#### CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING APRIL 10, 2022

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** By April 10, 84 percent of the barley crop had headed, compared with 75 percent last year, and 10 percent of the barley crop had matured, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Seventy-seven percent of the Durum wheat crop had headed compared with 61 percent last year, and 7 percent had matured. Producers had planted 17 percent of the cotton crop compared with 33 percent last year, and 4 percent had emerged. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly excellent to good, depending on location last week, with harvest taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Across Arizona, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly poor to fair. By April 5, 2022, moderate dryness was reported in over 86 percent of the State based on the U.S. Drought Monitor's indications. Some extreme drought conditions were noted in the northeastern part of the state, affecting pasture and range conditions. There were also reports of crop loss due to the lack of irrigation water in small grain crops.
