



## Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

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Cooperating with the University of Arkansas – Division of Agriculture

Week Ending: December 8, 2019

Released: December 9, 2019

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 3.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, December 8, 2019**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 3 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 50 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 6 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 45 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 27.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Prescott to 41.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Stuttgart. Highs ranged from 50.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 64.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Magnolia. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 0.34 inches
