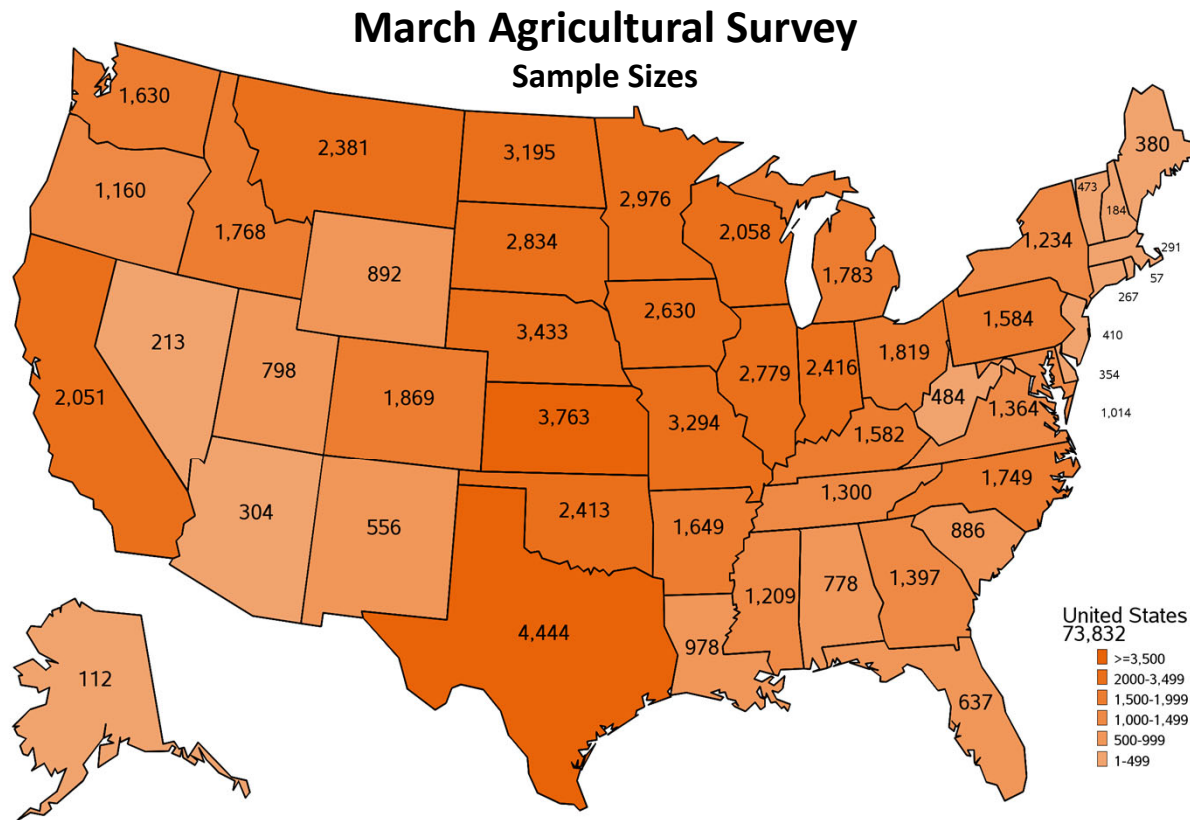

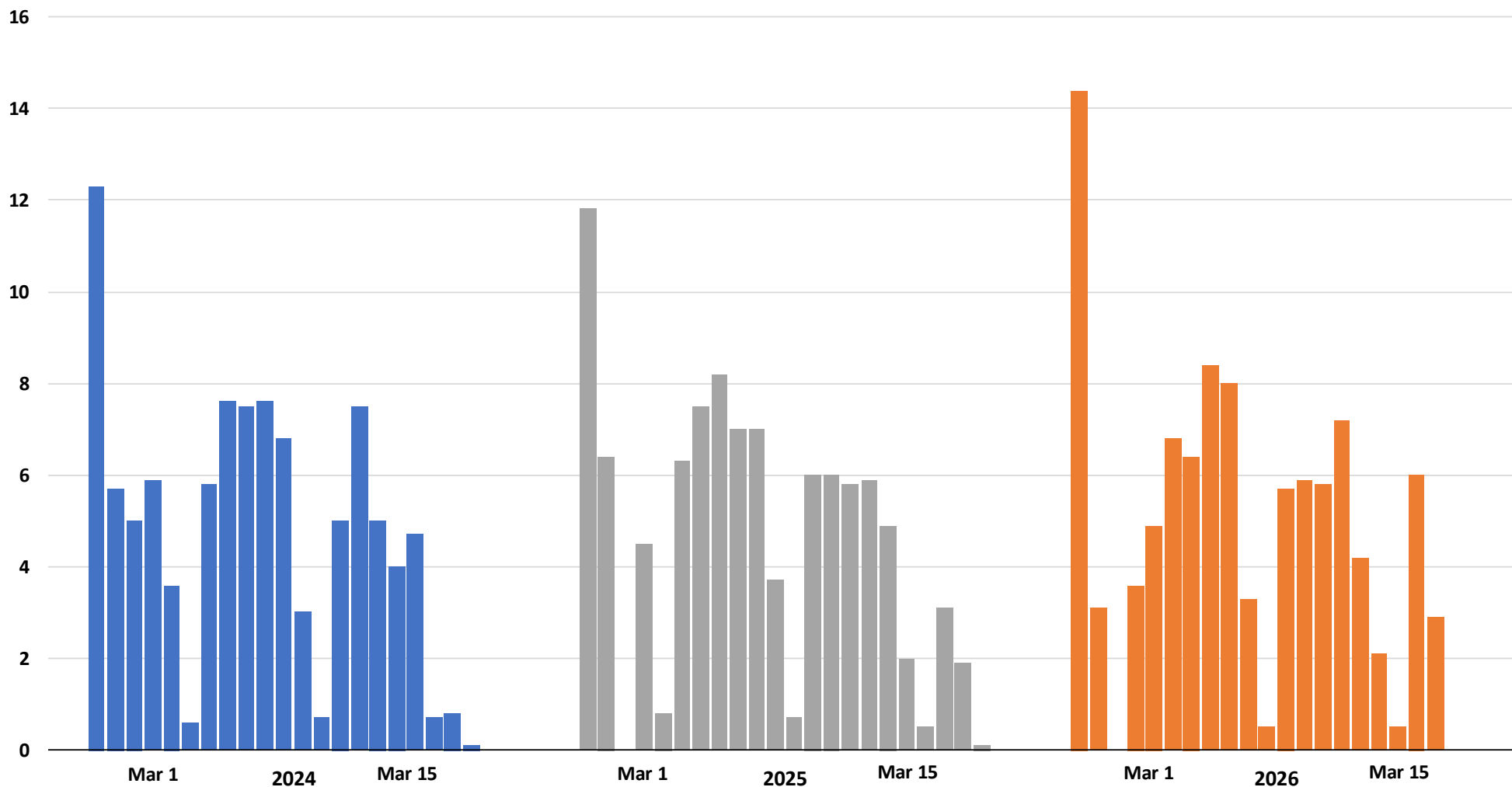

Usable Responses by Day

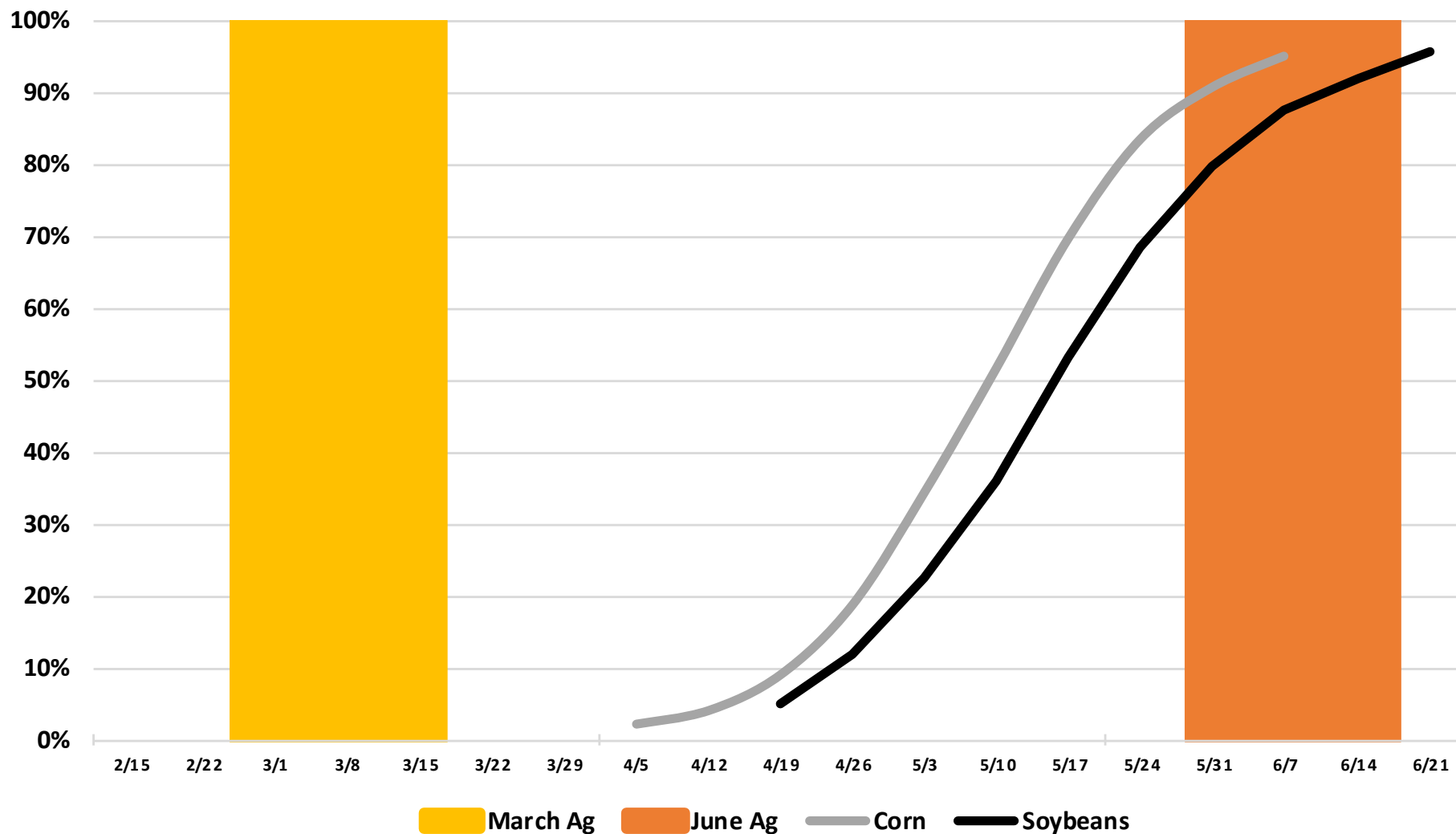

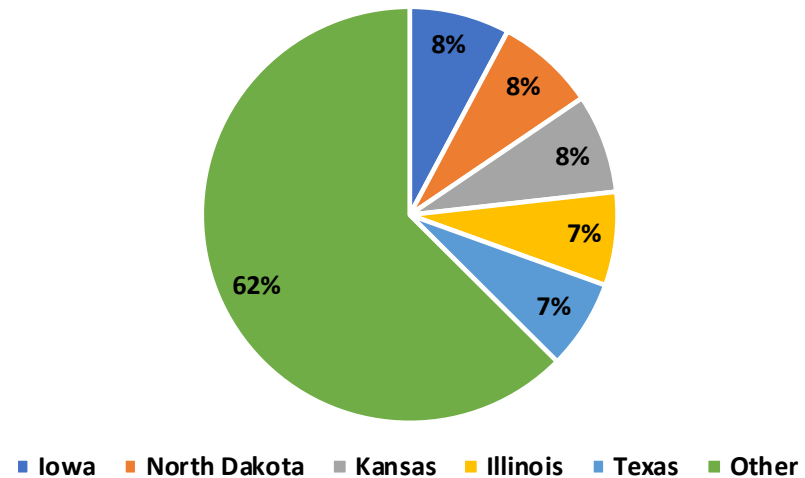

By State

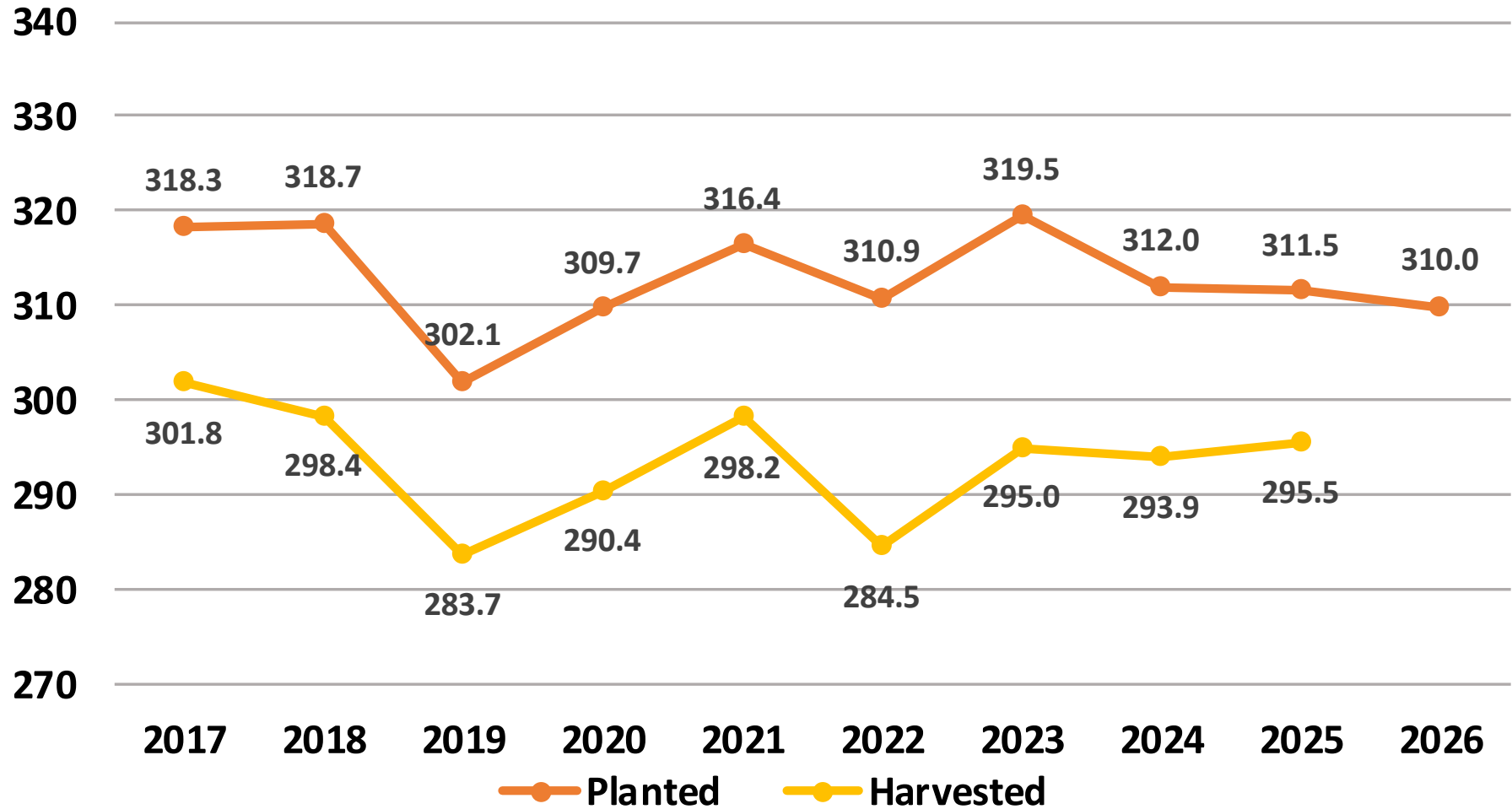

