NEBRASKA APRIL 1 POTATO STOCKS

LINCOLN, NE, April 17, 2014 – Nebraska growers, dealers, and processors held 2.2 million hundredweight (cwt) of potatoes in storage on April 1, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 26 percent of the production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.
