Farms

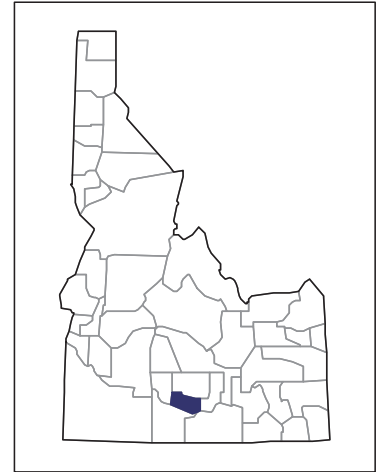

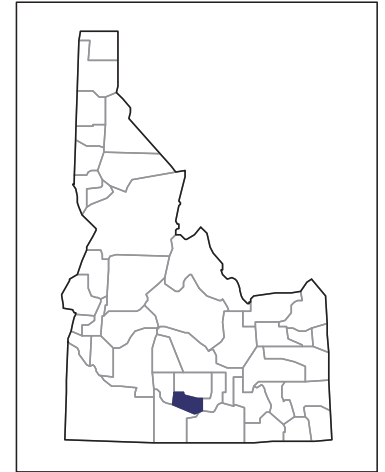

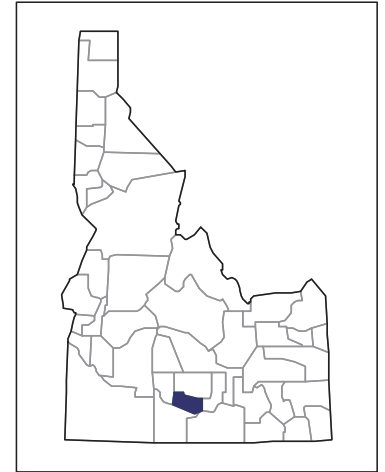

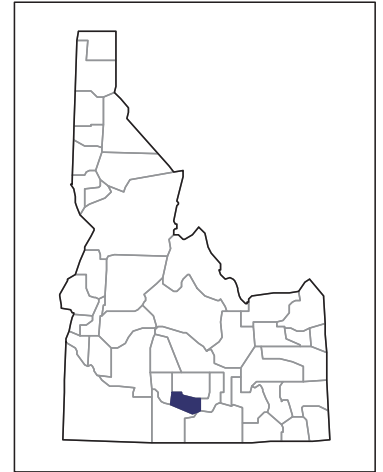