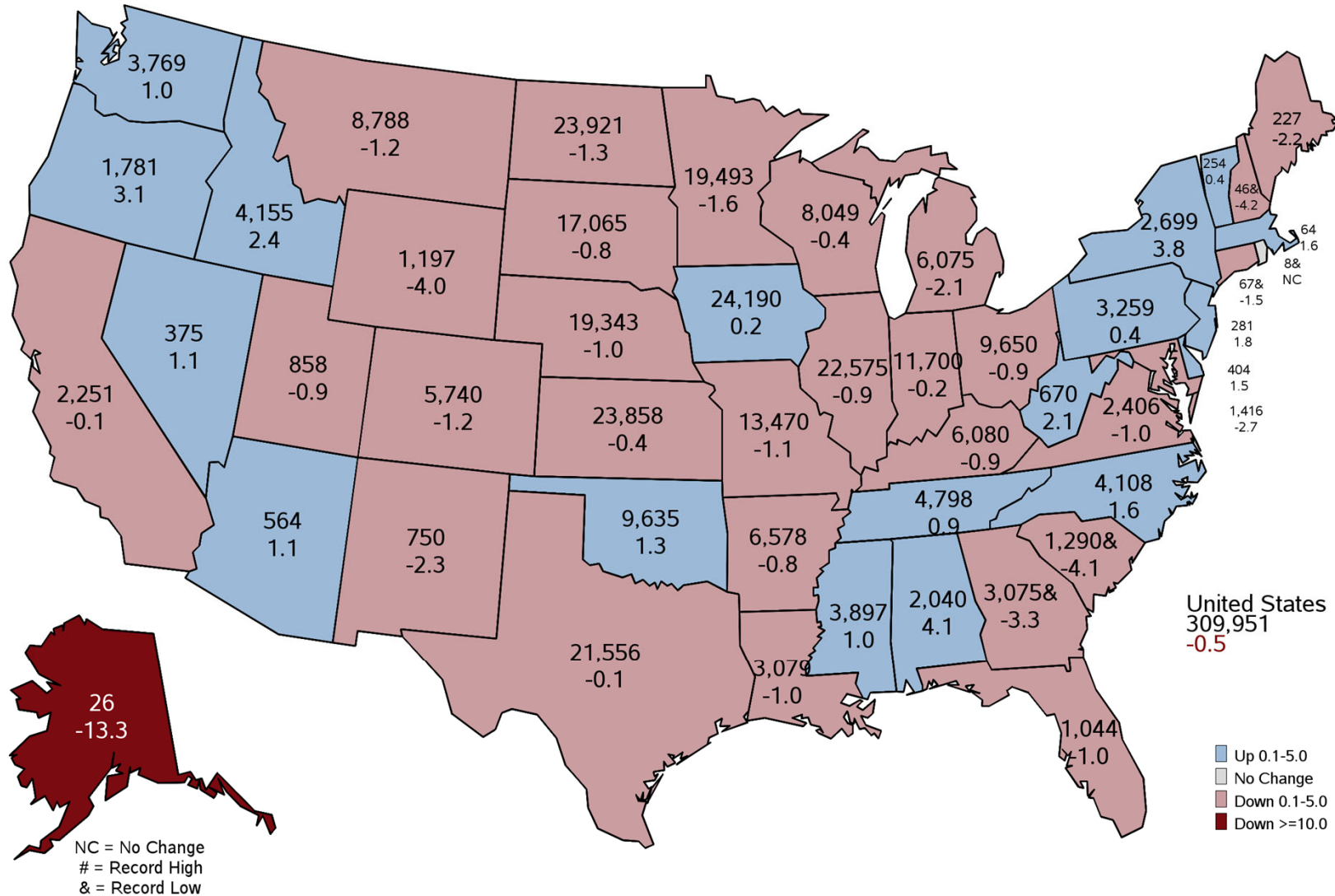

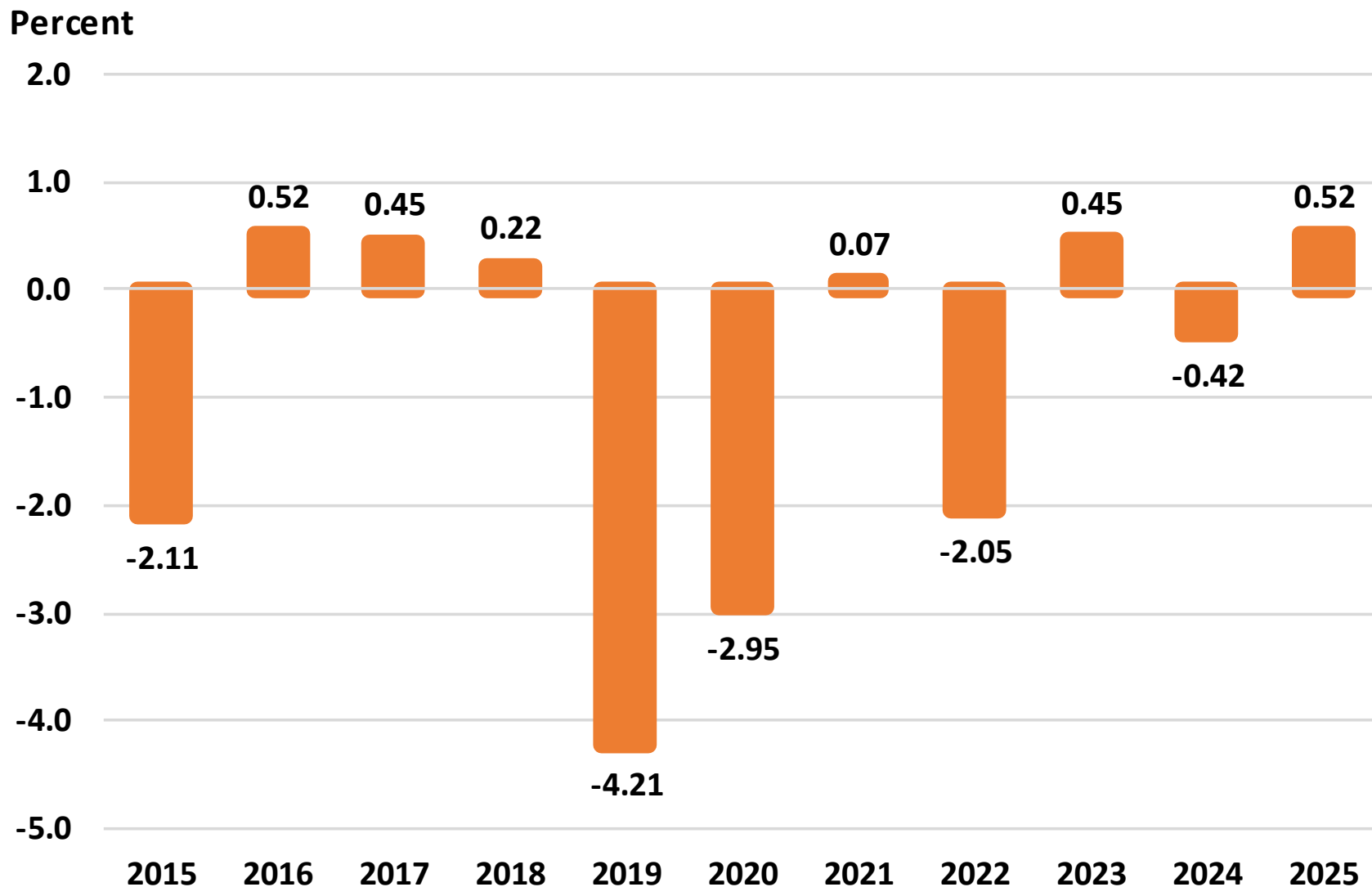

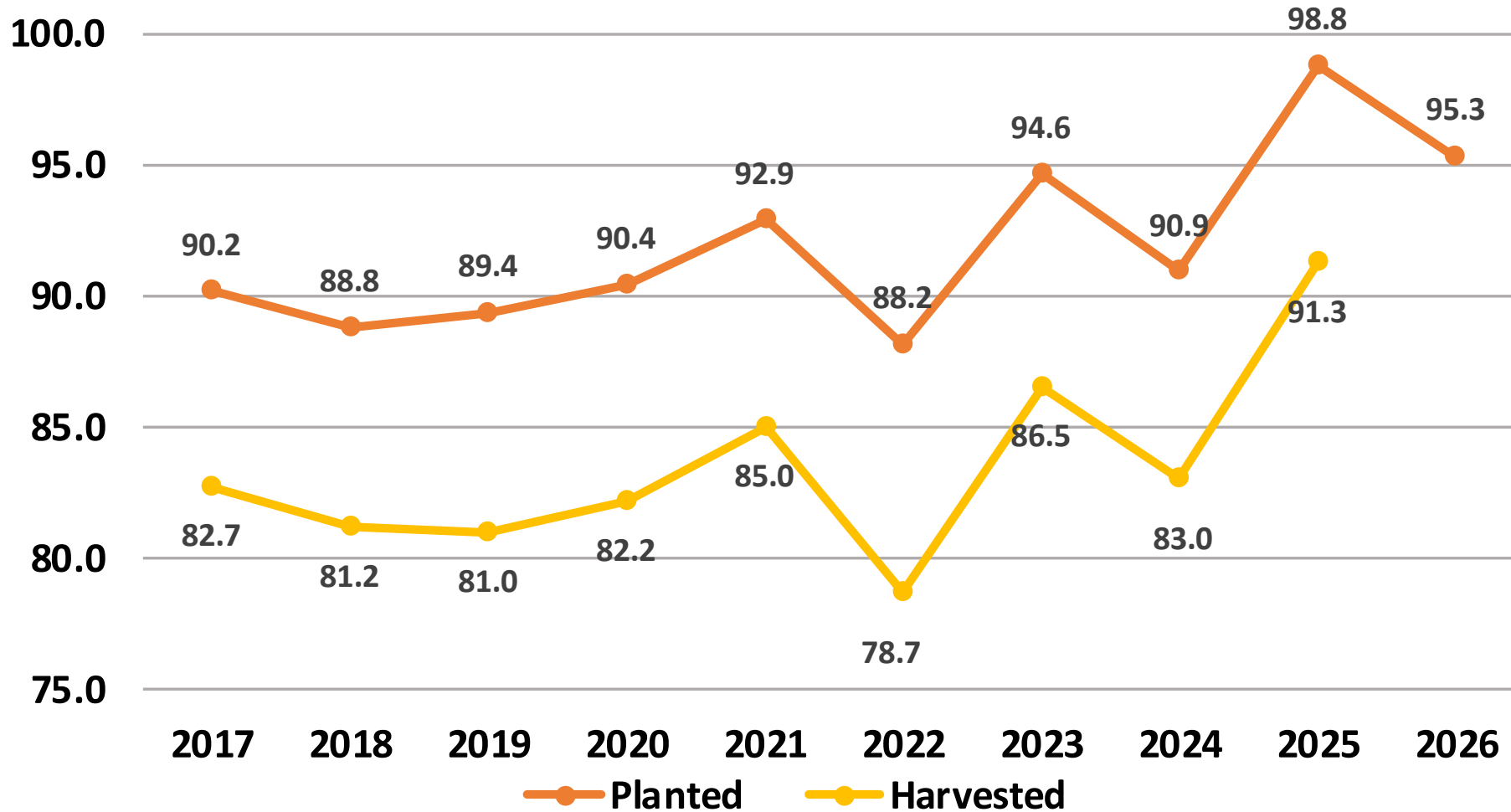

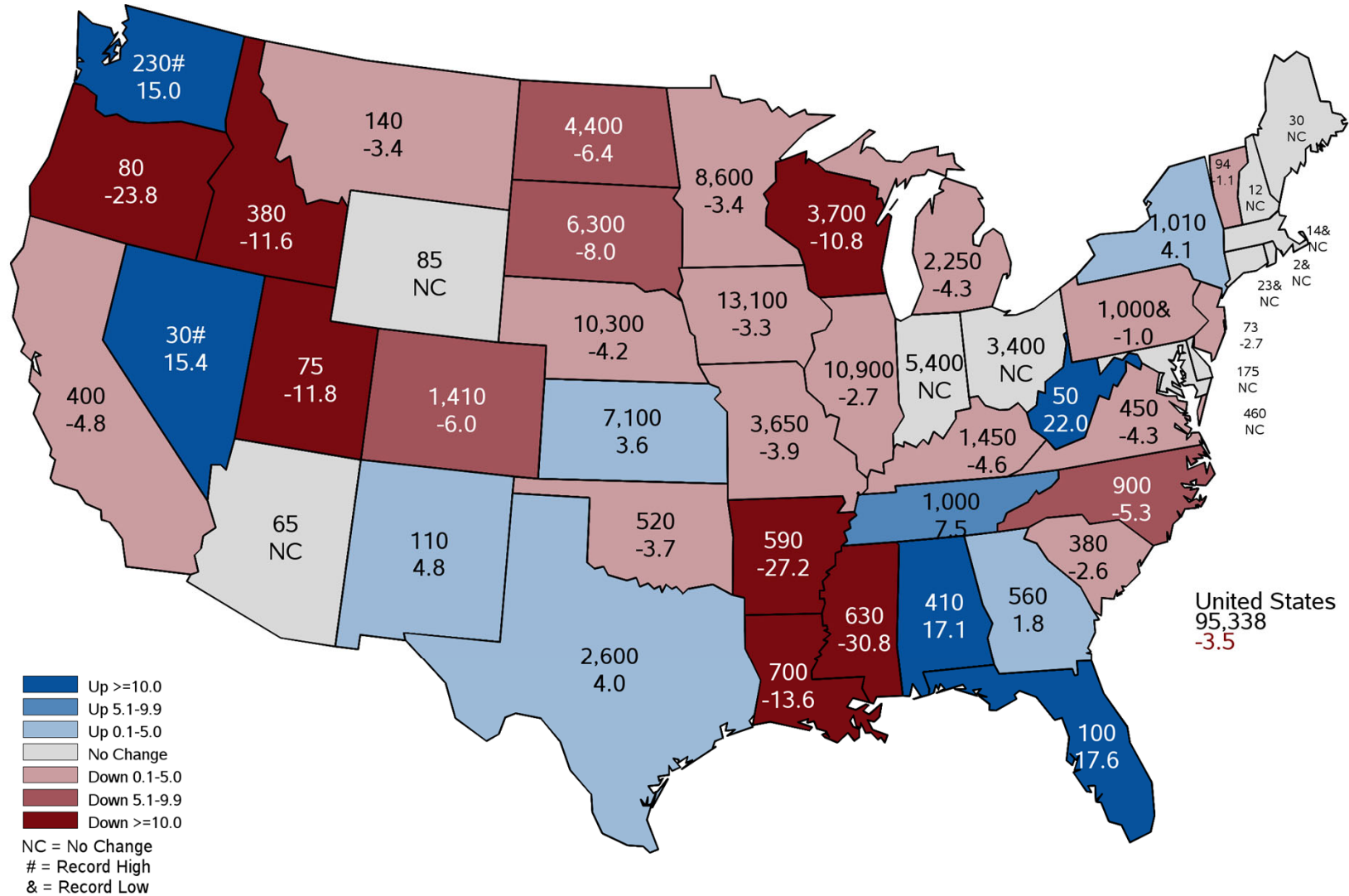

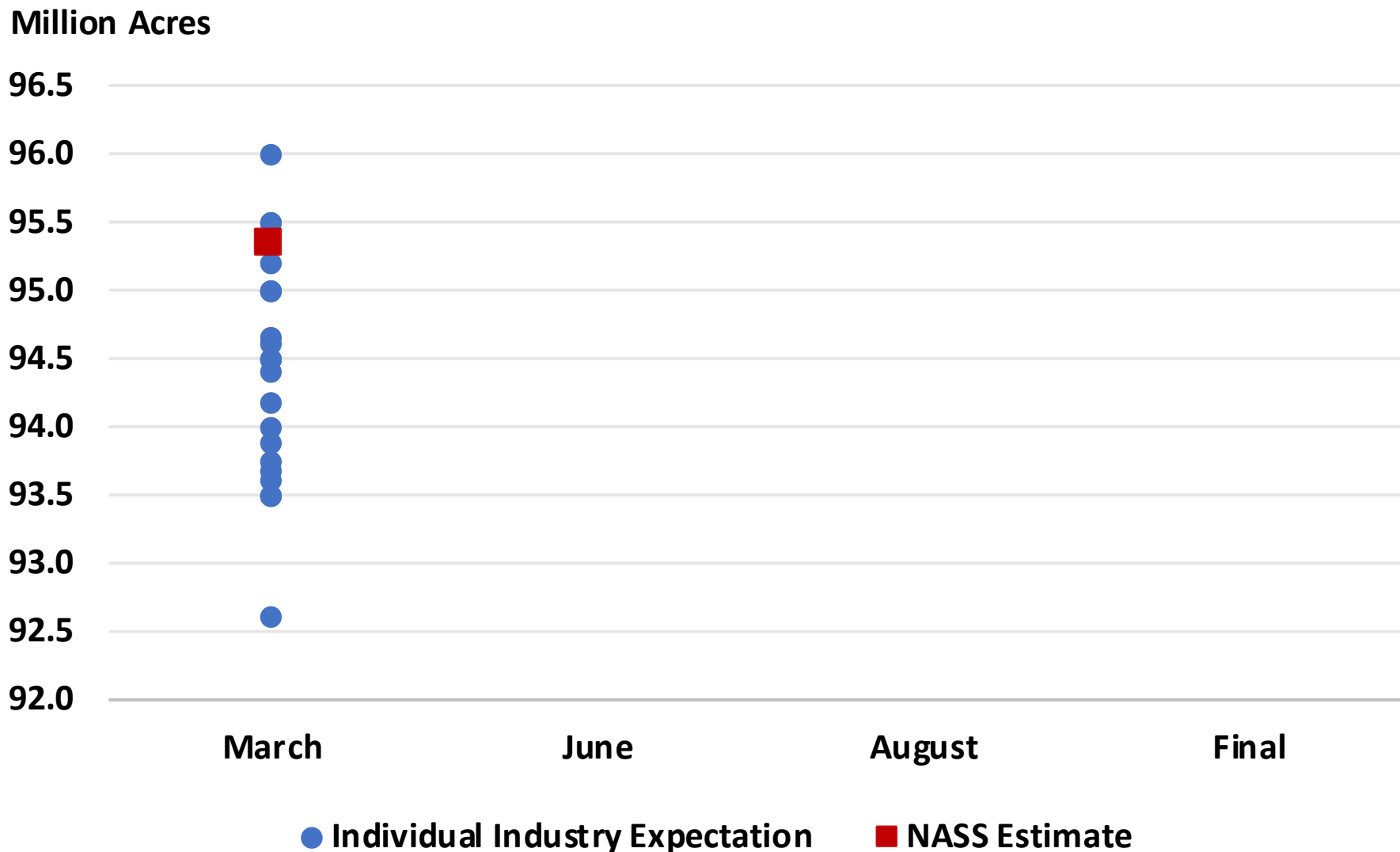

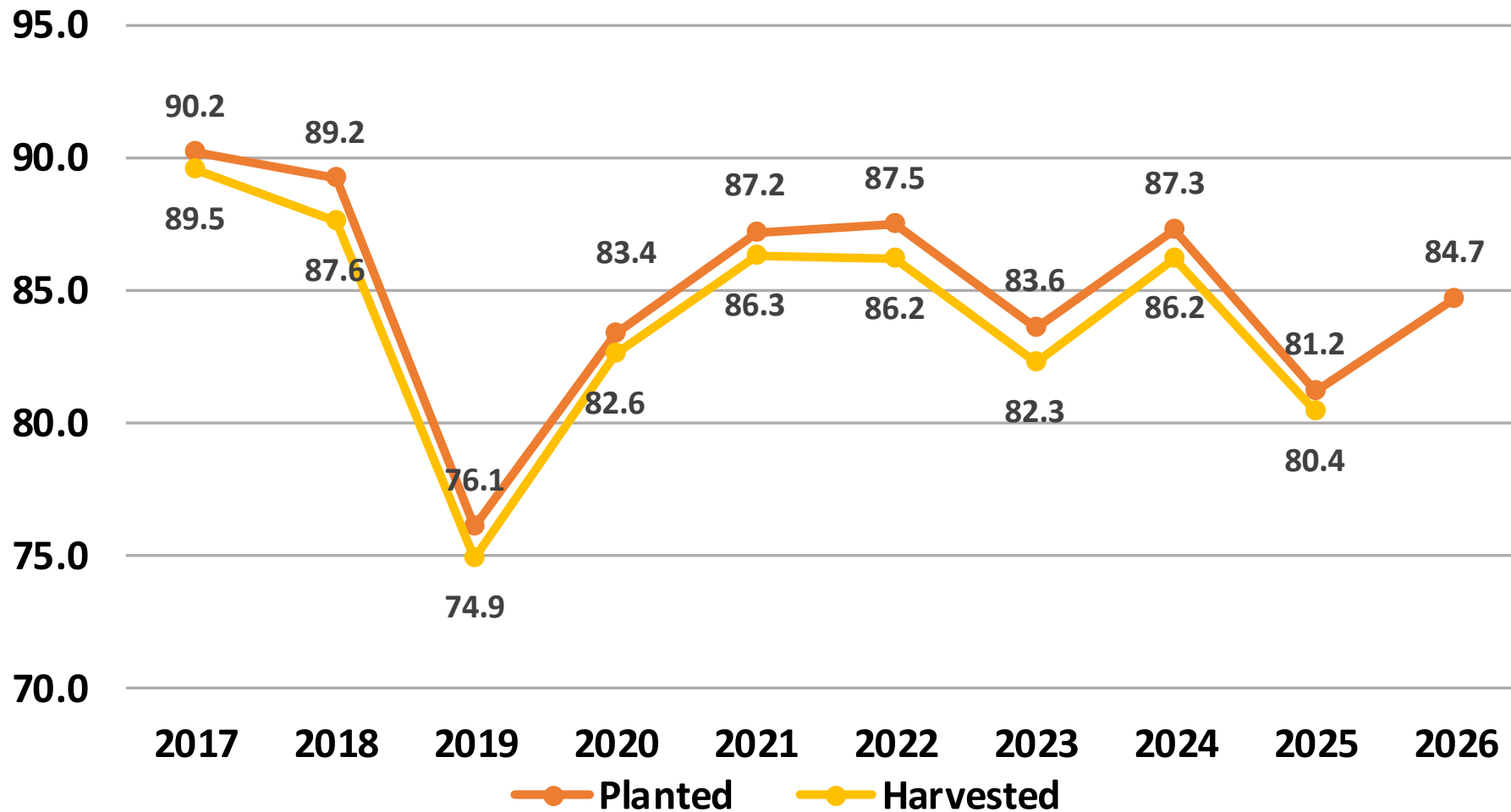

