



# Annual Crop Production Report

Issue No.: PR-100-14, January 10, 2014


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This report contains the results from the December Agricultural Survey. Our thanks to all farmers who responded to the Agriculture Survey.

The 2013 Texas **Upland cotton** crop totaled 4.30 million bales, 14 percent lower than 2012. Yield averaged 645 pounds per acre, compared with 623 pounds last year. Acreage harvested, at 3.20 million acres, is down 17 percent from 2012.



**Special note:** The state level estimates in this report for Texas corn and sorghum are final. Final district and county estimates for Texas corn and sorghum are scheduled for publication in mid-February. Due to the proximity of the February release and to avoid potential confusion, district estimates for corn and sorghum were not made for today's report.


Final **corn** production for 2013 totaled 276 million bushels, up 37 percent from last year. Statewide yields averaged 138 bushels per acre, up 8 bushels from 2012. Acres harvested for grain, at 2.00 million, are up 29 percent from last year.

### Corn Production and Yield




**Sorghum** production for 2013 totaled 129 million bushels, up 15 percent from last year. Acres harvested, at 2.30 million acres, is up 21 percent from last year. Yield, at 56 bushels per acre, is down 3 bushels from last year.

### Sorghum Production and Yield




Texas **peanut** production for 2013 is down 18 percent from last year, at 433 million pounds. Statewide yield, at 3,700 pounds per acre, is up 100 pounds from last year. Harvested acreage is down 20 percent from last year to 117 thousand acres.

### Peanut Production




### Rice Production



**Rice** producers harvested 11.15 million cwt during 2013, down 1 percent from 2012. Yield averaged 7,740 pounds per acre, 630 pounds lower than last year.

Texas **soybean** production for 2013 totaled 2.38 million bushels, down 17 percent from the previous year. Harvested acreage, at 95.0 thousand, is down 14 percent from last year. The 2013 soybean yield averaged 25 bushels per acre, compared with 26 bushels last year.

Texas **wheat** producers have seeded 6.20 million acres for the 2014 winter wheat crop, unchanged from last year, but up 9 percent from 2012. Nationally, U.S. seeding of winter wheat for 2014 totaled 41.9 million acres, down 3 percent from 2013

**U.S. Highlights:** United States **corn** production is estimated at 13.9 billion bushels, up 29 percent from last year's production estimate. The yield of 158.8 bushels per acre is 35.4 bushels above the 2012 average. The **sorghum** crop is up 58 percent from last year at 389 million bushels. The U.S. **upland cotton** crop totaled 12.6 million bales, down 24 percent from last year. **Soybean** production is estimated at 3.29 billion bushels, 8 percent above last year. The U.S. **peanut** crop is estimated at 4.17 billion pounds, down 38 percent from a year ago. U.S. **rice** production totaled 190 million cwt, down 5 percent from 2012.

### Statistical Methodology

**Survey procedures:** The estimates in this report are based primarily on surveys conducted the first two weeks of December. The December Agricultural Survey (DAS) is a probability survey that includes a sample of over 82,000 farm operators selected from a list of producers that ensures all operations in the United States have a chance to be selected. These operators were contacted by mail, internet, telephone, or personal interview to obtain information on crop acreage, yield and production for the 2013 crop year.

**Estimating procedures:** National and State level objective yield and farm operator reported data (DAS) were reviewed for reasonableness and consistency with historical estimates. The survey data were also reviewed considering weather patterns and crop progress compared with previous years. Each Field Office submits an estimate and written analysis for their State to the Agricultural Statistics Board (ASB). The ASB uses the survey data, administrative data, and the State analysis to prepare the estimates published in this report.
