## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING JULY 5, 2015

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** Alfalfa conditions were mostly good to excellent, depending on location. Harvesting occurred on over three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Winter Wheat conditions ranged from very poor to excellent throughout the State. Rangeland conditions varied widely from very poor to good, depending on location. Central Arizona growers had cantaloupes, honeydews, mixed and miscellaneous melons, and watermelon movement last week. Western Arizona growers shipped cantaloupes, mixed and miscellaneous melons, and watermelons last week. Thirty-three of the fifty weather stations recorded temperatures greater than 100 degrees last week. Parker, Bullhead City, and Mohave registered temperatures at 127, 116, and 114 degrees, respectively, while the lowest temperature recorded during the week was 49 degrees at the Grand Canyon.
