COTTON GINNINGS – 2014 CROP

ARIZONA

Arizona gins had processed 484,150 running bales (497,150 480-pound bales) of **all cotton** from the 2014 crop, compared with 455,400 running bales (465,800 480-pound bales) last year and also processed 29,750 running bales (30,300 480-pound bales) of **Pima** cotton.

UNITED STATES

United States running bales of **all cotton** ginned from harvest in 2014 totaled 15.88 million running bales (16.29 million 480-pound bales), compared to 12.52 million running bales (12.87 million 480-pound bales) from the same period in 2013, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Of that, 15.33 million running bales (15.73 million 480-pound bales) were **upland** cotton and 544,900 running bales (565,550 480-pound bales) were **Pima** cotton.
