Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.49 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 17, up 3 percent from the week prior and 13 percent above from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 13.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 17, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 17, was 3.30 million, up 42 percent from the previous week, but down 35 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 17, was 11.5 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.