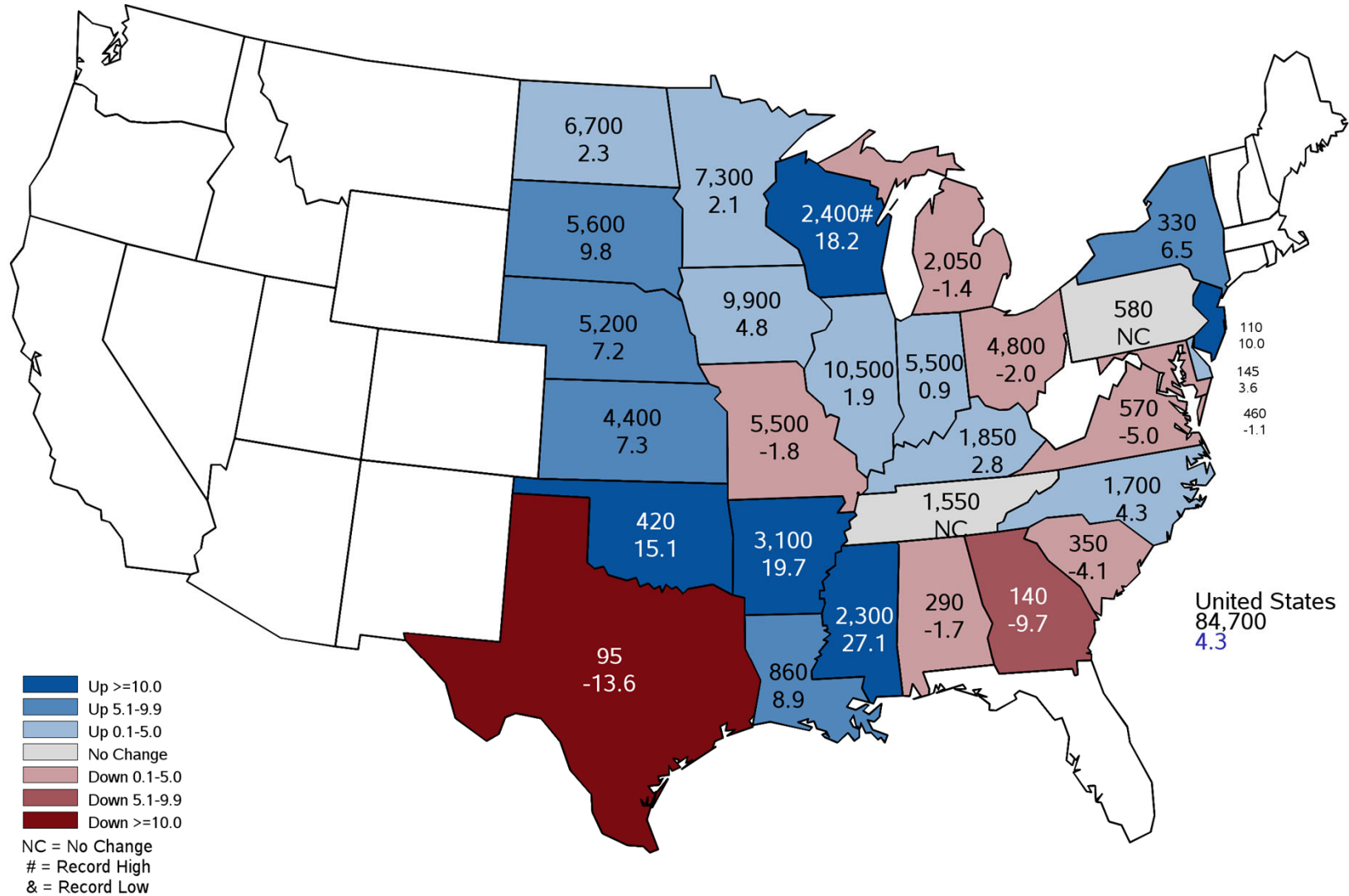

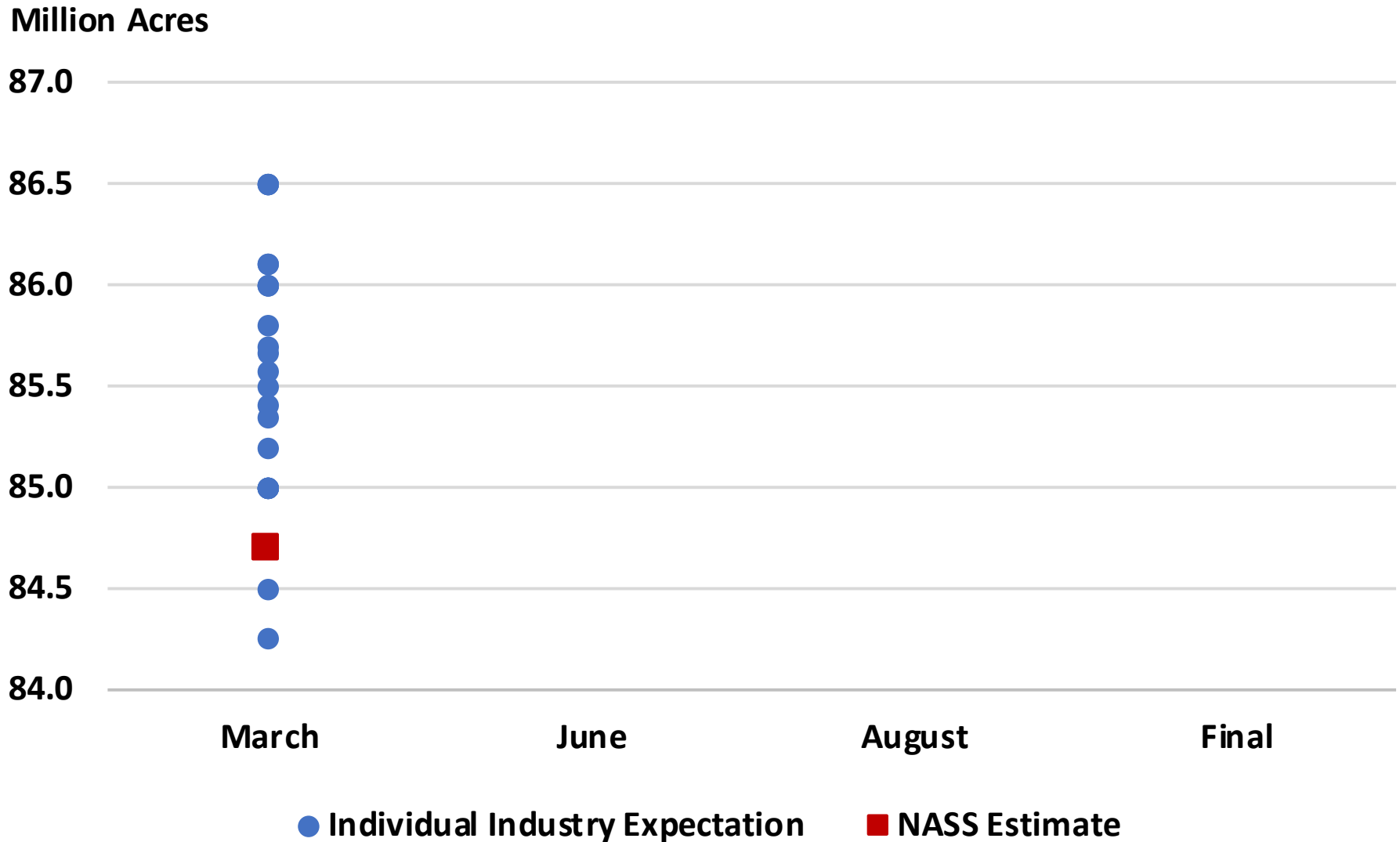

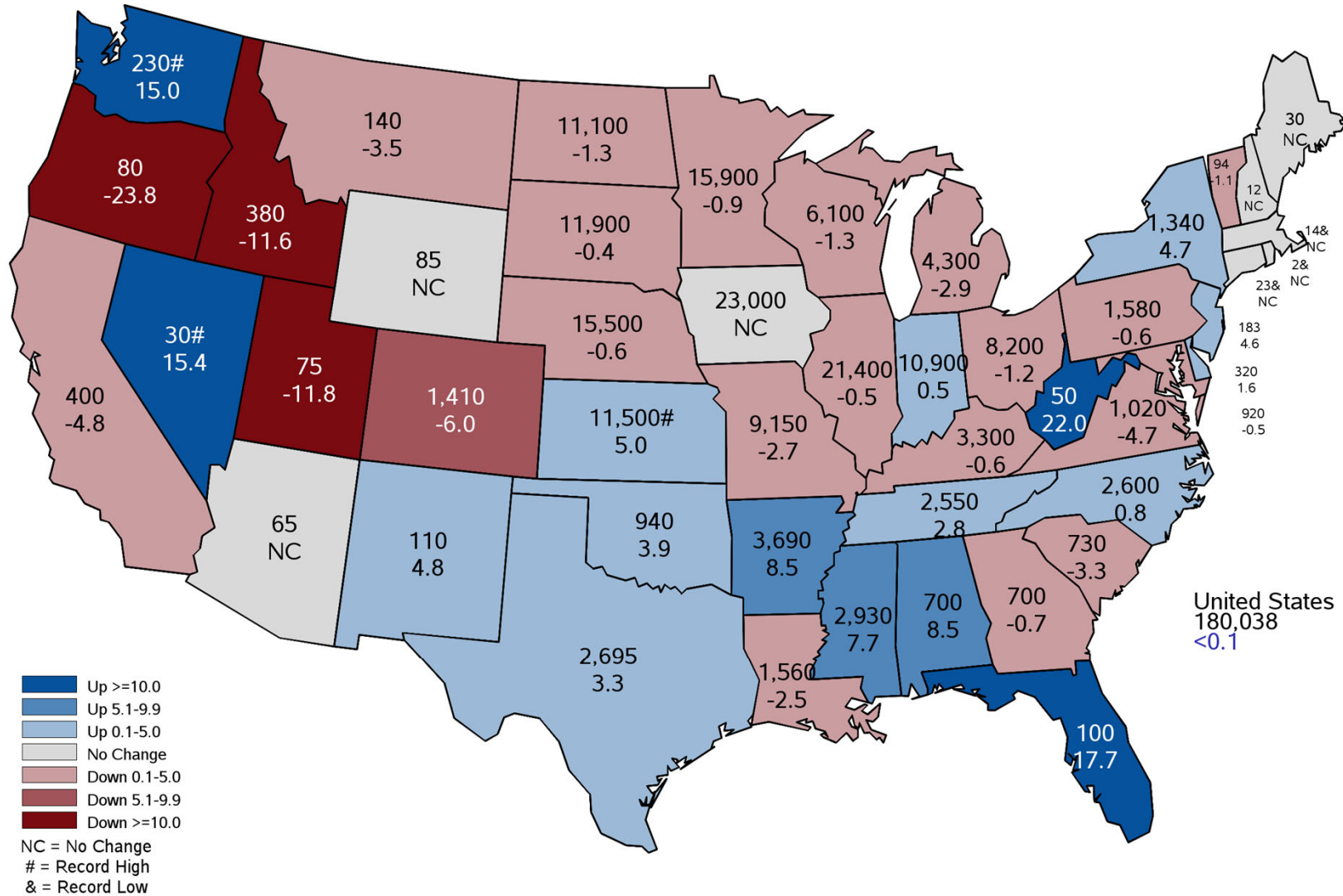

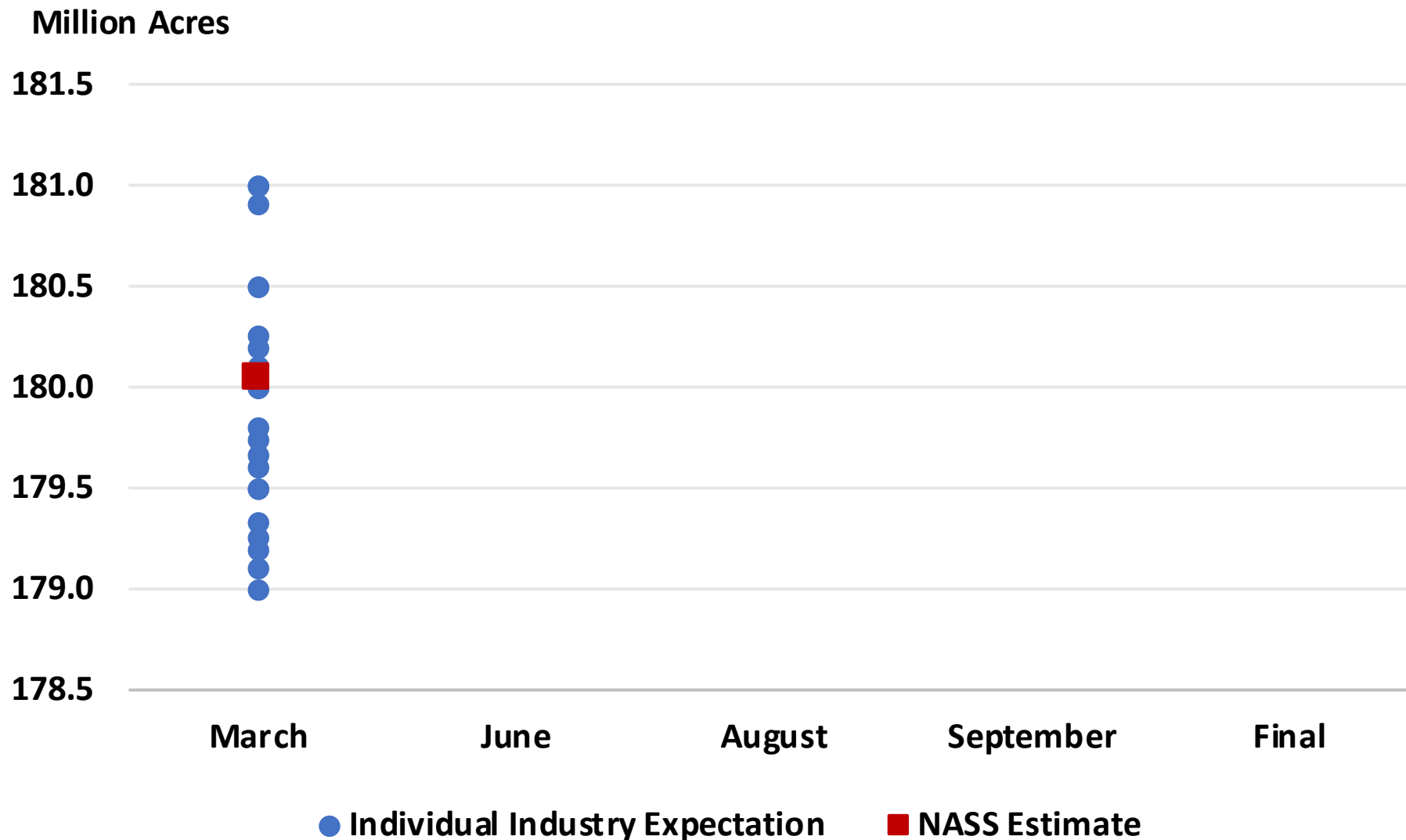

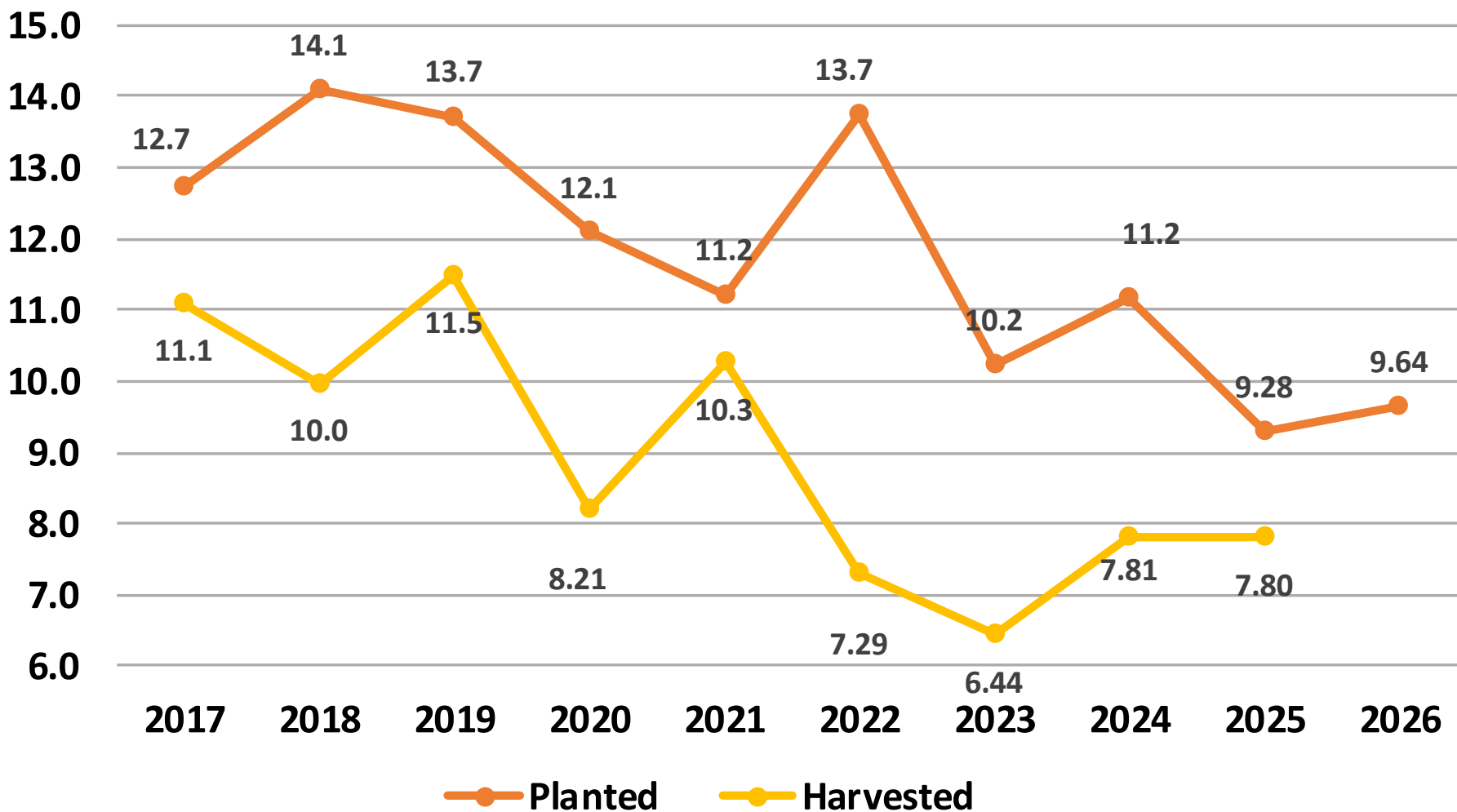

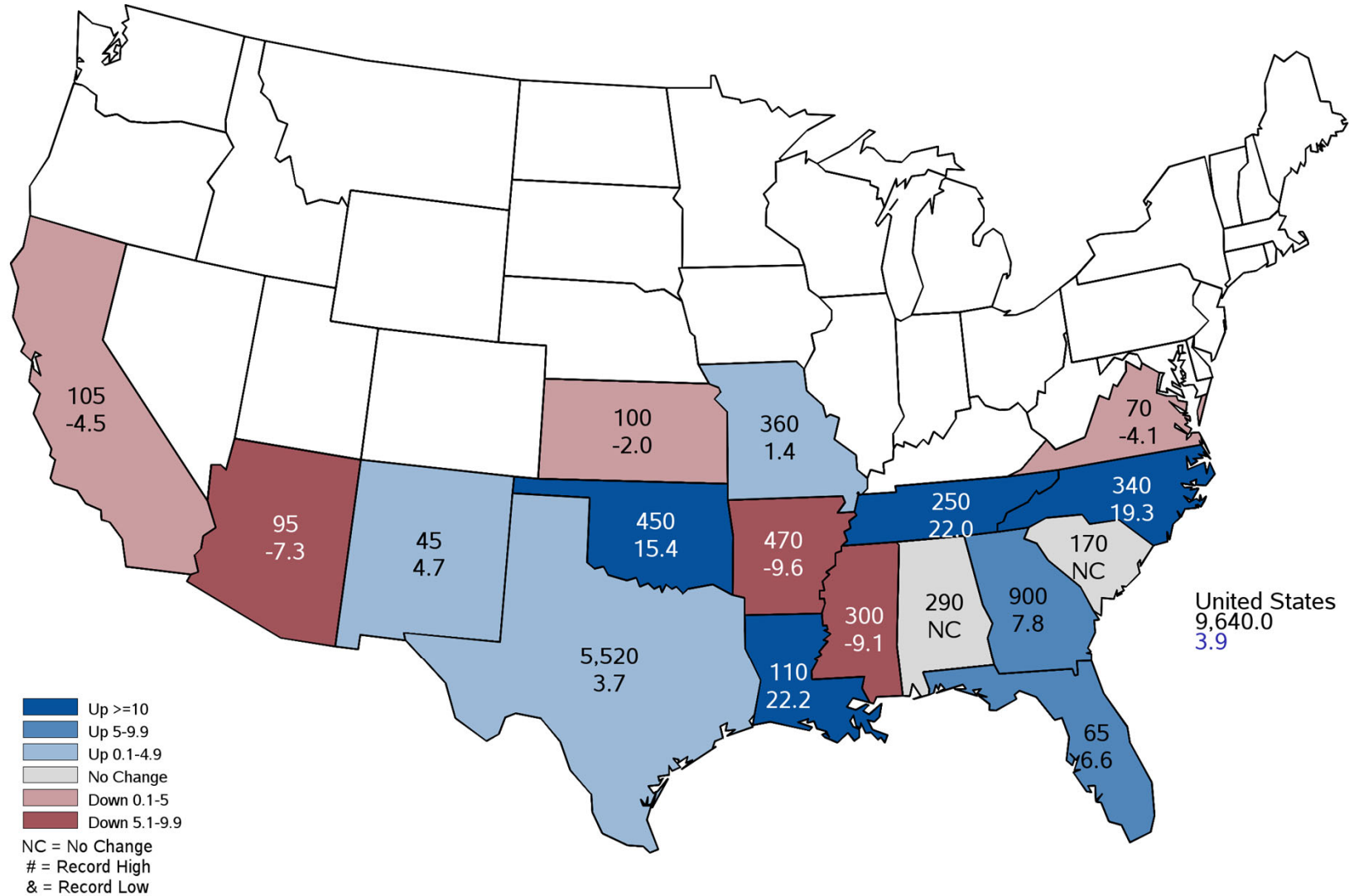

