Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. Week Ending: April 26, 2020 Released: April 27, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 3.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 26, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 1 percent short, 44 percent adequate, and 55 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 3 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 45 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 43.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Lead Hill to 58.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Sparkman. Highs ranged from 63.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 75.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Dardanelle and Sparkman. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the central part of the State with an average of 2.83 inches.
