Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.57 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 21, up 3 percent from the week prior and up slightly from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 14.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 21, up 6 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 21, was 4.64 million, down slightly from the previous week, and up 9 percent from the previous year.
