## Field Crops

Cotton squaring is 75 percent complete compared to 85 percent last year and 73 percent for the 5-year average, with conditions rated mostly good to excellent, depending on location. Bolls setting is at 31 percent, compared to 30 percent last year and the 5-year average. Arizona's alfalfa condition was rated in excellent to fair condition, depending on location. Harvesting occurred on over three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Barley conditions are mostly good to fair, with 80 percent harvested compared to 95 percent last year and 81 percent for the 5-year average. Durum Wheat conditions are mostly excellent to good, with 84 percent harvested compared to 89 percent last year and 64 percent for the 5-year average. Winter Wheat conditions are excellent to fair, depending on location, with 52 percent harvested, compared to 10 percent last year and 12 percent for the 5-year average. This week there were 7 days suitable for field work.
