

### Klamath County - Oregon Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms





### Klamath County - Oregon Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms





### Klamath County - Oregon Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms







