Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.59 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 7, up 5 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 7, was 4.08 million, down 5 percent from the previous week, and down 14 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 7, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 7, was 12.2 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
