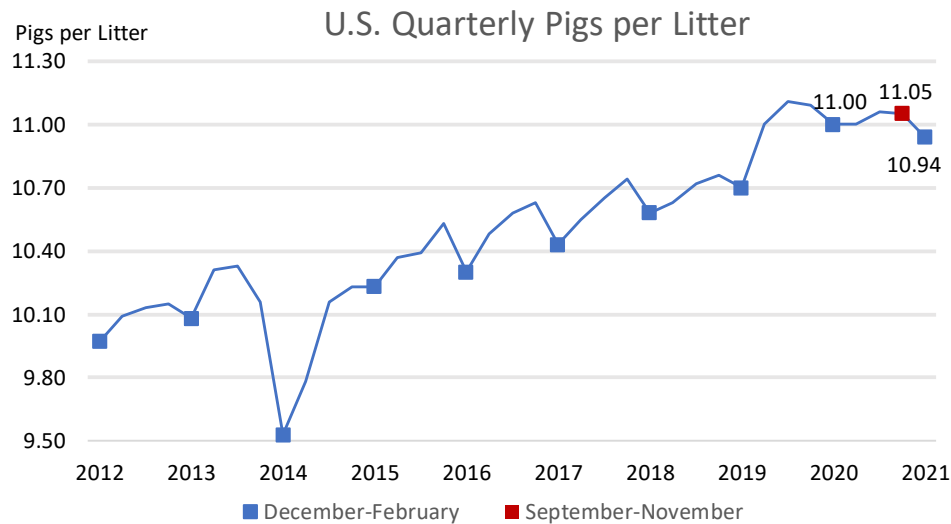

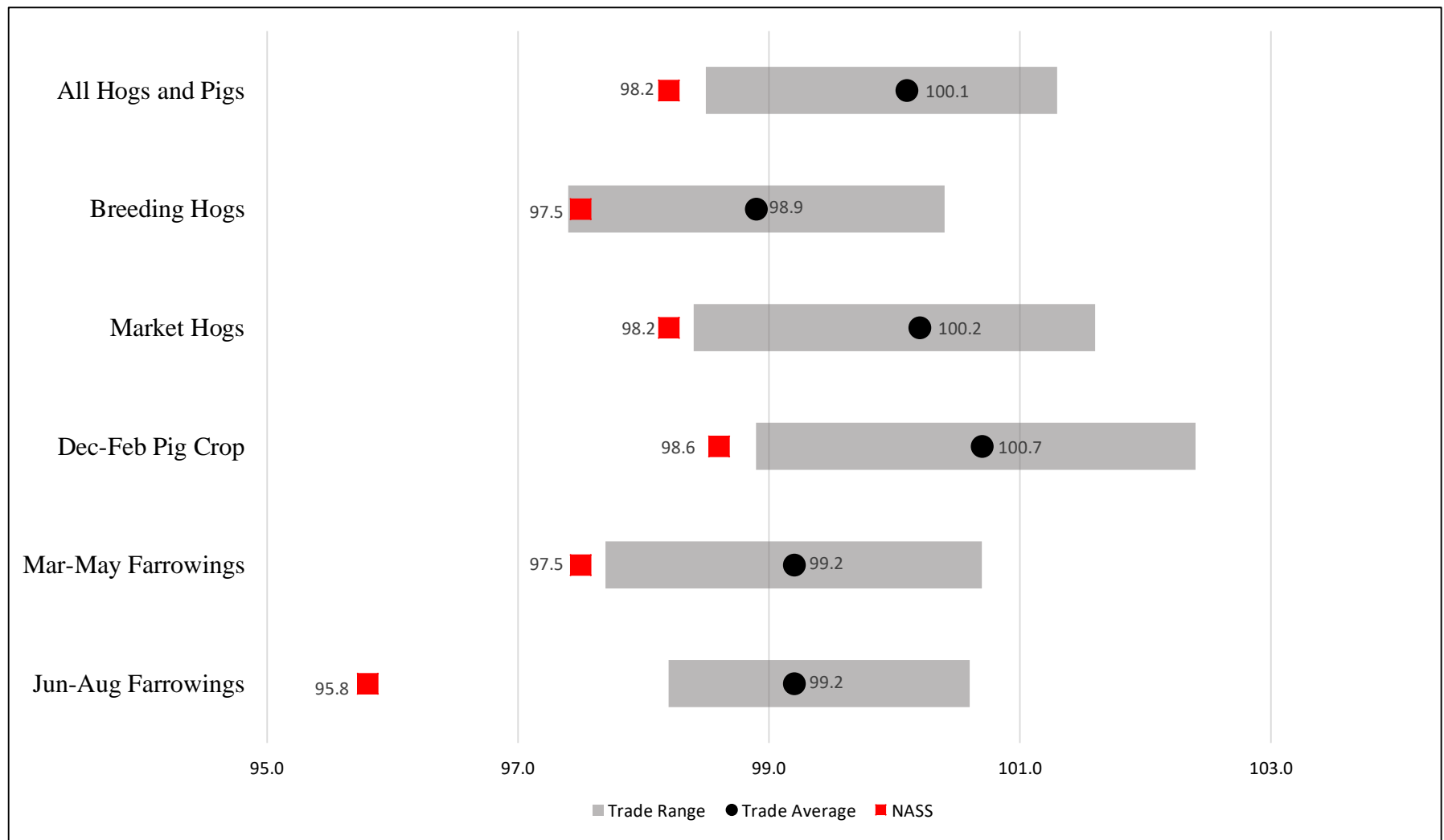

Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year

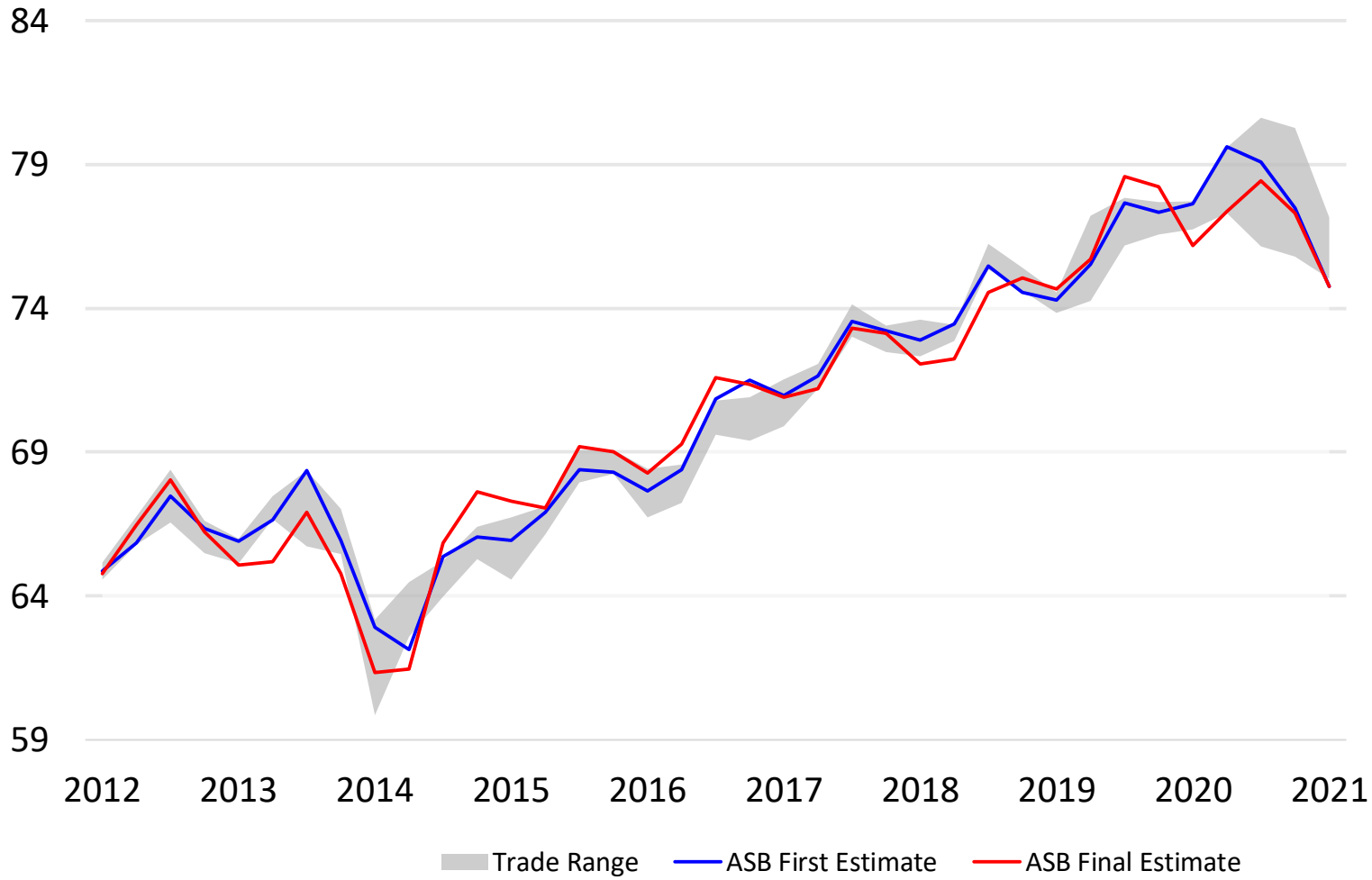




