

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of September. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on September 1 totaled 157 million bushels, were up 33 percent from the 2015 level of 118 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 145 million bushels were 32 percent higher than September 1, 2015.

Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on September 1, at 122 million bushels, were up 39 percent from the 2015 level of 88.0 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 117 million bushels were 43 percent higher than September 1, 2015.


Quarterly Wheat Stocks

Texas off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 8.95 million bushels. Off-farm sorghum stocks for September 1, 2015, were not published due to confidentiality requirements. On-farm stocks totaled 230 thousand bushels on September 1, 2016.

Texas off-farm corn stocks, at 16.1 million bushels, were down 22 percent from last year. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.


**Texas Quarterly Stocks

Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 1.60 million bushels, up 9 percent September 1, 2015. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm corn stocks, at 6.62 million bushels, were up 90 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.

U.S. Highlights: Total stocks of corn in the United States on September 1, 2016 were 1.74 billion bushels, slightly higher than September 1, 2015. All wheat stocks were estimated at 2.53 billion bushels in all positions, up 21 percent from last September. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 36.6 million bushels, 99 percent above September 1, 2015. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 197 million bushels, up 3 percent from last year.
