



# Texas Quarterly Grain Stocks






On March 1, 2013, Texas wheat on-farm stocks were unchanged from a year ago according to figures released by the USDA-NASS, Texas Field Office. Total stocks of **wheat** in all positions, at 46.8 million bushels, were down 7 percent from last year's level of 50.5 million bushels. On-farm stocks totaled 1 million bushels unchanged from a year ago. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 45.8 million bushels were down 7 percent from March 2012. Off-farm wheat stocks accounted for 98 percent of all wheat stocks.



**Sorghum** stocks in all positions on March 1 totaled 21.9 million bushels, up 94 percent from the previous year. On-farm stocks totaled 400 thousand bushels, unchanged from a year ago. Off-farm sorghum stocks, at 21.5 million bushels, up 98 percent from March 1, 2012. Off-farm sorghum stocks accounted for 98 percent of all sorghum stocks.



The Texas Field Office does not publish **corn** on-farm stocks, but off-farm stocks, at 77.5 million bushels, were up 34 percent from a year earlier.



**U.S. Highlights:** Total stocks of **corn** in the United States on March 1, 2013 were 5.40 billion bushels, down 10 percent from March 1, 2012. All **wheat** stocks were estimated at 1.23 billion bushels in all positions, up 3 percent from March 1, 2012. U.S. stocks of **sorghum** totaled 91.4 million bushels, down 15 percent from March 1, 2012. Stocks of **soybeans** in all positions totaled 999 million bushels, down 27 percent from March 1, 2012.

**Survey Procedures:** *The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of March. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates.*