All Hogs and Pigs First Estimate vs Final Estimate

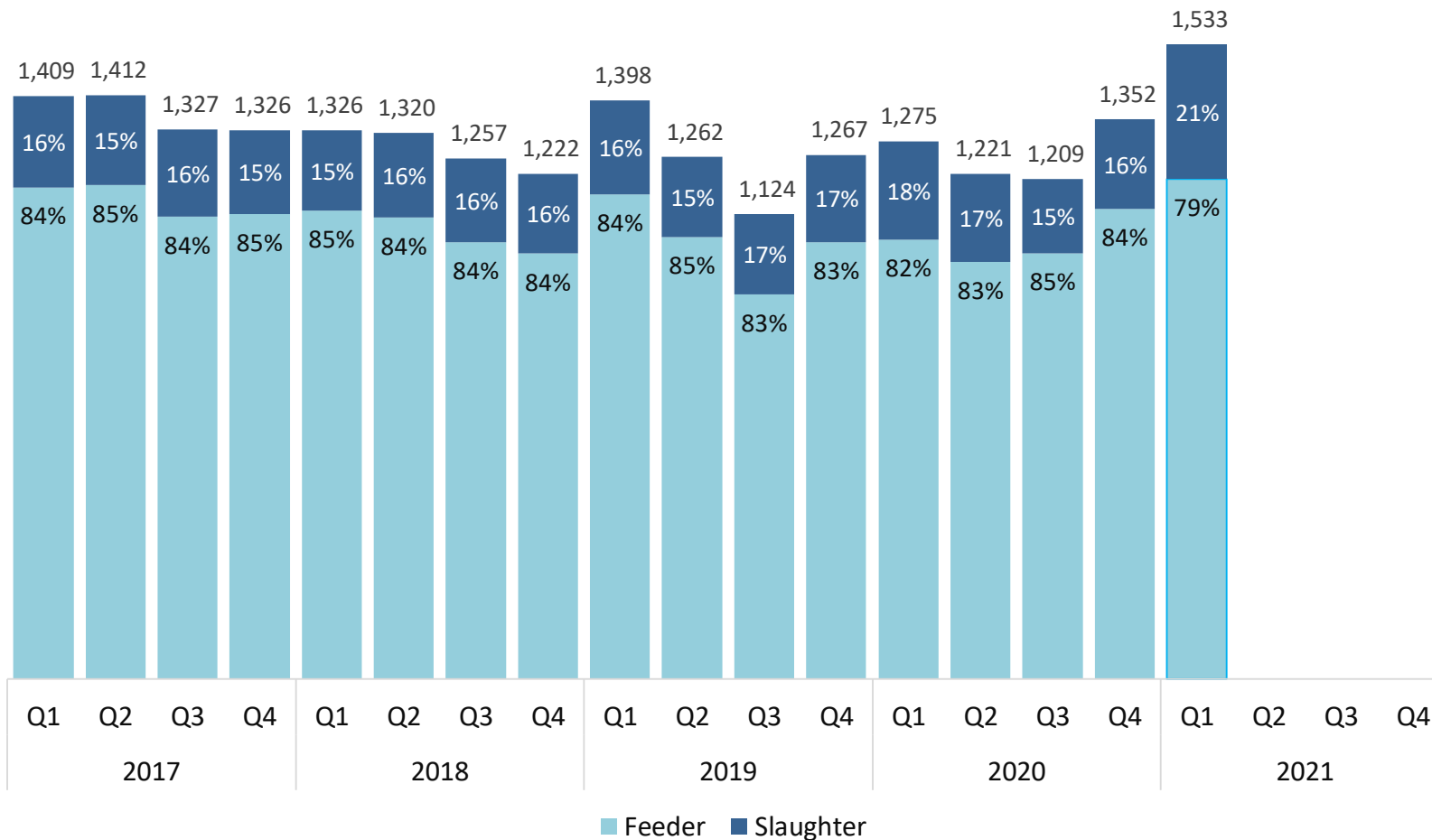

