

SHEEP AND GOATS

Lambs saved in 2011, at 47,000 head, increased 7 percent from the previous year. The number of ewes one year old and older on hand January 1, 2012 was up 9 percent from 2011. Lamb Crop per 100 ewes one year old and older was 138 during 2011, up 13 percent from a year earlier.

Wool production was up 4 percent from the previous year, at 240,000 pounds. Sheep and lambs shorn totaled 40,000 head with an average fleece weight of 6.0 pounds. Total value of shorn wool was \$98,000, up 13 percent from a year earlier and averaged 41 cents per pound.



COMMERCIAL SHEEP SLAUGHTER NUMBER OF HEAD, INDIANA, 2006-2011


