NEBRASKA WEEKLY WEATHER AND CROP REPORT

Release 11/15/71

Week Ending 11/15/71

WEATHER Dry and very warm weather prevailed in Nebraska the past week. Temperatures averaged from seven to 10 degrees above normal.

CROPS Generally favorable conditions last week permitted harvesting operations to advance substantially. Corn harvest is 90 percent complete, compared to 69 percent normally harvested by this date. Sorghum is reported 97 percent out of the fields. Some of the remaining sorghum fields are reported down and tangled and causing problems in combining. Ninety-eight percent of the soybean crop has been harvested. The sugar beet harvest is nearing completion in western Nebraska.

Fall plowing, discing and stalk shredding are major activities where harvest operations are completed. Fall fertilizer application was also under way last week.


The winter wheat crop is going into winter dormancy in slightly better condition than last year in all areas except eastern Nebraska.

LIVESTOCK Weaning of calves is continuing as fall round-ups occur and replacement cattle are moving to market. The condition of pasture and range feed is adequate in most areas, although supplemental feeding was required in some localities.