Canadian Imports by Quarter

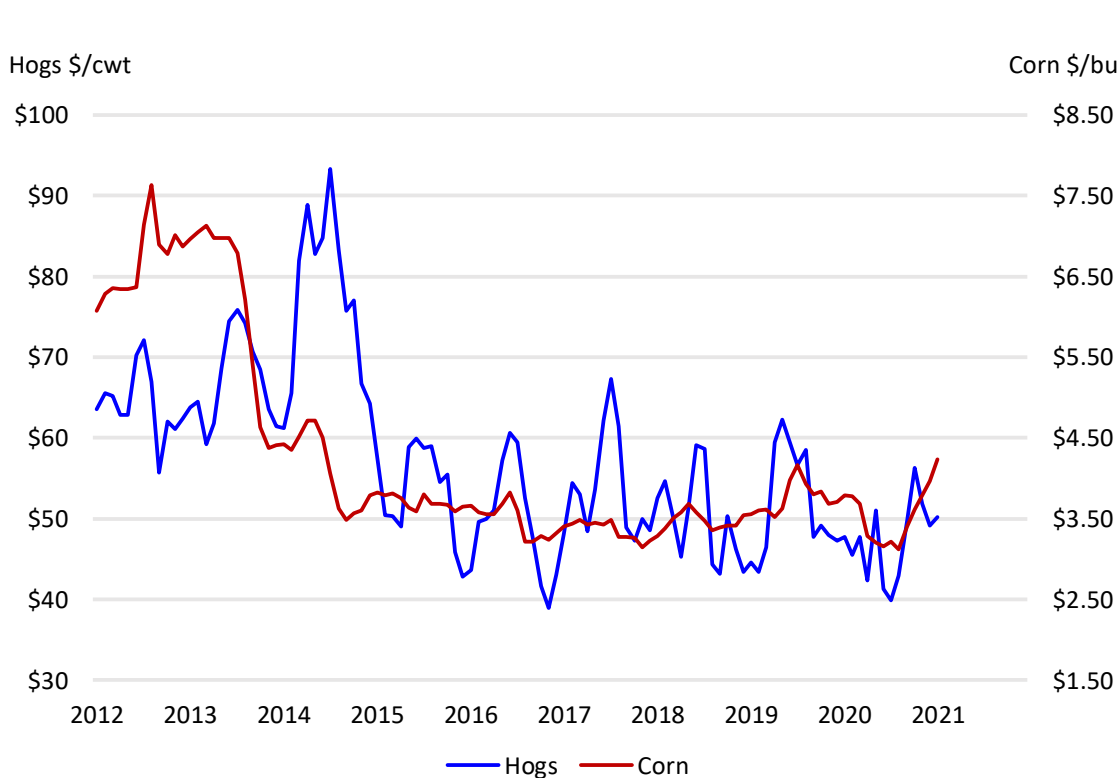
Feeder Pigs and Slaughter Hogs