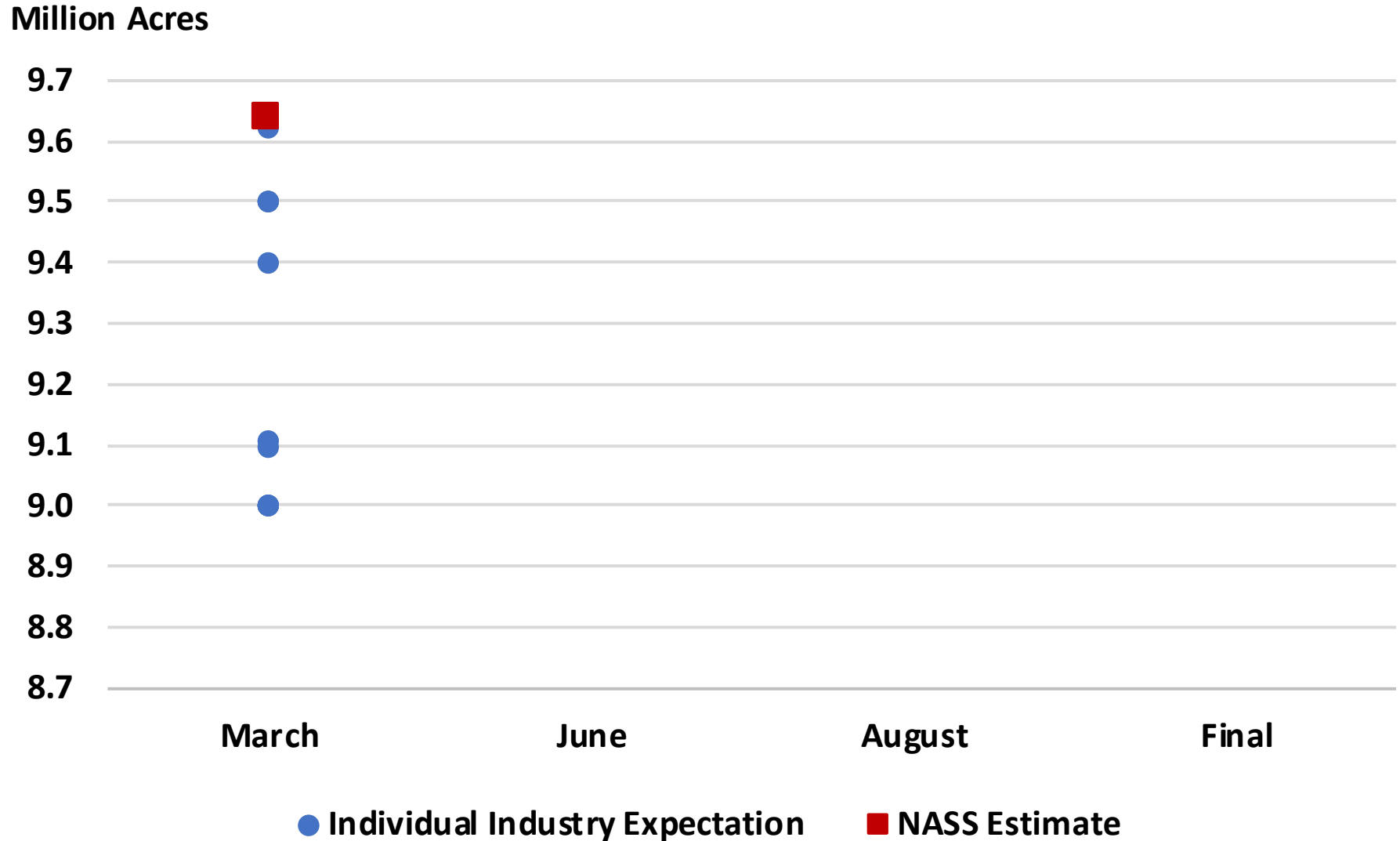

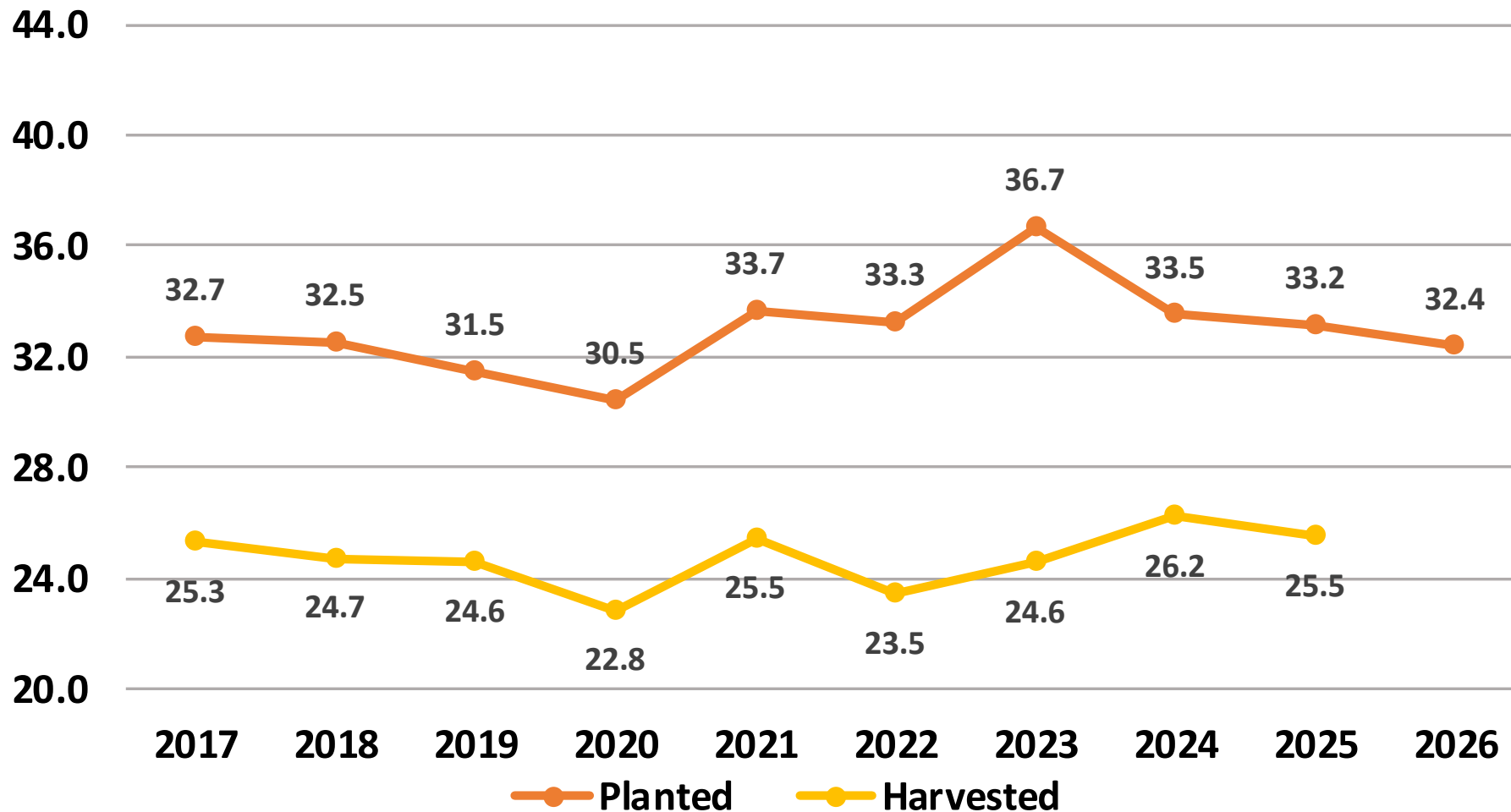

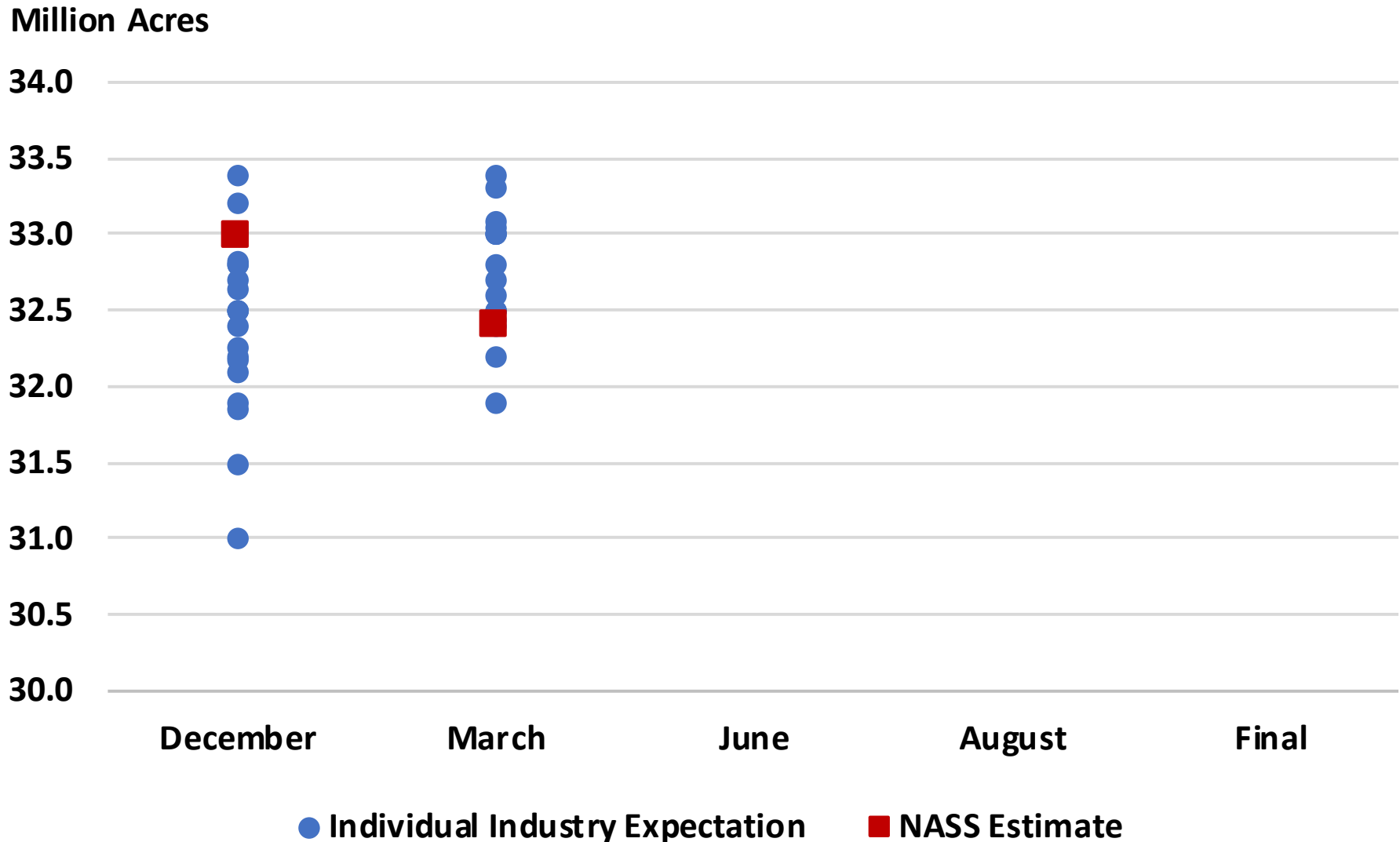




2026 U.S. Winter Wheat Planted Acres

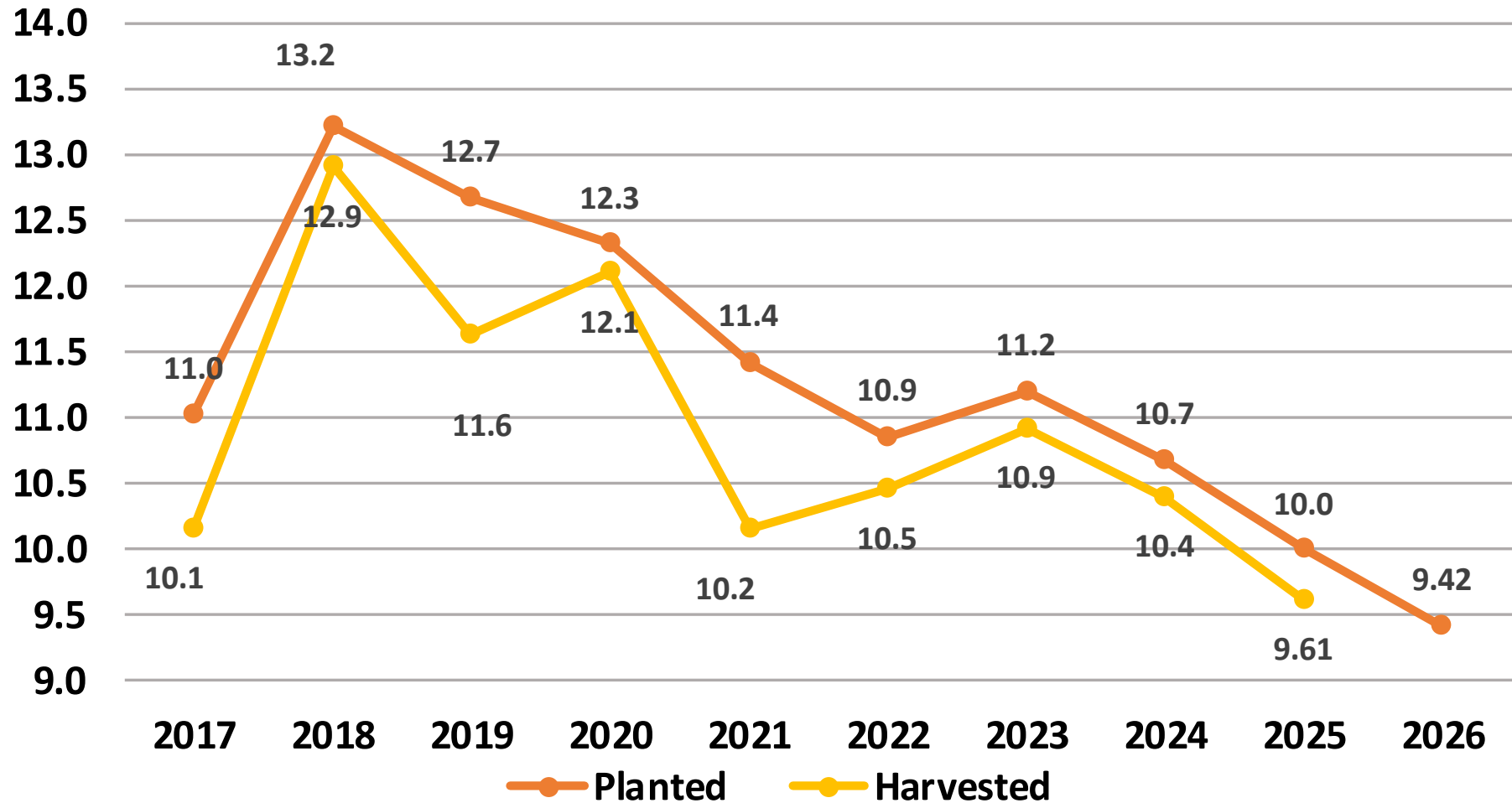

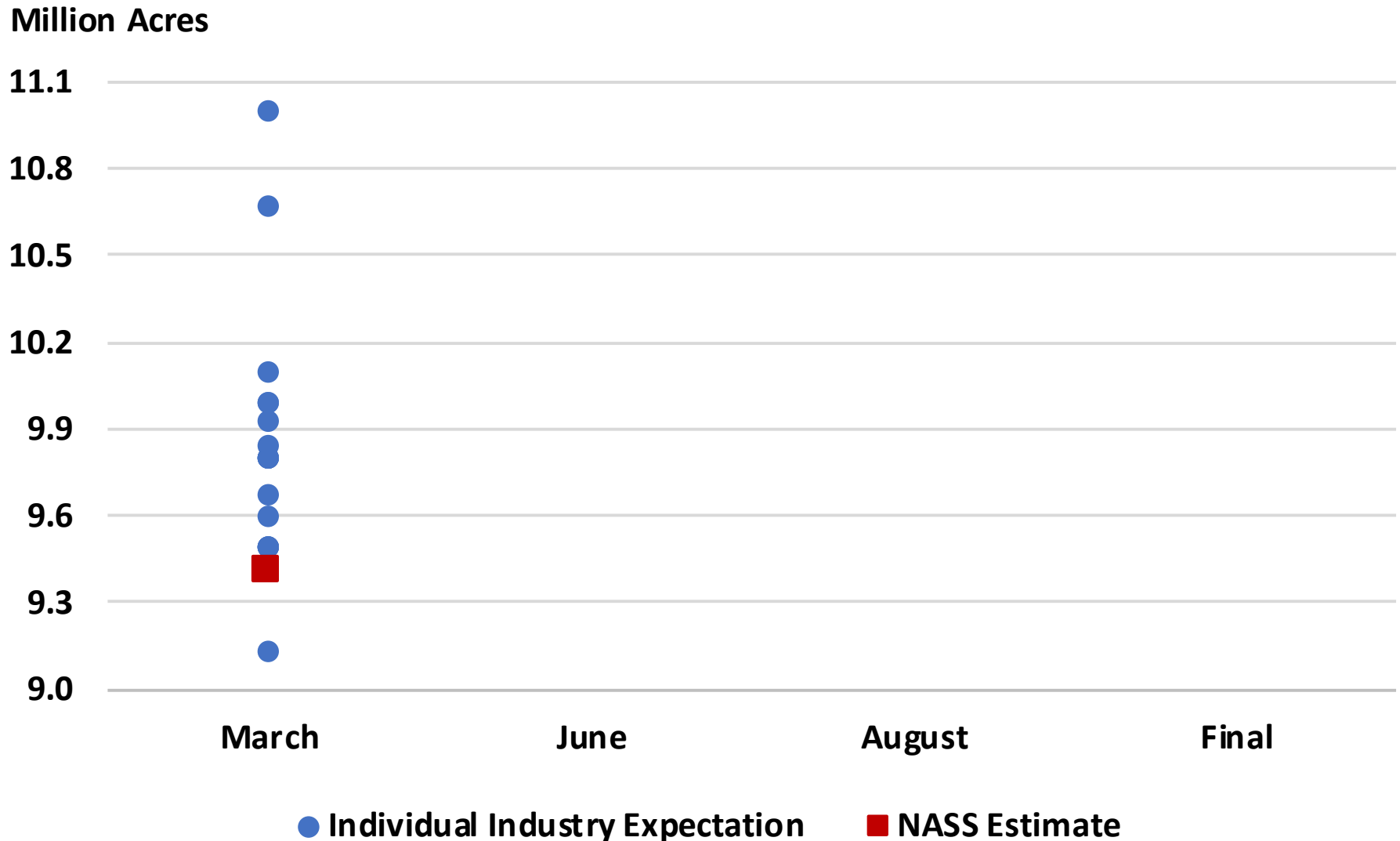

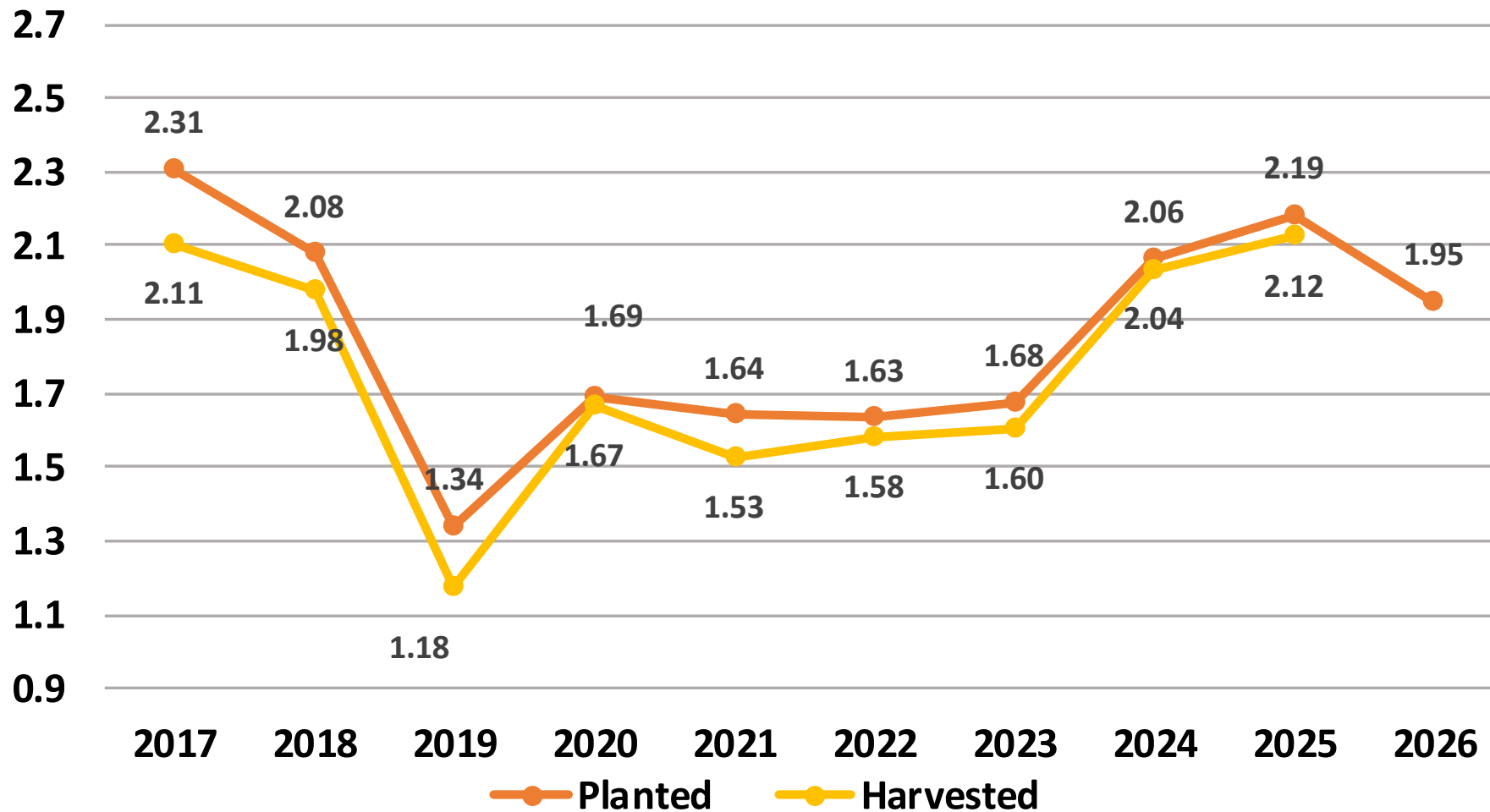

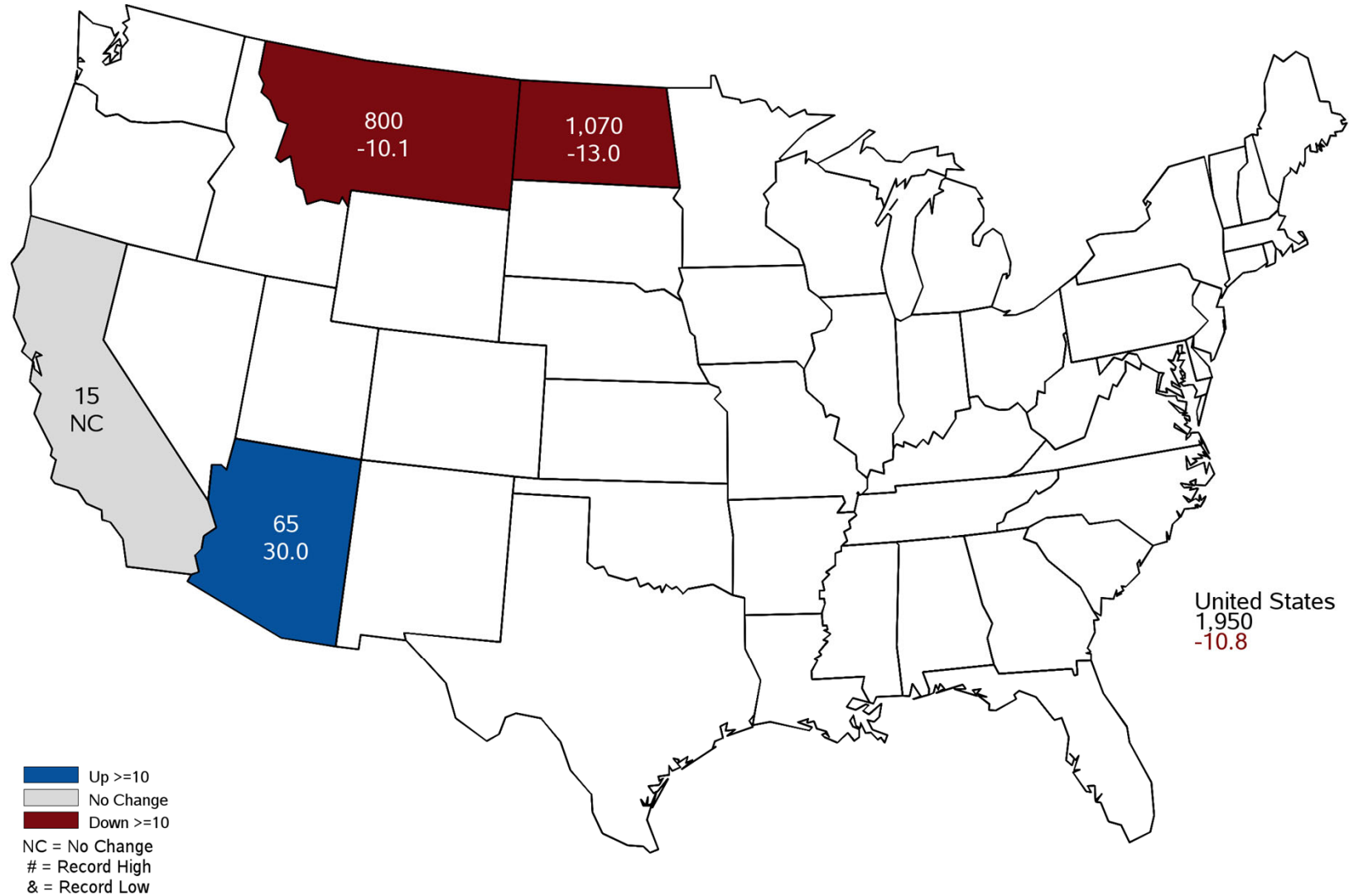

Thousand Acres and Percent Change from Previous Year



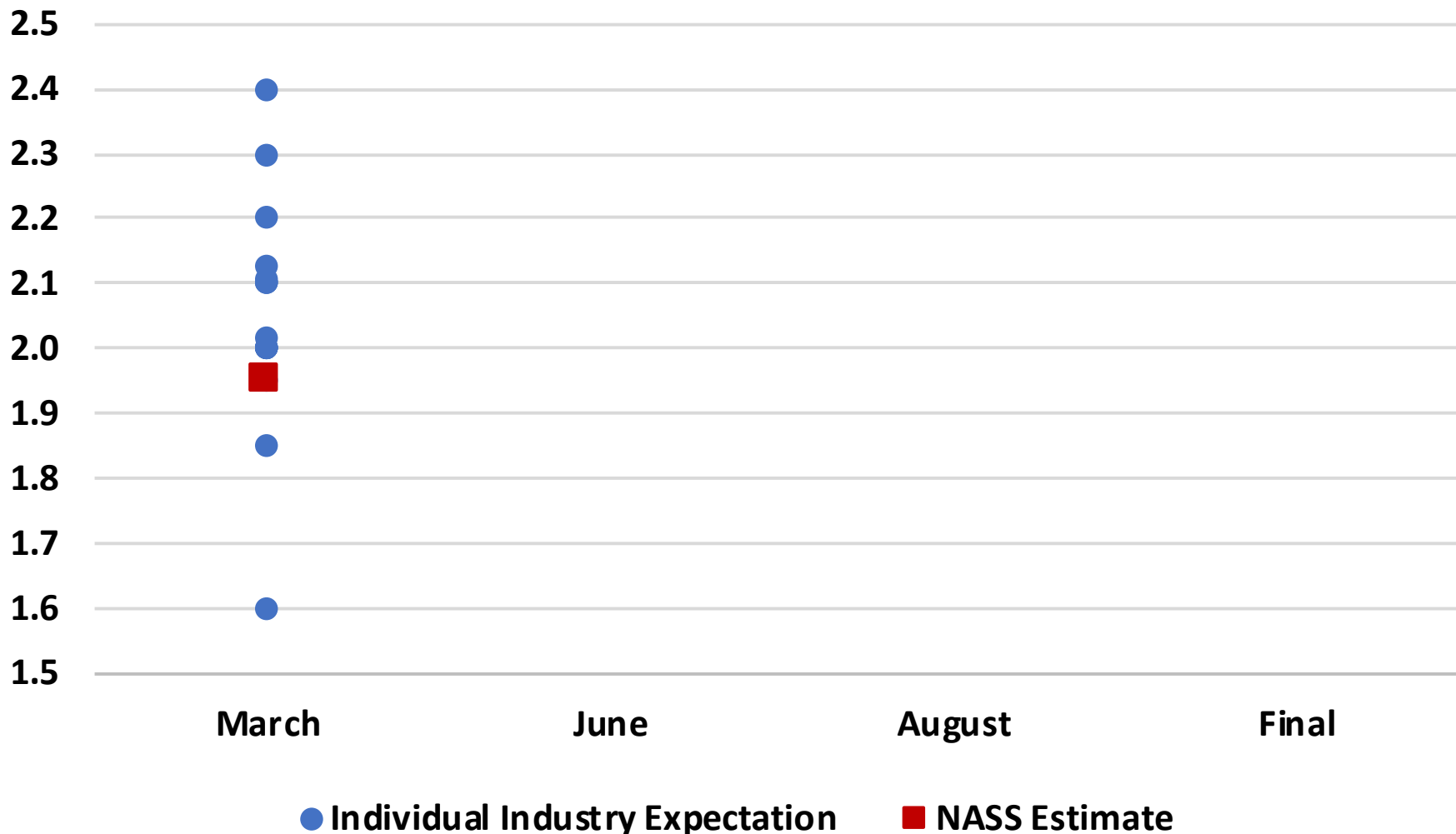

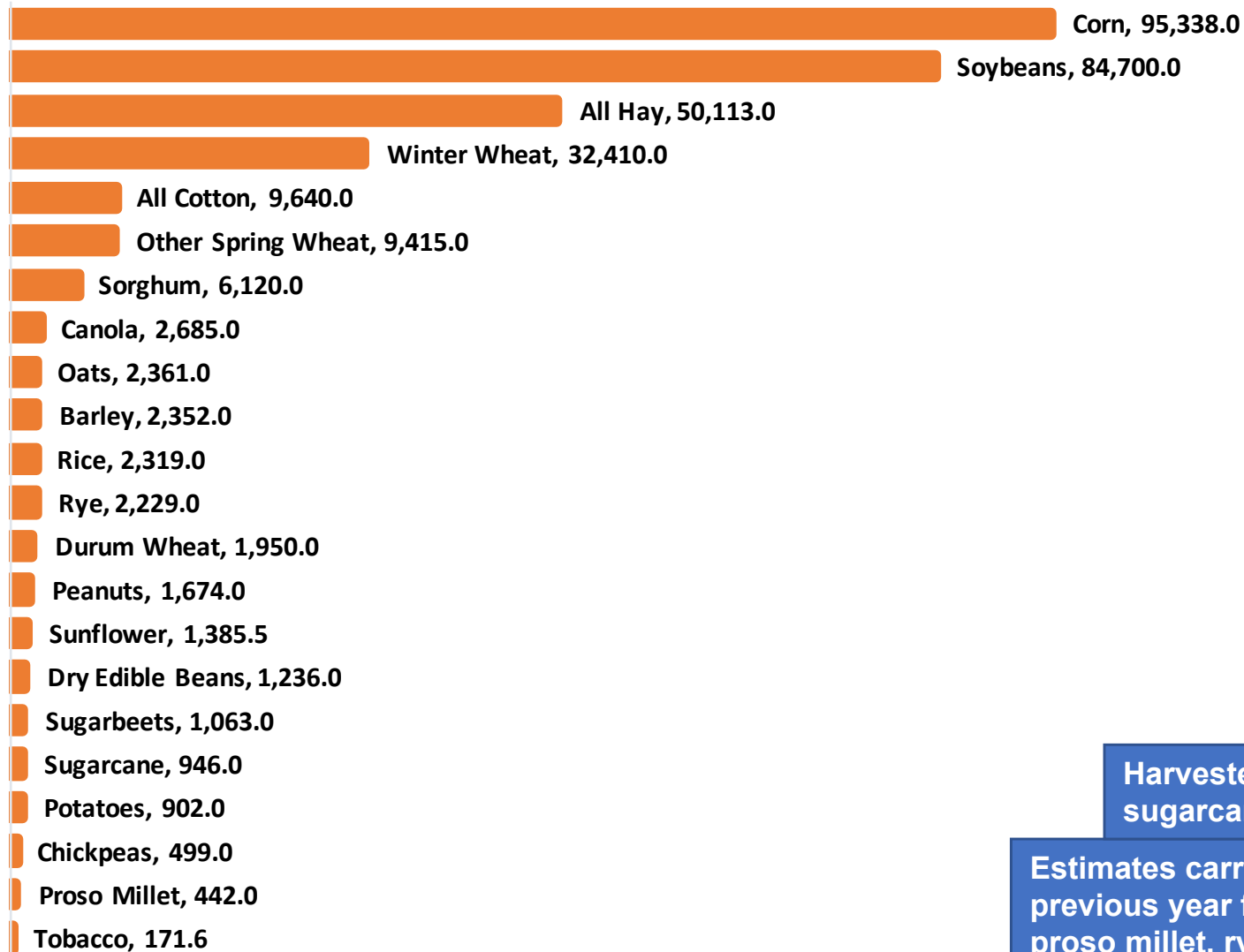

2026 Principal Crops Planted Acreage (000)



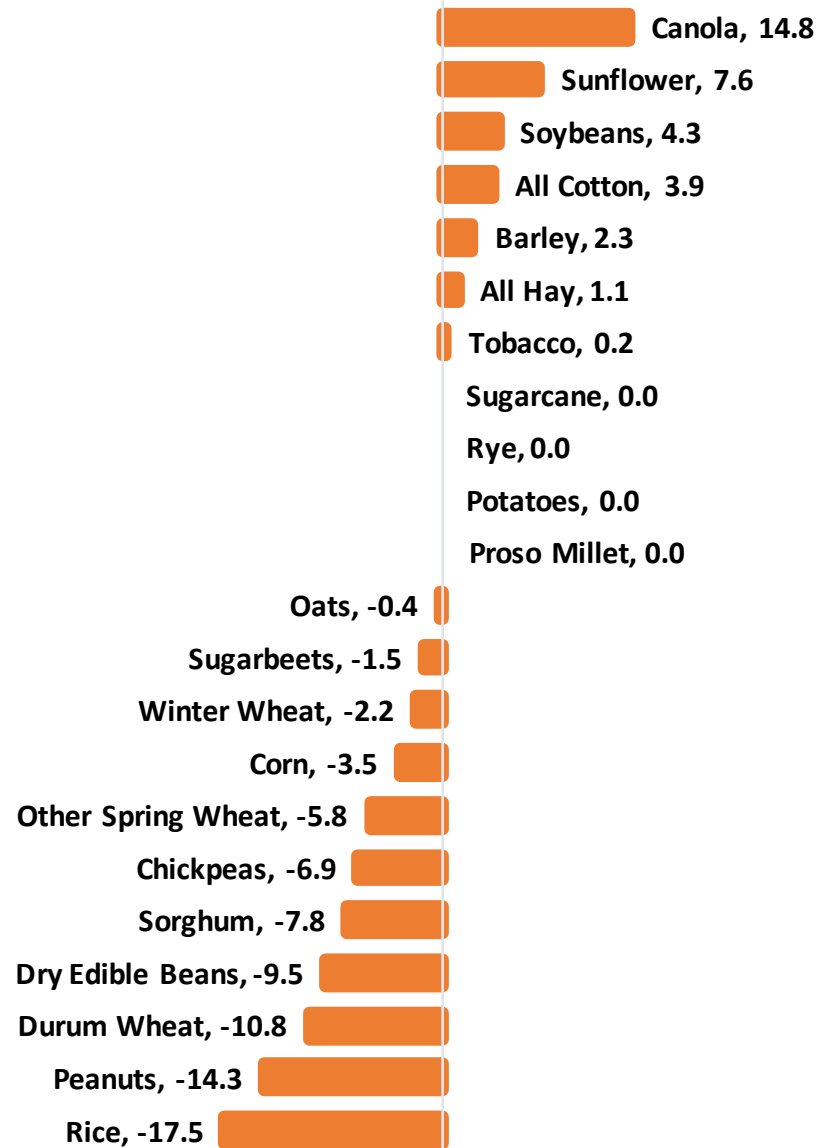

Planted Acreage Percent Change from 2025



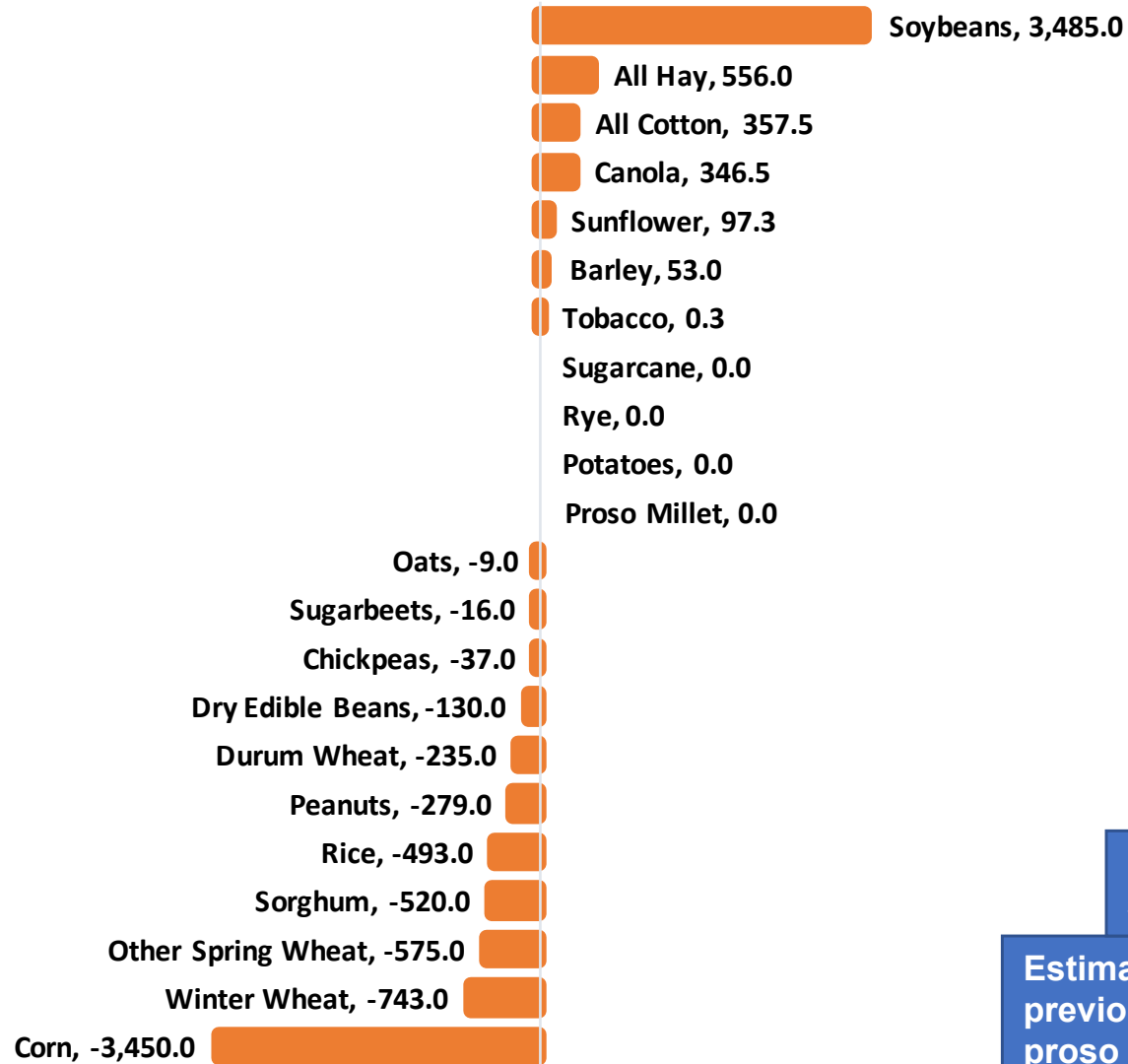

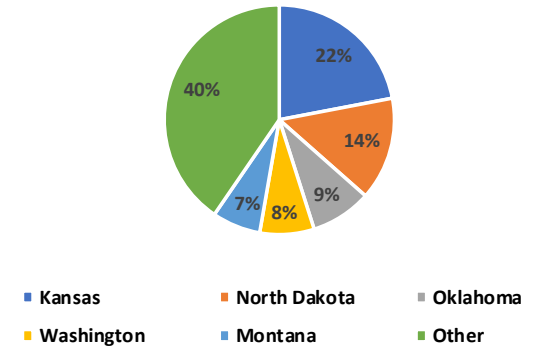

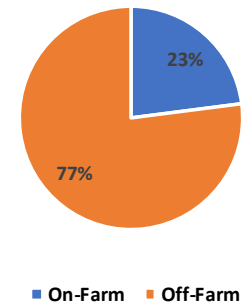

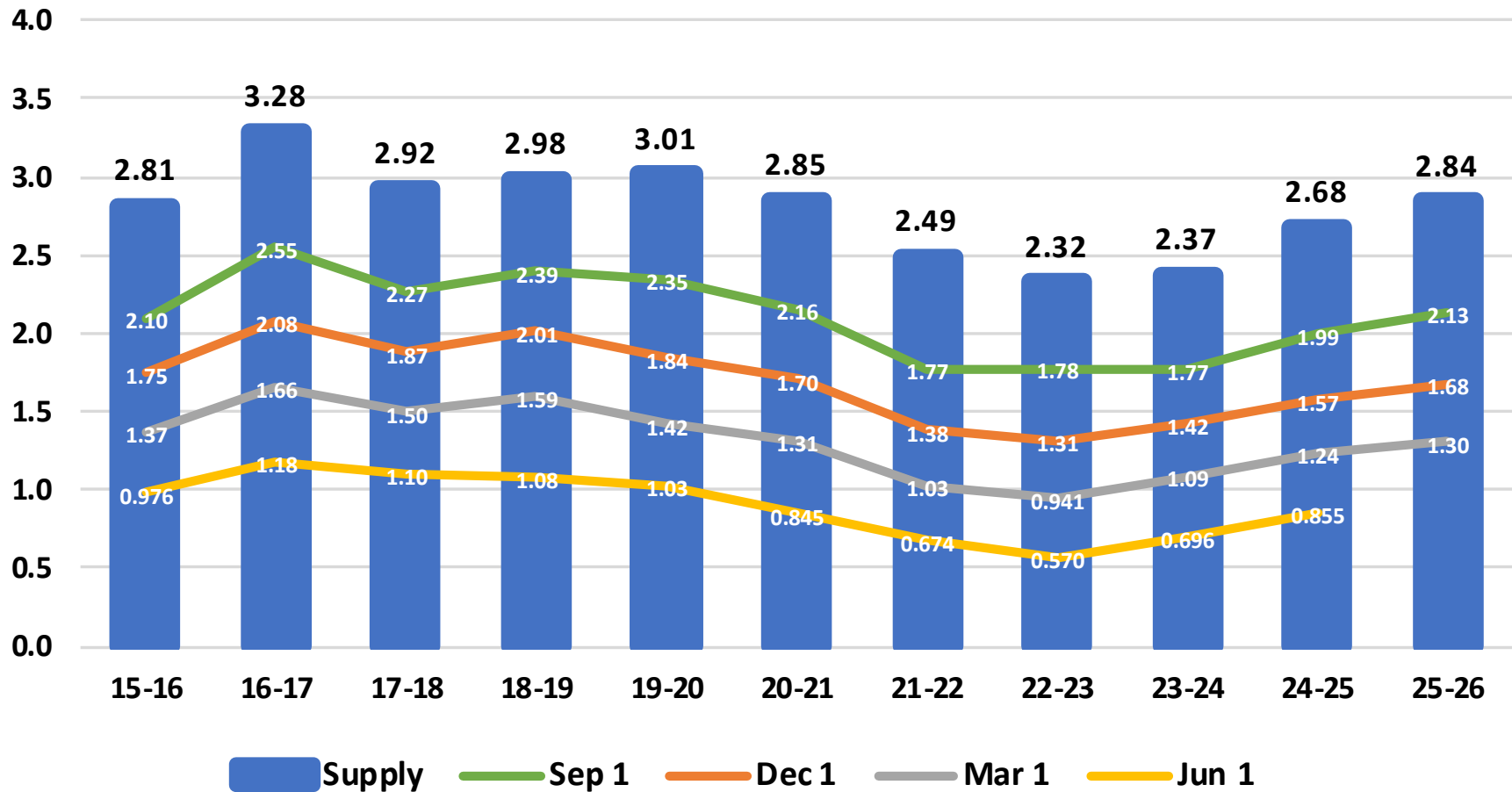

Billion Bushels



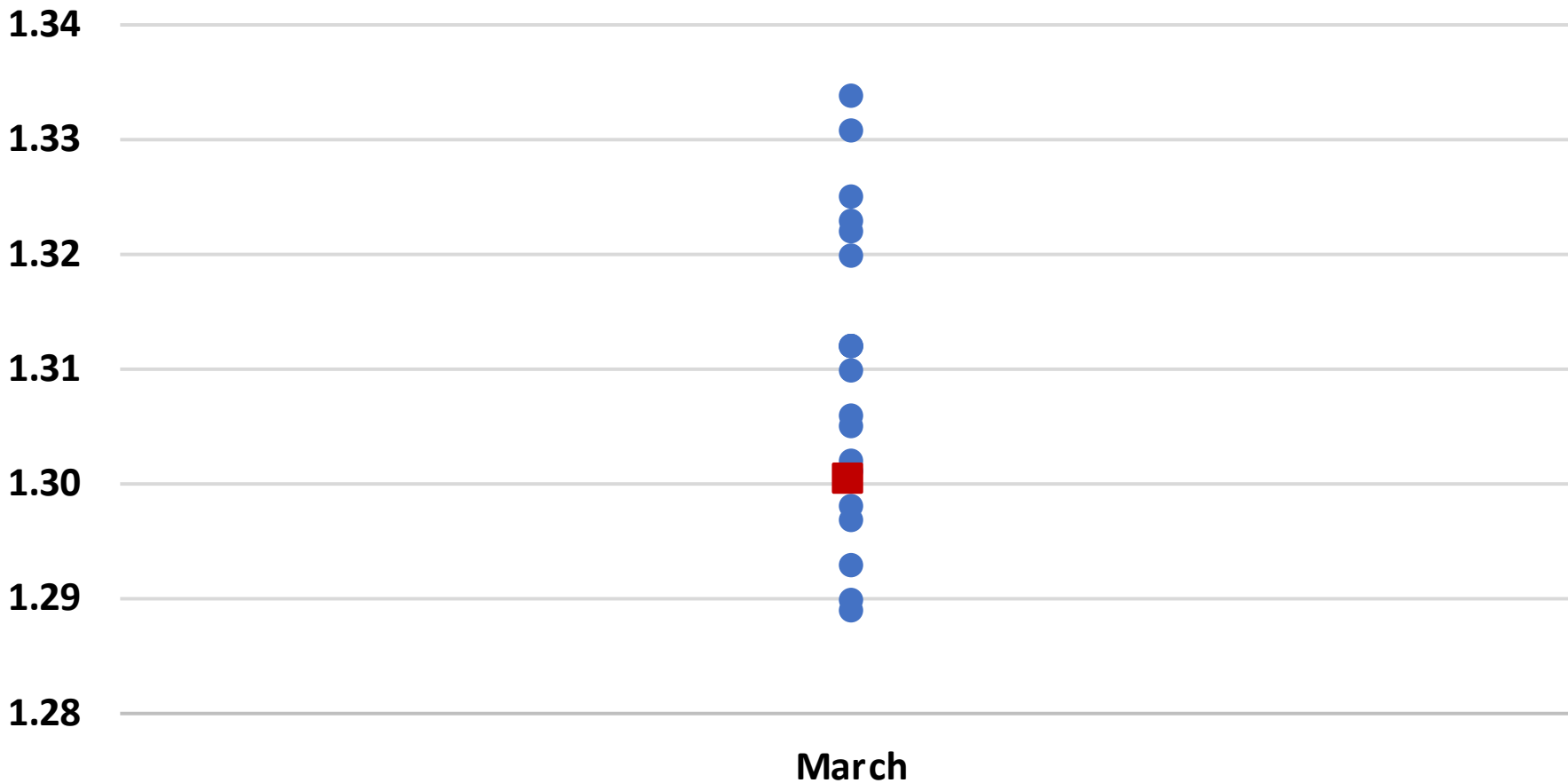

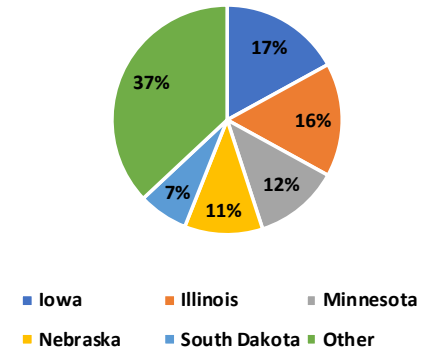

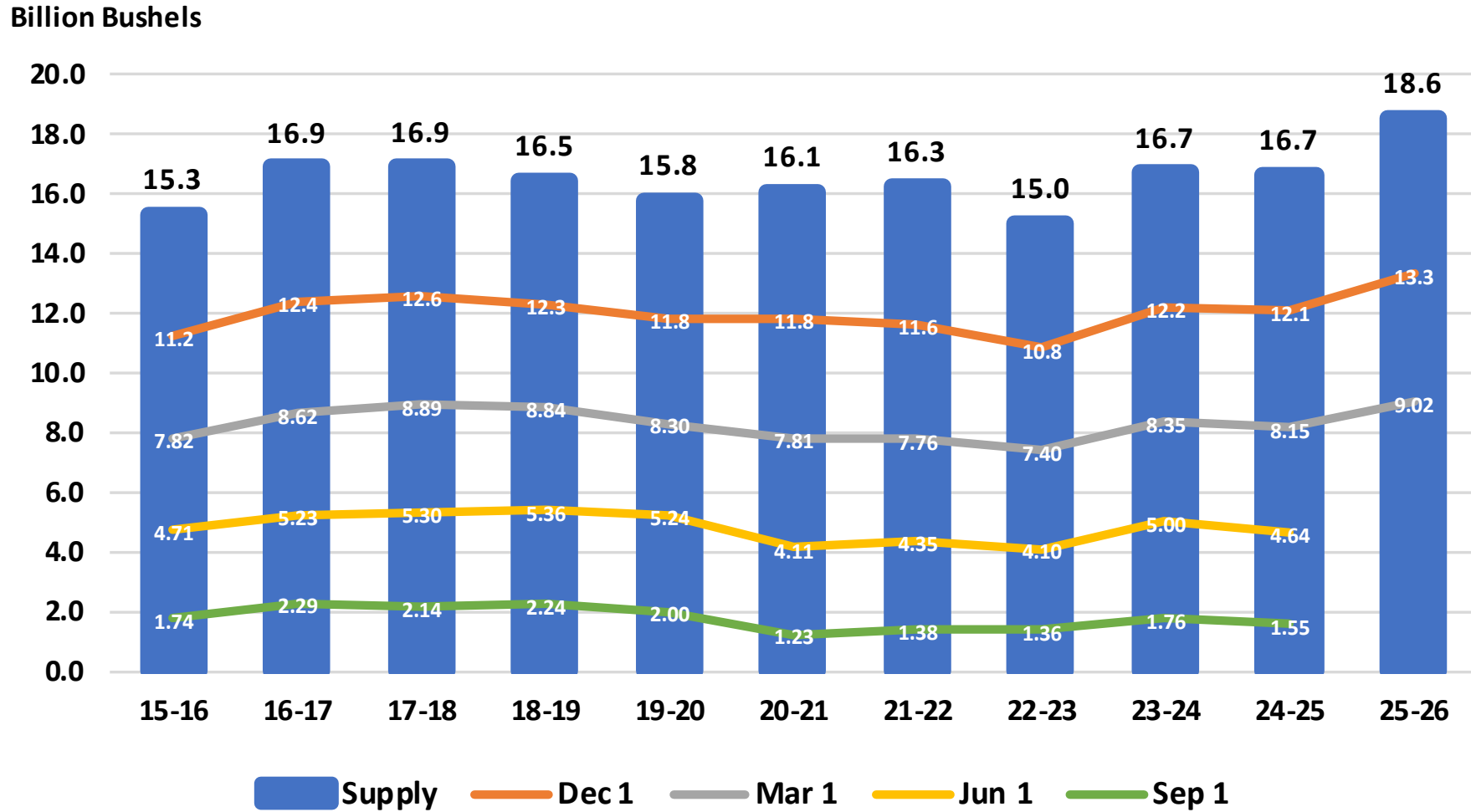

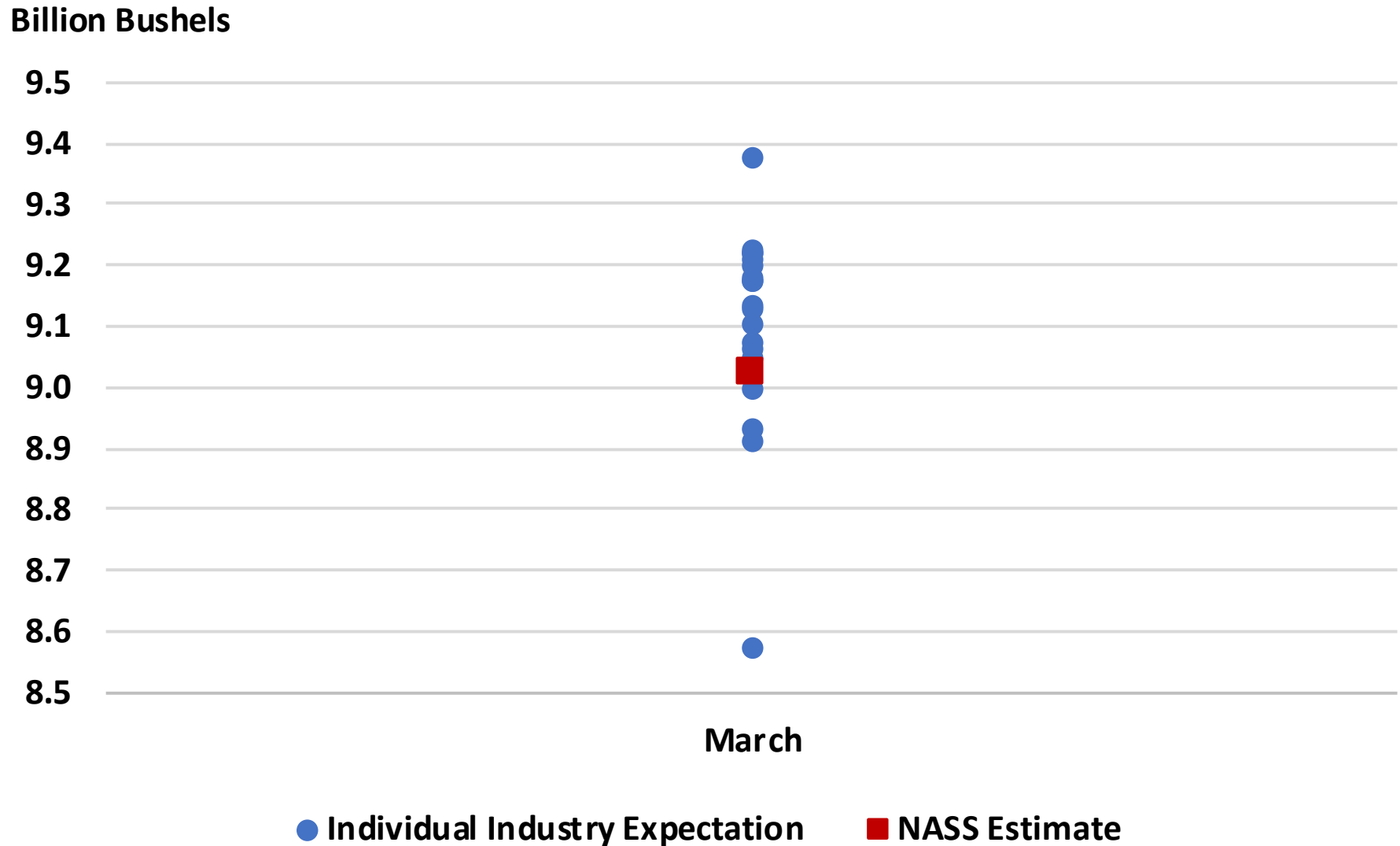

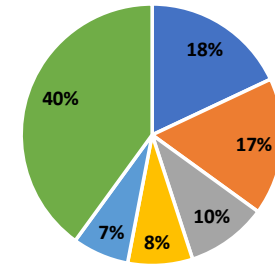

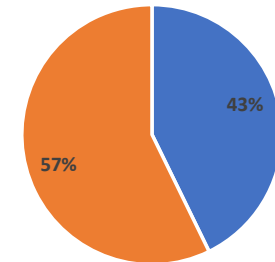

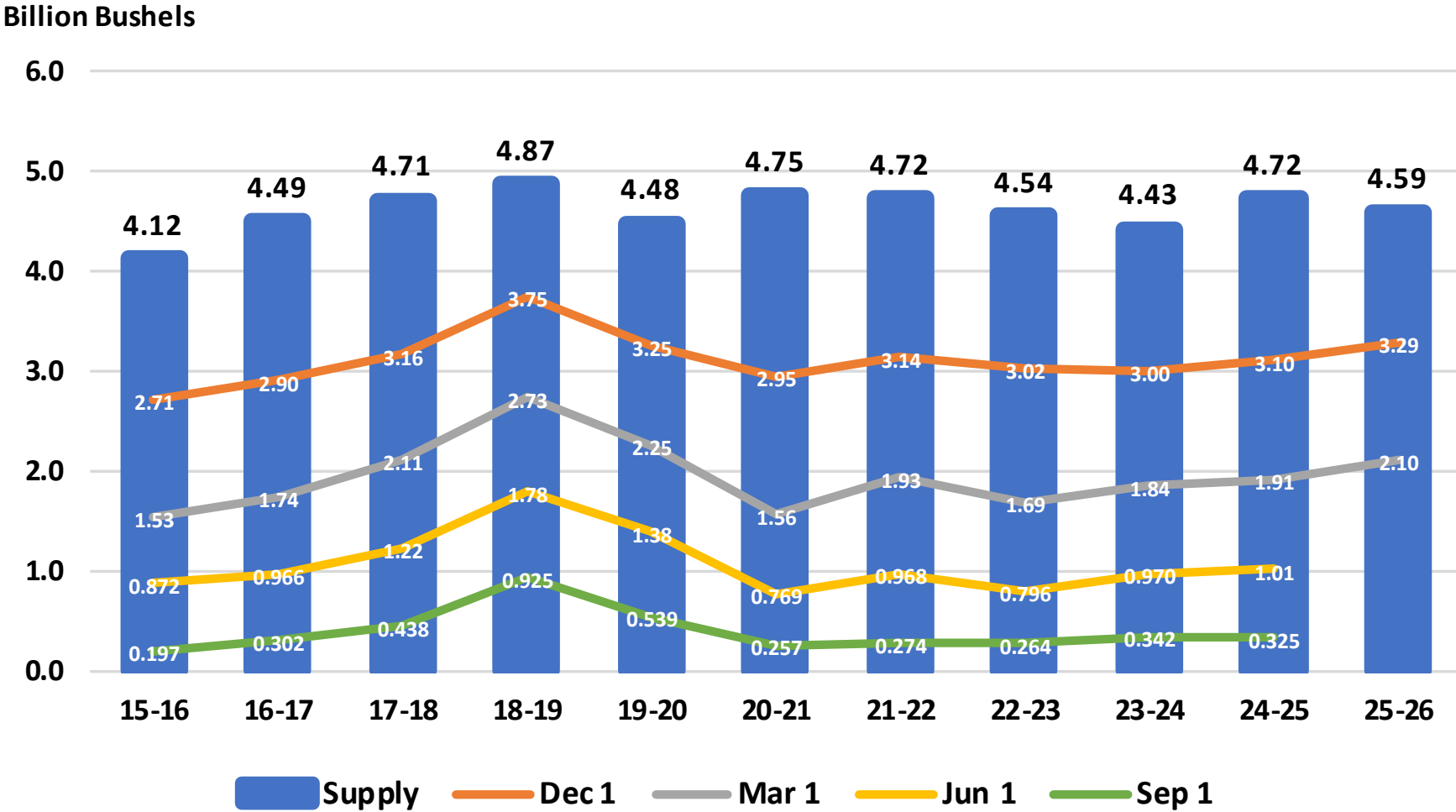

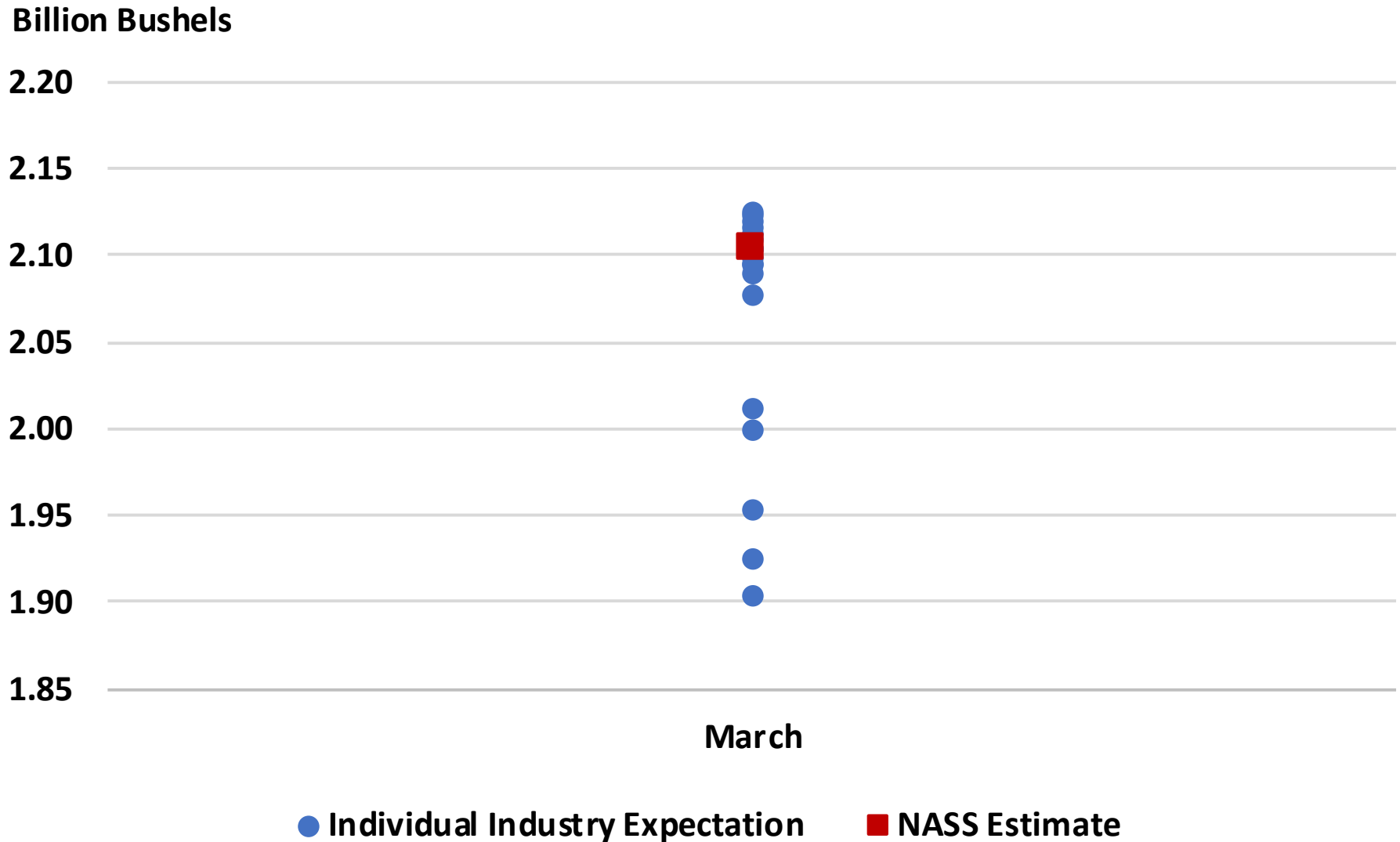

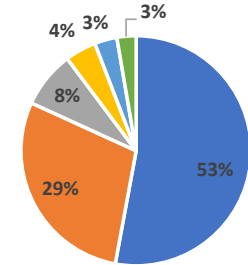

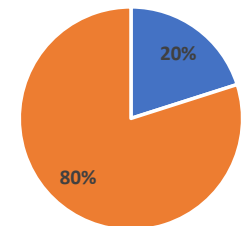

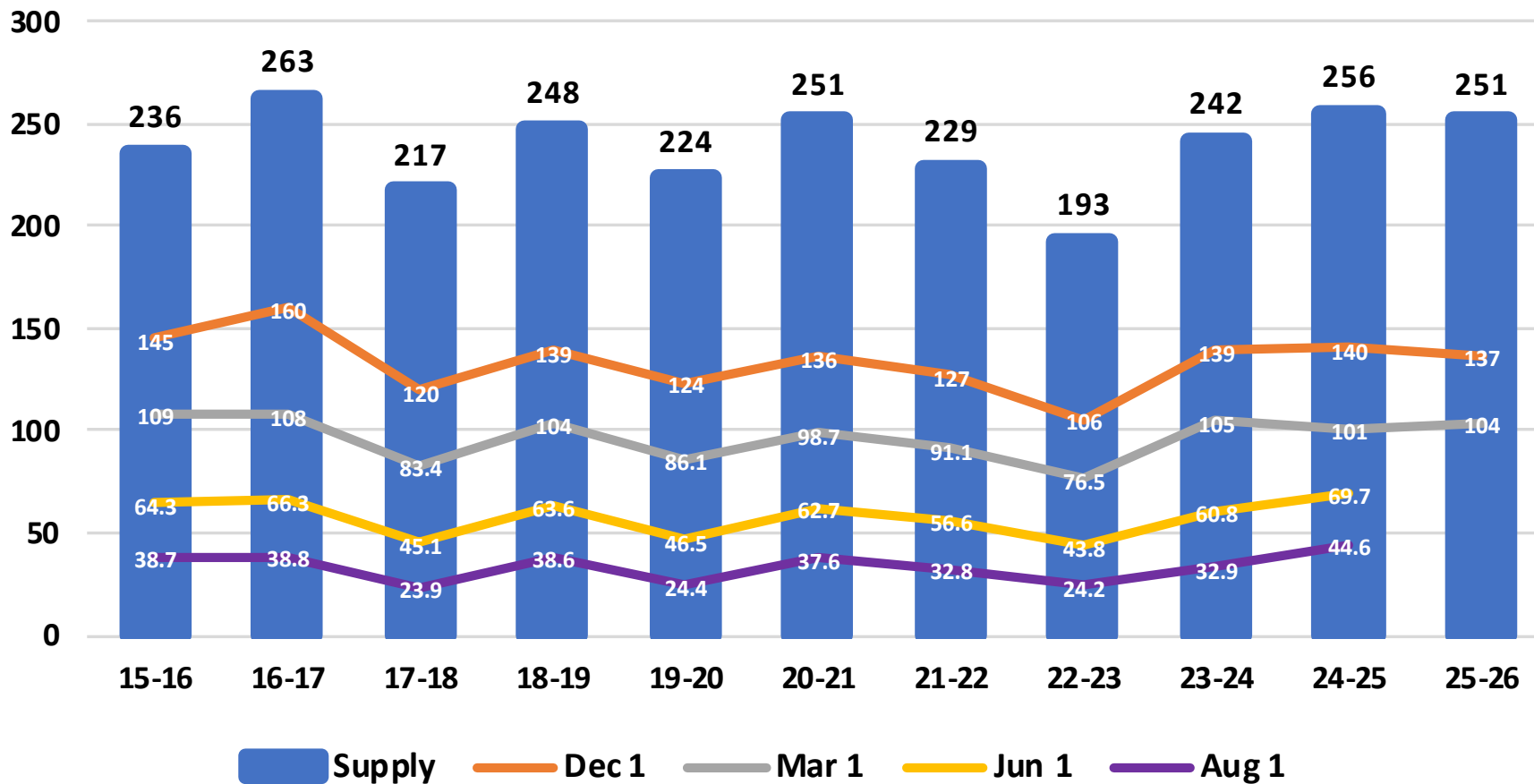
